AMARILLO, TX - While the Northwest Arkansas Naturals jumped out to an early lead in the first, the team entered the ninth inning trailing by five runs. Six straight reached with two outs in the ninth, but the comeback fell a run short, as the Amarillo Sod Poodles took the game, 11-10.

- For the third straight game, the Naturals lived for the long ball, with **Tyler Gentry** giving Northwest Arkansas a 3-0 lead in the first on a three-run homer, his fourth of the week.
- While the Sod Poodles inched towards the Naturals with single runs in the first and third, **Logan Porter** added a run of insurance in the third on a sac fly. **Nick Loftin** led off the fifth with a home run, his fourth of the week as well, his fourth straight game with a home run. Loftin became the first Natural to homer in four straight games since **Will Myers** did so from May 5 to 8 in 2012.
- After Loftin's home run, Amarillo tagged starter **Noah Murdock** and reliever **Eric Skoglund** for five runs in the bottom of the fifth inning to jump out to a 7-5 lead, as the Sod Poodles stayed on top for the rest of the night.
- Tucker Bradley** brought the Naturals within a run in the sixth, doubling home **Jake Means**, but the Sod Poodles scored a run in the sixth and three in the seventh to stretch the lead to five runs, a score of 11-6.
- Heading into the ninth, the Naturals made two quick outs before cobbling together a two-out rally. **Maikel Garcia** got things started with a bloop single to left field, the Loftin drew a walk. Gentry singled up the middle to score Garcia, then **Robbie Glendinning** drilled a three-run homer to the opposite field, a line drive to right that brought the Naturals within a run, 11-10. Still with two outs, Porter walked and **John Rave** singled, putting the tying run on third and go-ahead run at first, but after six straight reached with two outs Amarillo brought in a new arm from the bullpen and the runners were stranded on and the Naturals dropped their 15th one-run game of the season.

THIS DAY IN NATURALS HISTORY

The Naturals are 6-5 all-time when playing on July 2

On July 2, 2019, the Northwest Arkansas Naturals walked off on the Arkansas Travelers, 9-8 in 13 innings at Arvest Ballpark. **Brady Singer** struck out six across 6.0 innings, while throwing 74 of his 99 pitches for strikes (74.75%), tied for the seventh-most strikes ever thrown by a Nationals pitcher and the sixth-best strike %. All nine Nationals had at least one hit, including seven multi-hit performances. Center fielder **Nick Heath** produced a two-homer night as he led off the bottom of the first with a home run, then brought the Naturals within a run in the ninth with his second solo shot of the day. After **Meibrys Voloria** singled home **Gabriel Cancel** to tie the score at 7-7, it remained tied until the 13th, when the Travs took the lead in the top of the inning. In the bottom half, **Angelo Castellano** singled in **Taylor Featherston** to tie the game and **Khalil Lee** singled home Castellano with two outs to walk off.

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Manager Chris Widger enters his first season at the helm of the Naturals, after previous stops in *Advanced Rookie* Burlington (2019) and *High-A* Quad Cities (2021) managing Royals affiliates.

- 18 of the Naturals' 28 active players played for Widger with the Quad Cities River Bandits last season.
- 9 of the Naturals' 28 active players played under Widger with the Burlington Royals, then in Quad Cities and now in Northwest Arkansas: **Dante Biasi, Jonah Dipoto, Maikel Garcia, Jake Means, Noah Murdock, Zack Phillips, Logan Porter, John Rave** and **Ángel Zerpa**.

EXTREME ENDS OF THE SPECTRUM

When looking at the Naturals' numbers one game to the next, it appears rather black and white with what leads to a win or loss.

- When scoring seven runs or more, the Naturals are 26-4, while when scoring six runs or less, just 6-36.
- The Naturals are 20-9 when recording 10 hits or more, but when they get nine hits or less, are just 12-31.
- The Naturals are 30-10 when out-hitting their opponent or hits are tied, but 2-30 when out-hit by their opponent.
- When the Naturals score first, they are 21-13, whereas 11-27 when the opponent scores first ... the Naturals have scored first every game this series, in the first inning every time but have only won once.

ONE RUN GOES A LONG WAY

The Naturals are 3-15 in one-run games this season, meaning 15 of their 40 losses (37.5%) this season have been decided by just one run.

- The Naturals have had the winning run at the plate in eight losses this season (six one-run losses) and had the tying run at the plate or on base in 16 losses this season (including 11 of their one-run losses).

Yo, YOU WANNA SEE SOME REAL SPEED?

Through 72 games, the Naturals have stolen 97 bases in 116 attempts (average 1.35 steals/game, 83.62% success rate).

- 97 steals ranks second in the Texas League, fourth in Double-A and 26th in the Minors.
- Maikel Garcia's** 23 steals (in 26 attempts) ranks third in the Texas League and tied fifth among all Double-A hitters/basestealers.
- The Naturals have pulled off a double steal 14 times, meaning 28 of 97 steals this year (28.9%) have come on a double-steal.
- The Naturals have stolen at least one base in 47 of 72 games this season, including 26 games with two or more steals ... there have been three occasions where the team has stolen five bases, with perfect 5-for-5 steal efforts as a club on 5/13 vs. Wichita and 5/21 @ Arkansas.
- Naturals players have stolen two bases in a game 11 times, led by **FOUR** two-steal games from Garcia.

ROCKIN' ROBBIE

After slumping for much of June, first baseman Robbie Glendinning has begun to heat back up in the last week.

- The West Australian has hits in seven straight games, five of which have been multi-hit games, including four straight to begin the streak ... since June 24, Robbie is hitting .464 (13-for-28) with three doubles, four home runs and a 1.531 OPS, including homers the last two games.
- 19 multi-hit games this season ranks tied third among Naturals hitters, 17 being two-hit games ... Robbie recorded his first 3-hit game on Saturday June 25 against Springfield, a 3-for-4 game with a double and home run.
- He has reached base in 56 of 62 games he's played this season (90.3%), with hits in 41 of 62.
- His homer in the 8th inning on June 25 snapped a drought of 100 plate appearances and 24 games without a home run, the longest between two home runs for any Natural this season.

GAR-SEE YA ON BASE

Shortstop **Maikel Garcia** has reached base in 58 of the 68 games he has played in this season (85.3%), reaching base multiple times on a team-best 38 occasions, including a team-best 22 multi-hit games.

- In 322 plate appearances, the Venezuelan has reached base 117 times (80 hits + 37 walks), for a .365 on-base percentage.
- Garcia has walked 37 times and struck out 56 times, a 0.66 K/BB rate that ranks third among Royals minor league hitters with at least 250 plate appearances.
- The shortstop has the second-most hits in the Texas League (80), ranks third in the league in steals (23) and tied third in doubles (22) ... among all Double-A hitters, tied fourth in hits, tied fifth in steals and tied sixth in doubles.
- Maikel's 22 doubles are the most among all Royals Minor League hitters, while he ranks second in the organization with 80 hits and 23 steals ... he ranks tied second in runs scored (51), tied third in walks (37), sixth in extra-base hits (25), and batting average (.285), seventh in total bases (110) and on-base percentage (.366).
- His 14-game hitting streak between April 27 and May 12 is the longest on the Naturals this year, tied for the 15th-longest in club history and tied for the second-longest in the Texas League this season ... in those 14 games, he hit .397 (23-for-58) with six doubles and a .970 OPS.

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Catcher **Logan Porter** has quietly flown under the radar as one of the top hitters in the Royals system so far in 2022.

- Among full-season Minor League hitters, Porter ranks ninth in on-base percentage (.442) and fifth among all Double-A hitters in OBP ... in the Texas League, he is fourth in OBP and ninth in OPS (.922).
- Among qualified Royals minor league hitters, Porter has the highest on-base percentage, ranks third in OPS and batting average (.299) and fourth in slugging percentage (.480) ... his 41 walks are the second-most in the system, behind Omaha's Nick Pratto (42).
- Porter has reached base in 48 of 53 games he's played this season (90.5%), with hits in 44 of 53 and 17 multi-hit games, nine of which came in May.
- Porter's 17-game on-base streak between May 31 and June 23 is tied with Robbie Glendinning for the longest on the team this season, a stretch where he hit .321 (17-for-53) with 15 walks and a .493 on-base percentage.

LOFTIN THE BALL OVER THE FENCE

Naturals utility player Nick Loftin has loved playing in Amarillo, with home runs in each of the first three games of this series.

- Loftin has gone 4-for-13 at the plate this week, with ALL FOUR hits leaving the ballpark ... a ninth-inning two-run homer on Tuesday, June 28, a first-inning solo homer on Wednesday, June 29, a third-inning homer on Thursday, June 30 and a fifth-inning homer on Friday, July 1.
- Loftin's stretch of four straight games with home runs is just the fourth in Naturals franchise history, the last being Wil Myers from May 5 to 8 in 2012 ... tonight, he'll try and become just the second Natural to homer in five straight games, the only other being Clint Robinson, from August 7 to 12, 2010.
- Loftin is the second player in the Texas League to homer in more than three consecutive games, the other being Frisco's Trey Hair, who left the park in five straight games, June 7 to 12 for the RoughRiders, here in Amarillo against the Sod Poodles.
- Tuesday's home run snapped a 70-plate appearance stretch without a homer, his longest of the season between two home runs, his last having come in the first game of the Naturals' doubleheader at Tulsa on June 9.
- Loftin has reached base in 50 of 61 games where he has at least one plate appearance this season, with hits in 43 of 61 games and a whopping 20 multi-hit games.

