### JACKSONVILLE WINS IN EXTRA INNINGS

Brian Miller and Jordan Groshans each blasted a home run in the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp's 7-5, 10-inning win over the Gwinnett Stripers Sunday afternoon at Coolray Field. After a scoreless ninth, Groshans began the inning at second as the ghost runner and advanced to third on a wild pitch. Jerar Encarnacion worked his third walk of the game and Charles Leblanc doubled off Gwinnett (33-42) reliever Grant Holmes (L, 3-2) to put Jacksonville ahead 6-5. Encarnacion went to third and Brian Miller added an insurance run with a sac fly to pad the Jumbo Shrimp lead to 7-5.

### BULL\*\*\*\*

Since returning to the International League in 2021, Jacksonville has failed to find an answer on beating the Durham Bulls. Since 2021, the Jumbo Shrimp own a .375 winning percentage against the Bulls, the lowest winning percentage against a team they've faced in multiple series'. Last year, Jacksonville matched up against Durham 24 times, winning just nine contests. This year, the Jumbo Shrimp pitching staff owns a 6.13 ERA against Durham while the Bulls have posted a 2.76 ERA, allowing just 45 runs in 101.1 innings. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 73-45, an average of 6.0 runs/game to 3.8 runs/game.

### **CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT**

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last 27 contests, Jacksonville has blasted 33 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcher-friendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 33 home runs are 19th-most in Triple-A over the last 27 games.

### YOU CAN ONLY PLAY WHO'S IN FRONT OF YOU

Jacksonville's 32-42 record is 20th in the International League, but the Jumbo Shrimp have played arguably the most difficult schedule in the circuit. Fifty-three of the club's 74 games, or 71.6 percent, have come against teams with a record of at least .500. That figure is by far the most in the league. On the flip side, Durham has had a relatively easy schedule. The reigning Triple-A Champs are 10-17 vs. teams with a record above .500, they are 30-18 vs. teams below .500.

### **APRIL SHOWERS HAVEN'T BROUGHT FLOWERS**

Jacksonville finds themselves in the cellar of the International League. After finishing the first month of the season with a 13-12 record, the Jumbo Shrimp haven't found a spark, going 18-29 since May 1. The club posted the sixth-best ERA through the first month of the season at 4.47 in 227.1 innings. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 271 earned runs in 411.0 innings for a 5.58 ERA that ranks 13th in the IL. Through those 49 games, opponents have posted a .268 batting average against Jacksonville pitching which ranks as the sixth-highest batting average against in the league. Through 72 games in 2022, Jacksonville owned a 38-34 record with a posted 4.49 ERA.

### FOUR SCORE AND ONE MONTH AGO

The Jumbo Shrimp have scored at least four runs in 13 of their last 18 games, going 8-10 in that span. The Jumbo Shrimp are being outscored 94 to 87 during this run. After going 0-6 to close out May and open the month of June. Jacksonville has won six of their last 12. The Jumbo Shrimp's longest stretch of scoring at least four runs stands at 10 (April 27-May 7). During that run, Jacksonville went 7-3 and outscored their opponents 65 to 49.

### THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on May 12, Brian Miller had posted just a .217/.318/.315/.633 line for the season. However, over the last 26 games, the Durham, N.C., native is 29-for-91 (.319/.379/.462/.841) with six doubles, two triples, HR, 11 RBIs and 13 runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 10.4 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 37.1 percent.

### **SHRIMP BITES**

Jacksonville split their previous two series against Nashville and Memphis at home...The club hasn't won a series since May 2-7 on the road against the Redbirds. Since that point, the Jumbo Shrimp have gone 0-4-3 including a series loss to Gwinnett last week. With two wins against Gwinnett last week Jacksonville pitching struggled, posting a 6.13 ERA in 47.0 innings which was the sixth-worst ERA among International League teams last week. The Jumbo Shrimp were outscored 35 to 26, allowing a .291 BAA

### ABOUT JOHNNY

-A two-time All-Star and member of the 2015 World Series champion Kansas City Royals, Cueto has gone 143-108 with a 3.46 ERA over 356 MLB appearances, including 354 starts, in a 16-year career with the Cincinnati Reds, San Francisco Giants, Royals, Chicago White Sox and Marlins.

-Cueto was placed on the 10-day IL on April 4 with a biceps injury after departing from his Marlins debut on April 3 after just 1.0 inning. He had signed a one-year deal in January with Miami that included a club option for the 2024 season.
