Last Night: Lugnuts 8, TinCaps 3. Lansing knocked out Fort Wayne starter Clark Candiotti two outs into the game with a three-run 1st inning, broke a 3-3 tie in the third on a Casey Yamauchi two-run single, and cruised to victory behind Rodney Green, Jr.'s fifth home run of the year and four innings of one-hit shutout relief.

On Deck: Tomorrow is Page Fence Giants Night, with the Lugnuts wearing the uniforms of the dominant Black pro baseball team of the 1890s, whose story was revealed by Williamston historian Mitch Lutzke. Tomorrow will also feature a tribute to the life and legacy of Jackie Robinson.

All Things Considered: The Nuts' overall team batting average of .279 is 19 points higher than the Midwest League's second highest team, West Michigan. Lansing also leads the league in base hits (157), fewest strikeouts (111), on-base percentage (.393) and OPS (.794).

UPCOMING SCHEDULE

Streaking: Nate Nankil (1-for-4 yesterday) has reached base in 14 straight games; Clark Elliott (1-for-3, walk) has reached base in 13 straight; Cole Conn (1-for-4, walk) has hit safely in nine consecutive games; and Tommy White (2-for-5) has hit safely in eight straight games and has reached base in his last 10 consecutive games.

Heating Up: Speaking of Tommy White, the third baseman opened the season 0-for-11 at Fort Wayne and 4-for-24 vs. Great Lakes. Since then, the former LSU Tiger is batting .441 (15-for-34) with four doubles and a home run, raising his average to .275 and his OPS to .789 for the season.

The Conn Man: UIC Flames product Cole Conn has been hot all season, collecting an RBI single and a walk yesterday in five trips to place his batting average at .455, his OBP at .581 and slugging percentage at .697. Conn has reached base 25 times and scored 12 runs in nine games, thanks to 15 base hits, seven walks and three HBPs. The performance has gained him notice; Conn was the subject of yesterday's "Locked on A's" podcast, which normally focuses on the Major League club.

Welcome to the Show: The Athletics had a noteworthy MLB debut last night, with 2024 first-rounder Nick Kurtz becoming the 23,432nd player in Major League history. The slugging first baseman - who jumped over the Nuts on his way up the A's ladder delivered an RBI single in his first plate appearance to help key a 5-2 victory over the Texas Rangers. 2021-22 Lugnut Lawrence Butler homered for the second straight day and 2023 Lugnut Mason Miller struck out the side in a scoreless 9th for his seventh save, tying for 5th in the Majors. Miller has struck out 17 batters while allowing only four hits and one walk in eight scoreless innings this year.

Dialing Long Distance: Not only did Lugnuts outfielder Rodney Green, Jr. tie for the Midwest League lead with his fifth home run of the season last night, Stockton Ports infielder Myles Naylor crushed a grand slam for his own fifth homer of the year, taking the California League lead in roundtrippers. Both are chasing the promoted Kurtz, who slugged seven homers for Las Vegas to tie for the MiLB lead.

Prospecting: The Nuts boast the A's second, third, fourth and fifth selections in the 2024 draft: slugging third baseman Tommy White (40th overall), southpaw starter Gage Jump (73rd), shortstop Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (75th) and outfielder Rodney Green, Jr. (104th). White is rated the A's No. 7 prospect, Kuroda-Grauer is No. 10, Jump is No. 13 and Green is No. 19. The Lugnuts also have 19-year-old Steven Echavarria, rated No. 12, and outfielder Nate Nankil, who is No. 29.

2010: Ride the rollercoaster: The Lugnuts scored three runs in the bottom of the 8th to take an 8-6 lead over Dayton, watched the Dragons tie the score against Brian Slover in the 9th, and then walked off in the 10th on an Oliver Dominguez one-out RBI double, 9-8. It was all part of a three-game home sweep of Dayton, turning the tables after the Dragons swept the Lugnuts in three games at Fifth Third Field to start the year.

2017: Edward Olivares hit for the cycle, finishing with a two-run triple in the eighth, and the Lugnuts beat the South Bend Cubs, 11-5, at Cooley Law School Stadium. It was the first cycle for a Nut since 2010 (Brad Glenn) and the third consecutive game that the Nuts had scored at least 11 runs.



Garrett Irvin stranded two runners... the Timber Rattlers tied the game at 3-3 on a Jadher Areinamo home run in the 8th off Hunter Breault, only to see Clark Elliott triple in the 9th and get balked in for the winning run in a 4-3 Lugnuts victory... for Robinson: 83 pitches, 56 strikes, 9 ground outs | 2 air outs | 3 strikeouts.

In a Nutshell: One of five 2024 draft picks on the Lugnuts' 2025 Opening Day roster, joining Tommy White (2nd round), Gage Jump (2nd round compensatory), Joshua Kuroda-Grauer (3rd round) and Rodney Green, Jr. (4th round)... made his Lugnuts debut on April 6 at Fort Wayne, tossing two scoreless innings with three strikeouts to earn the win in Lansing's 5-3 victory... made first MWL start on April 10 vs. Great Lakes: allowed two-out, two-run Joe Vetrano double in 3rd (unearned due to a Sahid Valenzuela error), breaking 1-1 tie; tossed five innings in all; suffered the loss in Lugnuts' 3-2 defeat.

Welcome to Pro Ball: Signed for \$150,000 after being selected with the first pick of Day 3 by the A's... made pro debut for Stockton on August 23, 2024 (2 IP, 3 H, 2 R, 1 BB, 2 K)... made three starts in total before Stockton's season ended, allowing exactly two earned runs in each outing... lefties hit .333 (6-for-18) with 1 BB / 6 K, while righties hit .273 (3-for-11) with 2 BB, 3 K... base-stealers went 2-for-2... pitched in the 2025 Crosstown Showdown, tossing two scoreless innings against Michigan State in relief of Yunior Tur.

Texas Tech: Robinson opened up his time in Lubbock as a reliever in 2022, appearing in 12 games (including nine appearances without allowing an earned run)... as a sophomore, was named to the 2023 Collegiate National Team; posted 5.36 ERA in 45 1/3 innings before finishing strong, posting five scoreless innings with eight strikeouts in the Big 12 Tournament against Oklahoma State to earn a nod on the All-Tournament Team, then limited No. 2 Florida to two ER in five innings in the NCAA Tournament... as a junior, led the Red Raiders with 76 IP in 15 starts, with a 5.09 ERA; struck out 11 in six innings at Oklahoma State on May 11, 2024... drafted following junior year... notable Texas Tech pros include Josh Tomlin, Danny Coulombe, Josh Jung, and the inimitable Dallas Braden.
