GONE FISCH-ING

3B/1B ANDREW FISCHER enters today with 46 home runs between High-A (20) and Double-A (26), the most in MiLB... With 3 home runs on August 27, Fischer became the 1st Brewers Minor League player with a 40 home run season since **CF GORMAN THOMAS** (51) in 1974.

Fischer enters today tied for the 5th-most home runs by a minor league player in the Modern Era (since the 1963 reorganization)... It marks the most in a season since 2004, when **1B RYAN HOWARD** recorded 46.

Fischer has recorded 111 RBI between Biloxi (61) and High-A Wisconsin (50)... Fischer is the 8th Brewers Minor League player this century to record 100+ RBI in a season and the 1st since **C HUNTER MORRIS** (113) in 2012... Fischer enters today with the 5th-most RBI by a Brewers MiLB hitter this century.

No Brewers Minor League player has led MiLB in home runs since **C BILL FOLEY** (34) in 1978 with the Class-A Burlington Bees of the Midwest League... Fischer leads by 8 over **OF LAZARO MONTES** (38) with 6 games remaining in the regular season.

CHASING DOWN ANOTHER RECORD

SS JESUS MADE (88) enters today tied for the 2nd-most RBI in a single season in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... The current single-season record is 89, set by **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** in 2023.

Made is the 4th Shuckers player to record 80+ RBI in a season in franchise history (since 2015)... All 4 players have achieved the feat since the start of the 2023 season.

Made is hitting .311 (46-for-148) with an .857 OPS with runners in scoring position this season.

PLAYOFFS?!?!? WE'RE TALKING ABOUT PLAYOFFS!

The Shuckers are set to begin the 2026 Southern League playoffs on the road on Tuesday, September 15 against the Pensacola Blue Wahoos... 2026 marks the 25th playoff appearance by a Brewers Double-A affiliate and the 6th in Shuckers franchise history (since 2015)... No Brewers Double-A affiliate has won an outright league championship since the 1994 El Paso Diablos (Texas League).

The series will be a rematch of the 2015, 2018 and 2019 Southern League Division Series... The Shuckers are 3-0 against the Blue Wahoos in the playoffs, with all 3 meetings coming in the SLDS.

The meeting will mark the first between a Brewers and Marlins Double-A affiliate since the 2003 Southern League Championship Series... The Carolina Mudcats (MIA) swept the Huntsville Stars (MIL), 3-0.

HIP, HIPO'RAE!

On August 28, **2B DYLAN O'RAE** set the Shuckers new single-season franchise record with his 53rd stolen base of the season... O' Rae's 58 stolen bases mark the most in a season by a Brewers Double-A player since 1984, when **OF MIKE FELDER** recorded 58 with the El Paso Diablos.

O' Rae enters today as the Southern League leader in stolen bases (58)... No Shucker has led the league in stolen bases since **OF COREY RAY** (37) in 2018.

HOMER HAPPY SHUCKERS

Across 63 games in the second half, the Shuckers have hit 100 home runs, the most by a Southern League team in the 2nd Half since 2005... The Shuckers have recorded a home run in 49 of 63 games in the half.

The Shuckers enter today with 167 home runs, a **NEW** franchise record... The previous record was 154, set in 2022.

ALL ABOUT THE BULLPEN

During the Shuckers 12-game homestand (since 8/25), the bullpen held a 3.14 ERA (18er, 51.2ip) with a .230 opponents average and a 22% strikeout rate... The 3.14 ERA was the 3rd-best by a Double-A bullpen during that span.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ (12-4, 4.86) makes his 26th appearance and 25th start of the season... Rodriguez enters today among the Southern League leaders in wins (1st, 12), innings (T-1st, 124.0), opponents average (4th, .243), ERA (5th, 4.86) and strikeouts (6th, 106).

Rodriguez's 12 wins mark the most by a Brewers Double-A pitcher since the Brewers moved their affiliate to the Southern League in 1999.
