**Today:** It's White Claws & Paws, with \$5 White Claws and dogs welcome to the ballpark, with the Lugnuts played the fifth game of a six-game series against the Fort Wayne TinCaps, High-A affiliate of the San Diego Padres. After dropping the opener, the Lugnuts have won the last three games of the series, putting them in position to clinch a series victory with a win today.

Last Night: Lugnuts 3, TinCaps 1. It was a night for the LSU Tigers, as college teammates Gage Jump fired 6 2/3 scoreless innings with 13 strikeouts while Tommy White delivered an RBI double in the first inning and a tie-breaking RBI single in the eighth to lift the Nuts to the Friday night triumph.

On Deck: Tomorrow is a Capital City Market Kids Day featuring Kids Run the Bases, concluding this six-game series with Fort Wayne. After a day off on Monday, the Lake County Captains arrive in town on Tuesday to open their own six-game series in Lansing.

### Lug•Notes

Atop the League: The Lugnuts' offense leads the Midwest League in batting average (.281), base hits (177), fewest strikeouts (124) and on-base percentage (.389). Lansing has scored 100 runs this season, trailing only West Michigan (121).

Streaking: Though Nate Nankil (0-for-4 yesterday) had his team-high 15-game on-base streak end yesterday, Clark Elliott (1-for-1, two walks) extended his own streak to 14 games; Cole Conn (1-for-4) has hit safely in 10 straight games; Tommy White (2-for-4) has hit safely in 10 straight games and reached base in his last 12 games; and T.J. Schofield-Sam (0-for-3, HBP) has reached base in his last 12 consecutive games.

**Heating Up: Tommy White** opened the season 0-for-11 at Fort Wayne and 4-for-24 vs. Great Lakes. Since then, the former LSU Tiger is batting .442 (19-for-43) with six doubles and a home run, raising his average to .295 and his OPS to .825.

Where are the Lefties? Today is the 20th Lugnuts game of the season... and the 20th straight game that the Nuts will face a right-handed starter. Lansing has only had 91 at-bats this season against southpaws compared to 317 against right-handers. Then again for the opposition's sake, that might be a good thing – the Nuts are batting .275 vs. lefties compared to .256 vs. righties (albeit with an .809 OPS).

**Jump Man:** Yesterday's 13-K gem by **Gage Jump** marked the first time that a Lugnuts pitcher had struck out 10 batters in an outing since **Jake Garland** achieved the feat with 10 strikeouts in seven innings in his Lansing debut on May 18, 2023, vs. Wisconsin. Jump came four strikeouts away from matching **Aaron Krawiec**'s franchise single-game record of 17 strikeouts from April 29, 2001.

**The Big Club:** 2023 Lugnuts shortstop **Jacob Wilson** is in the early mix for American League Rookie of the Year, and last night won't hurt his cause. Wilson went 3-for-4 with a home run, helping the A's beat the White Sox, 6-5, and is now hitting .347 this season, 4th best in the Majors. He is tied for 5th in MLB with 34 base hits.

**Soder Pop:** 2022 Lugnuts catcher **Tyler Soderstrom**, now playing 1B and LF for the A's, is tied for the Major League lead with nine home runs, tied for 4th in total bases (62) and 5th in slugging percentage (.620).

**Prospecting:** The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman **Tommy White** (40th overall), southpaw starter **Gage Jump** (73rd), shortstop **Joshua Kuroda-Grauer** (75th) and outfielder **Rodney Green, Jr.** (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 19. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old **Steven Echavarria**, rated No. 12, and outfielder **Nate Nankil**, who is No. 29.

**DK** at the Helm: The 19th manager in Lugnuts history is **Darryl Kennedy**, entering his second year in the A's organization. Kennedy distinguished himself as a catcher at Manatee Community College before starring at the University of North Florida and was named an NCAA All-American in 1991 en route to North Florida's Hall of Fame, inducted in 2017. Kennedy played in the Minor Leagues for seven seasons, including parts of four seasons in Triple-A. Following his 1997 retirement, he immediately began managing, leading the Gulf Coast League Rangers to the 1998 GCL Championship.

2008: Future Major Leaguer Neftali Feliz struck out eight Lugnuts while allowing two hits and one walk in five scoreless innings, but the Lugnuts scored five runs in the 8th to win at Clinton, 6-1.

2011: SS Gustavo Pierre committed a franchise record four errors (two throwing, one missed catch, one fielding) and went 0-for-4 with three strikeouts in a 5-3 loss at home to Great Lakes. The bad day brought Pierre's error total to 15 errors in 17 Lugnuts games.

2024: The Nuts trailed Dayton 13-1 entering the bottom of the eighth inning before exploding for nine runs (aided by three runscoring wild pitches!), but lost 14-10 on a wild Friday night. Dragons first-rounder Rhett Lowder started the game, whiffing nine batters while allowing one unearned run in six innings.

Gatorade, Not Gator: Echavarria posted a 0.28 ERA with 80 strikeouts in 50 innings as a senior at Millburn High School, allowing only one extra-base hit the whole season. He was named New Jersey's 2022-2023 Gatorade High School Baseball Player of the Year and the top prep prospect in the state. Initially committed to Oregon, he changed his commitment to the University of Florida as his senior year dawned, but then signed with the A's for \$3 million to head into professional baseball - the only New Jersey high schooler taken in the 2023 MLB Draft.

19-year-old Steven Echavarria is part of an exclusive club: players who suited up for the Lugnuts as teenagers. Future Major Leaguers include 19-year-old Max Muncy, who joined the Nuts for the final 42 games of 2022; 19-year-old Gabriel Moreno, who homered in his first Lugnuts at-bat in 2019; Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. and Bo Bichette, who were 18 and 19 respectively when they dominated the 2017 Midwest League and appeared in the Futures Game; 18-year-old Carlos Beltrán, who was in the Lugnuts' very first Opening Day lineup on April 5, 1996; and the 1999 Lugnuts teenage duo of 19-year-old Corey Patterson, who was named the Midwest League Prospect of the Year, and 18-year-old Carlos Zambrano, who won 13 games and worked 153 1/3 innings.

Path to Lansing: After signing, Echavarria debuted in instructional league ball in 2023. He was slated to pitch in the 2024 Spring Breakout for the A's against the Giants, but the game was canceled due to rain. On May 2, 2024, Game 22 of the Stockton Ports' season, he made his official professional debut, starting against Visalia and working three scoreless innings before allowing two unearned run in the fourth... posted 9.00 ERA in six May starts (20 R/18 ER in 18 IP)... limited opposition to one run or fewer in nine of his final 13 starts of the year, including stretch from June 25-August 4 with just 2 ER allowed in 25 2/3 IP... vs. right-handers: .306/.386/.387, 1 HR, 5 GiDP... vs. left-handers: .316/.431/.474, 3 HR, 1 GiDP... best inning was the fourth inning: 3-for-26, .115 avg. against... base-stealers were successful in 11 of 13 attempts.