Pitchers of the Month (1)

* **May: LHP Drew Parrish** ... started five games and went 3-1 with a 0.59 ERA (2 ER in 30.2 IP) ... only allowed 15 hits and four walks, while striking out 29 opposing hitters ... among qualified Texas League pitchers, threw the most innings and had the lowest ERA and WHIP (0.62), while holding opponents to a .144 average.

Players of the Week (2)

* **April 25 to May 1: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit .417 (10-for-28) across six games with a league-best 19 total bases and nine runs batted in, while tied for the Texas League lead with 10 hits. His 1.221 OPS ranked third among players with at least 20 at-bats, while his .417 average tied for second among that same group.

* **May 23 to May 29: 2B Michael Massey** ... hit a league-best .481 (13-for-27) across six games in Midland, while tied for the league lead with 19 total bases. He drove in nine runs as well, doubling three times with one home run, a go-ahead grand slam on May 24 and collected multiple hits in each of the first five games of the series.

Pitchers of the Week (3)

* **May 2 to May 8: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 7 @ Springfield ... held the Cardinals to just two hits and one walk while striking out four. He retired the first eight he faced and the final five, with five 1-2-3 frames.

* **May 9 to May 15: LHP Drew Parrish** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings on May 13 vs. Wichita ... held the Wind Surge to just three hits and no walks while striking out nine. Between the second and sixth innings, he retired 13 straight batters, retiring the side 1-2-3 in the first inning, as well as the third through sixth.

* **June 6 to June 12: LHP Anthony Veneziano** ... threw 7.0 scoreless innings in a complete-game shutout on June 9 @ Tulsa ... held the Drillers to just three hits and one walk while striking out five, on 79 pitches. Retired the final eight hitters he faced and 11 of the last 12, only needing five pitches for a 1-2-3 seventh inning to end the night.

#27 CHRISTIAN COLÓN • ASSISTANT HITTING COACH

- Christian Colón returns to the organization as the Naturals Assistant Hitting Coach in 2022, following a 12-year professional career.
- He was the Royals first-round pick in the 2010 MLB Draft, scored the winning run in the 2014 AL Wild Card game and had the game-winning hit in the title-clinching Game 5 of the 2015 World Series.
- After being drafted in 2010, Colón ascended to Northwest Arkansas by 2011 and between 2011, 2012 and 2014, played 202 games for the Naturals ... in 2011, Colón led the Texas League in sacrifices (21), while leading the team in at-bats (491) and hits (126). His 21 sacrifices that season are the most a Naturals player has ever recorded in a single season, while 28 overall are tied for the club record.
- During his playing career, he made stops in Miami (2017) and Cincinnati (2019-20) ... spent 2021 with the Rich Baseball-owned Buffalo Bisons (Triple-A, Toronto) before announcing his retirement.
- He also played in parts of four seasons in the Puerto Rican Winter League.
- Christian lives in Cave Springs, Ark. (15 minutes North of Arvest Ballpark) with his wife, Kayla, and three daughters, Marley, Mia and Lucy.



#23 MIKE JIRSCHLE • BENCH COACH

- Mike Jirschele enters his first season as the Bench Coach for Northwest Arkansas after spending last season in the same role for Manager Chris Widger in Quad Cities.
- He served as a Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020 and was on the Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015.

- Prior to his 11-year stint with Omaha, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years (1998-2002), while he held managerial positions with Omaha (1995-97), Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- Jirschele was originally selected by the Texas Rangers in the fifth round of the 1977 MLB Draft and played in 999 minor league games over 13-plus seasons in the Rangers and Royals systems.

- Danny Accola is entering his seventh season with the Royals organization and first as the certified athletic trainer with the Naturals, after serving in the same role with the Quad Cities in 2021.

- Accola graduated from the University of Central Missouri in 2014 and previously held an athletic training internship with the Denver Broncos in 2013.

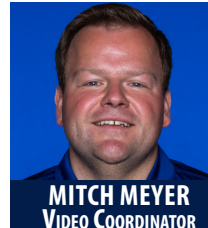
