

FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue a six-game homestand against the Birmingham Barons, Double-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox. Rocket City is coming off a 2-4 road trip in Biloxi and looks to bounce back in the first matchup of the second half against Birmingham. This marks the third of four series between the division rivals this season, with the final meeting set for August 19-24 at Regions Field.

BARONS EDGE TRASH PANDAS 2-0 IN 10-INNING PITCHER'S DUEL: The Trash Pandas dropped a 2-0 extra-innings heartbreaker to the Birmingham Barons on Tuesday night at Toyota Field. Despite a dominant six-inning, scoreless outing from Sam Aldegheri, Rocket City couldn't capitalize on several chances, leaving 10 runners on base. The Barons broke through with two runs in the 10th to claim the win. Nelson Rada and Denzer Guzman each had multi-hit games for Rocket City, while Aldegheri finished July with a 1.57 ERA and a perfect 3-0 record.

THE FIRST DOMINO FALLS: BROWN TRADED TO NATS: On Wednesday, the Angels traded Trash Pandas first baseman Sam Brown to the Washington Nationals as part of a four-player deal. A 2023 12th-round pick out of Washington State, Brown hit .244 with 12 doubles, five homers, and 40 RBI in 92 games for Rocket City this season. He was named Southern League Player of the Week in mid-July and ranked fourth in batting average in May, In return, the Angels received LHP Andrew Chafin and RHP Luis García, while LHP Jake Eder also goes to Washington. José Quijada was designated for assignment.

PANDAS ON FANDUEL SPORTS NETWORK WEST: The Trash Pandas are hitting the West Coast! Beginning Thursday, July 31, four Trash Pandas games will be televised and streamed live on FanDuel Sports Network West during the second half of the 2025 season. Broadcasts—produced in-house by the Trash Pandas team—will feature veteran voices Josh Caray and Chris Harris. Fans in the Angels' local TV market can tune in via the FanDuel app or network to catch the action and experience Toyota Field like never before. Game Schedule: July 31 vs. Birmingham, August 14 vs. Knoxville, August 28 vs. Columbus, and September 10 vs. Chattanooga

GUZ GONE WILD: DENZER'S BLAZING THROUGH JULY: The San Pedro de Macorís native has been one of the hottest hitters in Double-A this July, leading the Southern League—and 2nd in all of Double-A—with a 1.102 OPS, 47 total bases, and 13 extra-base hits. He ranks second in the league with a .365 batting average and is also first in slugging (.635) and on-base percentage (.467). His nine doubles rank second in the league, and his 27 hits are 3rd. On July 13 in Chattanooga, he recorded the second five-hit game in Trash Pandas history, going 5-for-5 with three doubles, a home run, and four RBIs.. He now ranks among the overall league leaders in several categories, including doubles (2nd, 23), extra-base hits (T-1st, 35), RBIs (6th, 53), total bases (5th, 137), home runs (T-7th, 11), and slugging (5th, 428), and OPS (7th, .768). Guzman leads the team with 16 multi-RBI games

ALDEGHERI CHIUDE LUGLIO IN GRANDE STILE: Itallian lefty, Sam Aldegheri has been one of the Southern League's most dominant starters in July, leading the league with a 0.78 ERA. In four starts, the left-hander is 3-0, allowing just four earned runs over 23.0 innings while recording 19 strikeouts and 10 walks.

"YOU CAN'T SCORE IF YOU DON'T GET ON BASE.": Led by Denzer Guzman, who has reached safely in nine straight games and hit safely in eight consecutive games, the Trash Pandas have enjoyed some lengthy on-base streaks lately. Myles Emmerson has reached in seven of his last eight games. Nelson Rada has reached base in 16 of his previous 17 games. Guzman has also been consistent over the long haul, getting on base in 22 of his last 24 games. Meanwhile, Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 21 of his previous 25 games, and **David Mershon** has reached base in 17 of his last 19. Over the Trash Pandas last 13 games, highlighted by a four-game win streak from July 12-20. During this stretch, they've posted a .336 OBP, ranking sixth in Double-A baseball, racking up up 98 hits and 54 walks.

REACHING THE 100 STRIKEOUT MARK: Mitch Farris became the seventh pitcher in Trash Pandas history to reach 100 strikeouts in a single season on July 25 with six over 6.0 innings at Biloxi. He currently ranks 3rd in the Southern League with 103 strikeouts across his first 18 outings (17 starts) in 2025. The league leader is Birmingham's Riley Gowens, who sits at 105. The single-season franchise record belongs to Caden Dana, who tallied 147 strikeouts in 2024.

ROCKET CITY IS LIVING UP TO ITS NAME: Since July 3, the Trash Pandas have launched 18 home runs over 20 games, T-1st in the Southern League and ranking T-6th in all of Double-A baseball. That stretch includes a five-homer outburst on July 3 against Knoxville at Toyota Field, tying a franchise record. Prior to that, Rocket City had hit 53 home runs over % games—an average of just 0.7 per game. The recent surge has seen that average jump to 0.9 per game, fueled by **Oscar Colás** and **Ben Gobbel**, who have combined for 10 of the 18 homers. Colás leads the league in that span with six, while Gobbel is right behind with four.

SOUND THE BLANKENHORN: OF Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 21 of his last 25 games, and 28 of 34 since returning from the Injured List on June 13. The veteran outfielder ranks 4th in the Southern League with a .856 OPS with six doubles, a triple, eight home runs, 20 RBIs, and 18 walks over that span.

COLÁS BROUGHT THE BOOM IN JULY: Rocket City outfielder Oscar Colás is 3rd in all of Double-A with six home runs in July, plus he has three doubles, 15 RBIs, and 11 runs scored. On July 3 vs. Knoxville, Colás recorded his first career three-homer game, hitting solo home runs to lead off the third, fourth, and sixth innings. This marked only the second three-homer game in franchise history, the first being Orlando Martinez's performance on May 7, 2021, at Chattanooga

RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, the youngest player in the Southern League at just 19 years and 11 months, has reached in 16 of his last 17 games, and ranks 2nd in the league and 4th in all of Double-A with 34 stolen bases this season—19 of which came in a blistering month of May. His 34 steals already rank 3rd in Trash Pandas single-season history, trailing only his own mark of 35 from last year and Kyren Parris' franchise record of 44 set in 2023. Rada **ranks among the league leaders** in **stolen bases** (2nd, 34), **OBP** (5th, .384), **batting average** (8th, .281), and **hits** (T-8th, 89). Rada has recorded a team-best 26 multi-hit games, including five three-hit games.

ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

- **BEN JAMMIN':** INF **Ben Gobbel** has belted four home runs in his last 16 games, including his second career multi-homer performance on July 8 at Chattanooga—the first also came against the Lookouts on June 6, 2024, at Toyota Field. Since rejoining the Trash Pandas on June 17.
- GUZMAN AND BROWN GO BACK-TO-BACK FOR LEAGUE POW: INF Denzer Guzman was named Southern League Player of the Week for July 1-6 after leading the league with a 1.316 OPS and seven extra-base hits, along with six RBIs and six walks during a six-game series against Knoxville. One week later, INF Sam Brown earned the honor for July 8-13, posting a league-best .444 batting average (8-for-18) over five games in Rocket City's road series at Chattanooga. Brown added four extra-base hits, six RBIs, five walks, four runs scored, and a 1.398 OPS—also the highest in the league that week. Guzman and Brown became the 13th and 14th players in Trash Pandas history to win the award, and for the second consecutive season, Rocket City produced back-to-back weekly honorees, following Tucker Flint (Aug. 12-18) and Christian Moore (Aug. 5-11) in 2023.
- BACK FROM THE FUTURES GAME: RHP George Klassen made a brief but electric appearance for the American League squad at the Futures Game on July 19, throwing 11 pitches in the bottom of the third inning. He fired two 99 mph heaters—striking out Chicago's Owen Caissie. The No. 3 prospect for the Angels was the only representative for the Angels and became the sixth Rocket City player to earn a Futures Game selection, joining RHP Caden Dana ('24), OF Kyren Paris (' 23), C Edgar Quero (' 23), RHP Ky Bush (' 22), and LHP Reid Detmers ('21).
- KEEPIN' IT QUALITY: Starter Joel Hurtado, has not made a start since June 20, but still ranks third in the Southern League with seven quality starts, and ranks fifth in the Southern League with a 3.10 ERA.
- ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: On July 3, INF Chad Stevens made his MLB debut for the Angels, becoming the seventh this season, and 43rd all-time Trash Panda to make their MLB debut. In 17 games for Rocket City in 2024, he hit .316 with two homers, 10 RBIs, and two stolen bases over 17 games. He joins former Pandas, Robinson Piña (debuted on June 20), Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 17), who all debuted this year.
- NEW HALF, NEW TRASH PANDAS: In June, the Trash Pandas had 25 roster moves impact the roster, with 10 moves coming on June 17. Only 17 of the current 28-man roster were active on May 19. Newcomers joining the club in June include OF Oscar Colás (6/3), 18 Evan Edwards (6/3), INF David Mershon (6/17), INF Ben Gobbel (6/17), LHP A.J. Block (6/17), RHP Sam Ryan (6/17), while OFTravis Blankenhorn (IL, 6/7), C Jaxx Groshans (Dev. List, 6/24) and RHP George Klassen (IL, 6/1) have been reinstated from the IL, or Dev. List.
- THE STREAK IS OVER!!: The Trash Pandas dropped a Southern League record 16 straight games from June 14 to July 2. The streak was the longest in Minor League Baseball this season. The streak surpassed the previous Southern League mark set by the Columbus (GA) Astros in 1971, dropping 15-straight games from May 17-June 1, 1971. That season, the Southern League and Texas League played an interlocking schedule and referred to the agreement as the "Dixie Association".
- PROSPECTS WITH A HALO: The Trash Pandas roster features four of the Angels' top 11 prospects and eight of the top 20 in MLB Pipeline's newest prospect rankings released on July 22; included in the top 11 are RHP George Klassen (3), OF Nelson Rada (6), LHP Sam Aldegheri (8), and INF Denzer Guzman (11). The other members of the roster included in the Top-30 include LHP Samy Natera Jr. (16), RHP Walbert Ureña (17), RHP Joel Hurtado (19), and RHP Camden Minacci (20).
- THE YOUNG GUNS: The Trash Pandas have three of the nine youngest players in the Southern League. For the second-straight year, OF Nelson Rada is the youngest player in the Southern League at 19.9 years old (8/24/05), the only player in the league born in 2005. INF Denzer Guzman is the eighth-youngest at 21 years old (2/8/04), and RHP Walbert Urena is the ninth-youngest, just 14 days older than Guzman, born on 1/25/04, 21 years old (1/25/04).
- **DELAYING THE LAUNCH:** From June 12-29, the Trash Pandas endured 9 hours and 20 minutes of weather delays, and during the last homestand, June 10-25, they faced delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games impacted by rain delays or postponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground.com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days.
- MAY WAS A GOOD MONTH FOR BROWN AND RADA: Over 26 games in May, Sam Brown finished 4th in the league in batting at .301 (28-for-93), with eight extra-base hits, and 14 RBIs, and Nelson Rada finished 2nd in batting at .325 (27-for-83), and 2nd in OBP (.467). Rada led all of Double-A and was 3rd in Mil B with 19 stolen bases
- ANOTHER WALK-OFF AT TOYOTA FIELD: The June 11th walk-off single in the 10th inning by Cole Fontenelle was the second of the season for the Trash Pandas. This was the first walk-off since Denzer Guzman hit a walk-off homer in the ninth inning on April 5 against Chattanooga. Overall, it marked the 24th walk-off victory for the Trash Pandas at Toyota Field.
- MLB EXPERIENCE: The Tash Pandas boast seven players on the roster with Major League experience after the recent additions. Sam Aldegheri made his MLB debut on August 30, 2024, for the Angels, vs. Seattle, and made three starts for the Angels over the remainder of the season. Kelvin Cáceres made his debut for the Angels on September 27, 2023, vs. Texas, and appeared in two total games that season. Jesus Cruz made his MLB debut for on August 18, 2020 for the Cardinals, and has appeared in eight games between the Cardinals ('20) and Braves ('22). Jordan Holloway made his MLB debut on July 26, 2020, for the Marlins, and appeared in 15 games (4 starts) for Miami from 2020-2023, posting a 3.29 ERA. Sean Poppen made his MLB debut on June 19, 2019, for the Twins and has appeared in 63 games for the Twins (10), Pirates (3), Rays (1), and Diamondbacks (49) since 2019, posting a 5.08 career ERA. José Quijada made his MLB debut for the Marlins on April 24, 2019, against Cleveland, and has appeared in 140 games for the Marlins (34) and Angels (106) since 2019, logging a 4.64 ERA and eight saves. The only position player with MLB experience is Travis Blankenhorn, who made his MLB debut on September 15, 2020, for the Twins against the White Sox. Overall, he's played in 49 career games for the Twins (2), Mets (24), and Nationals (23) since 2020.
- FONTENELLE'S CYCLE: Not only was Cole Fontenelle's cycle on April 8 vs. Knoxville the first in Trash Pandas history, but it was the first in the Southern League since former Smokies star Moises Ballesteros did it on June 15, 2024, at Biloxi. Fontenelle led off each at-bat, which has only been done once in MLB history, by Todd Helton in 1999 against the Florida Marlins. The last LA Angels' minor league player to hit for the cycle was José Rojas, who hit for the cycle on May 11, 2018, while playing for the Double-A Mobile BayBears. Rojas completed his cycle with a grand slam in the eighth inning, leading the BayBears to a 14-3 win over the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park.
