### LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox used a four-run eighth inning to come from behind and defeat the RubberDucks 6-5 in the series opener. Trailing by one entering the eighth, **Jud Fabian** tied things up with his 15th homer of the season. A wild pitch brought home the go-ahead run in **Samuel Basallo** before **TT Bowens** and **Frederick Bencosme** singled and doubled in runs, respectively, to add on to Bowie's lead. **Wandisson Charles** closed things out with his first save of the season while **Lincoln Henzman** received the win.

### ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles 2024 All-Star Futures Game selection, collected a pair of hits on Sunday to record his team-leading 22nd multi-hit game this season. The No. 2 O's/ No. 12 MLB prospect is tied for the 7th-most hits in the Eastern League (82) and is the first teenager to hit double-digit home runs in an Eastern League season since Vladimir Guerrero Jr. in 2018 (NH).

### THE FABULOUS FABIAN

After hitting his 15th homer of the season yesterday, OF **Jud Fabian** is now the Eastern League leader in home runs amongst active players and is one off sharing the overall league lead held by Somerset's Agustin Ramirez, who is now with Triple-A Scranton Wilkes-Barre. The O's No. 11 prospect has homered in back-to-back games and recorded his first two-homer game of his career against Akron on May 7.

### FEAR THE BEARD

Between Double-A Bowie and High-A Aberdeen, OF **Matthew Etzel's** 41 stolen bags this season are tied for 9th-most in all of MiLB and 2nd-most in the Orioles system. The first member of the O's '23 draft class to reach Double-A, Etzel has hits in 22 of his first 28 starts at the level.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF/1B **Dylan Beavers** has reached base in 62 of 77 games played in his second season with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 6 prospect leads the team in walks (41), tied for sixth-most in the Eastern League.

### OWNAGE IS OWNAGE

OF **Jud Fabian** and 1B **TT Bowens** own the best numbers against Akron so far this season. Fabian is hitting a team-high .364 (8-for-22) with 3 HR and 8 RBI while Bowens is batting .333 (7-for-21) with three doubles.

### SETH ON THE SLAB

RHP **Seth Johnson** has been one of the most consistent starters in the Eastern League in his first full season at Double-A. Since May 17, the Orioles No. 9 prospect has a 1.70 ERA over his last 42.1 innings pitched. On Friday against Hartford, Johnson recorded his fifth scoreless start of the season with four shutout innings.

### ARMS RACE

The Baysox pitching staff has the 5th-best ERA in Double-A since June 1 (3.49) and has recorded the 2nd-most strikeouts this season (892)...The Baysox bullpen has thrown the most innings (438.1) at Double-A with the 3rd-best WHIP (1.20)...The Bowie rotation has also done its part with the 4th-lowest ERA (2.86) in Double-A in July.

### LET'S DISCUSS THE DUCKS

Entering this week, the Akron RubberDucks own the best second-half record in the Eastern League at 15-6. The RubberDucks have the best staff ERA in the Eastern League at 3.22 and they are tied with Harrisburg for the most shutouts in the league this season (12). Four of the Guardians top 30 prospects are on the RubberDucks active roster - OF Petey Halpin (No. 15), LHP Parker Messick (No. 21), 1B CJ Kayfus (No. 27) and IF Dayan Frias (No. 28)

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Tommy Mace makes his 18th start of the season for the RubberDucks. The 25-year-old has thrown the fourth-most innings in the Eastern League (98.2) this season. After recording a 1.79 ERA in April and May, Mace has recorded a 6.87 ERA in June and July. The former Florida Gator and former college teammate of Jud Fabian threw six scoreless innings the first time he faced Bowie on May 11.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Coaching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

### CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach
