### JUMBO SHRIMP BLANK SOUNDS 10-0

Jacksonville (18-26) snapped their eight-game losing streak in their 10-0 blanking of Nashville Saturday night. The offense started early with two bases loaded walks in the first. In the third, **Victor Mesa Jr.** drew a walk and scored on a double from **Jonah Bride**. Three batters later, **Javier Sanoja** knocked the second double of the inning, plating Bride to give the Jumbo Shrimp a 4-0 advantage. The bats stayed hot for Jacksonville in the fourth as **Xavier Edwards** led off with a triple and scored on a base hit from **Tim Anderson**. A Bride double later scored Anderson for a 6-0 lead. The Jumbo Shrimp plated four more runs for a commanding 10-0 win over the Sounds.

### TOUGH TIMES DON'T LAST

With their 10-0 win vs. Nashville last night, Jacksonville has won two of its last 17 games. Previously, they suffered their worst stretch since at least 2005 (losing 15 of their last 16 contests). The Jumbo Shrimp have struggled in nearly every facet of the game during this stretch. Offensively over this stretch, the club ranks 26th in Triple-A in batting average (.230), 29th in OBP (.316), 27th in SLG (.354), 27th in OPS (.670), 24th in hits (133) and 28th in runs scored (65). On the other side of the ball, Jacksonville has surrendered 155 hits, which is ninth and tied for the 12th-most runs (94) on tied for the 11th-worst BAA (.266) and 16th-worst OPS-against (.785).

### TO THE VICTOR GO THE SPOILS

Jacksonville outfielder **Victor Mesa Jr.** missed the first six games of the season with an injury, but the 22-year-old has quickly made up for that lost time. In 35 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp, Mesa Jr. is 39-for-144, slashing .271/.338/.465/.803 with seven doubles, seven home runs, 28 RBIs, 15 walks and 25 runs scored. In 123 games last season with Double-A Pensacola, Mesa Jr. struck out in 22.9 percent of his plate appearances. He has shaved that to 18.8 percent this season with Jacksonville.

### ALWAYS THE BRIDE, NEVER THE BRIDESMAID

Jumbo Shrimp infielder **Jonah Bride** has had two short stints in the major leagues this season, batting 2-for-12. With Jacksonville, however, Bride is 37-for-119 (.311/.462/.639/1.101) with 10 doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 24 RBIs, 30 walks and 21 runs scored in 35 games played. The Owasso, Okla., native ranks third in the IL in OPS, fourth in slugging percentage, third in on-base percentage, tied for tied for eighth in walks, tied for 10th in home runs and tied for fifth in extra-base hits (20). After posting a 22.4 percent line drive rate and 30.6 percent pull rate with Triple-A Las Vegas in 323 plate appearances in 2023, Bride has compiled a 29.5 percent line drive rate (89th in Triple-A).

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 29 of Jacksonville's 44 games (65.9 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 11 of the last 13 contests and 14 of the club's last 17 affairs. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 13 of its last 14 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 13-16 in these affairs.

### WALK OF LIFE

Jacksonville pitching has excelled thus far in 2024 in not giving out free passes to opponents. The club's 156 walks issued are the second-fewest in the International League entering play on Sunday. Of late, the Jumbo Shrimp have upped their game to a new level, walking three batters or fewer in nine of the last 14 games. On the season, Jacksonville's pitching staff has walked three batters or fewer in more than half of the club's games, a total of 24 out of 44 contests (54.5 percent).

### TWO DOWN, A MILE TO GO

Over the club's last 14 games dating back to May 3, the Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 80 runs (5.7 per game), which ranks as the 12th-most in Triple-A during that span. Of those 80 runs, a whopping 44, or 55.0 percent, have come with two outs. On the season, Jacksonville pitching has ceded 135 hits in 124.0 innings pitched with two outs, the second-most in Triple-A. Opponents are hitting .268 with an .800 OPS against the Jumbo Shrimp with two down, which respectively place as the sixth- and eighth-highest marks at the level.

### SHRIMP BITES

With their 10-0 win last night, Jacksonville avoids losing their most consecutive games. Since at least 2005 a Jacksonville team hasn't lost more than eight-straight.

### ABOUT RODDERY

-Originally signed by the Atlanta Braves on June 11, 2018 as a non-drafted free agent.

-On July 17, 2023, the Washington Nationals claimed Muñoz off waivers from Atlanta. The Pittsburgh Pirates then claimed Muñoz on waivers on December 1, 2023, and after designating him for assignment, they traded him to Miami on December 20, 2023 for cash considerations.

### 2024 SEASON

-Made major league debut for Miami on April 20 against the Cubs, pitching five innings, allowing two runs on two hits with one walk and seven strikeouts.

-Earned first career MLB win on May 1 in a start against the Colorado Rockies in which he ceded only one run on three hits in 6.0 innings. He struck out seven against two walks..

### 2023 SEASON

-Between the Rookie-level FCL Braves, Double-A Mississippi, Triple-A Gwinnett and Triple-A Indianapolis in 2023, posted a 4-6 record and 5.42 ERA in 34 games, including 14 starts (78.0 IP, 70 H, 53 BB, 81 K).

-Last season in Triple-A, he went 1-3 with a 7.20 ERA in 10 starts (35.0 IP, 35 H, 26 BB, 36 K, .259 BAA). As a reliever, he was 2-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 18 appearances (31.0 IP, 28 H, 20 BB, 32 K, .239 BAA).

-Muñoz posted extreme platoon splits in Triple-A. He held right-handed hitters to a .217/.329/.357/.686 line in 170 plate appearances. Left-handed batters slashed .291/.418/.545/.963 against him in 134 plate appearances.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit just .213/.346/.354/.700 against Muñoz, but with runners on base, they batted .286/.391/.524/.915 against him.

### 2022 SEASON

-Split the 2022 season with High-A Rome and Mississippi, collecting an 8-4 record and 4.66 ERA in 22 games, all starts (100.1 IP, 97 H, 42 BB, 119 K).
