Longest Win Streak: Longest Losing Streak:

On this day in 2021, the Sounds completed their second consecutive six-game sweep with a 9-3 win at Columbus. Outfielder Tyrone Taylor led the attack with a 3-for-4, 2B, HR, 3 RBI performance. The win moved Nashville to 18-5 on the season, in franchise history.

Brewers on Rehab: Luke Voit and Luis Urías continued their rehab stints on Sunday. Voit smashed three hits, including a double, and drove in three. The first baseman was returned to Milwaukee and designated for assignment on Monday. Urías broke out of his 0-for-13 slump with a three-hit day, also lining a double and picking up an RBI. The infielder is batting .167 (3-for-18) through four rehab games with Nashville.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the their best start through 23 games manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 625-543 record during an eight-season span.
