Shipping Up to Portland

Series Dub Reading won its first series of the season four games to two over Somserset last week. The Fightin Phils captured the series with a 6-3 win on Sunday afternoon. Robert Moore had two hits and two runs scored and a RBI, while Trevor Schwecke added two hits and drove in two runs. Lachlan Wells started and went five

The Fightin Phils begin a six-game series at the Portland Sea Dogs tonight. It is the seventh of 21 matchups between the teams this season, with Portland holding the 4-2 edge. Reading won the series in 2023 11-9 over Portland. Zach Haake starts tonight for Reading, opposite Zach Penrod for Portland.

innings, and the bullpen combined to allow just two hits and one run over the games final-four innings, while adding five strikeouts.

Trifecta of Arms

The Fightin Phils were able to lean on three of its most-consistent pitchers to finish out the game on Sunday against Somerset. Tristan Garnett (7th), Max Lazar (8th) and Tommy McCollum (9th) combined to allow no runs, zero hits and strike out five hitters over the games final three frames. That trio currently own a combined 1.02 ERA, with a 33/2 strikeout to walk ratio over 26.1 innings and 20 games combined. McCollum and Lazar have also combined for six saves. Reading is 6/7 in save oppurtunities this April, after going 3/6 last season. Also the R-Phils have not blown any leads after the 6th, 7th or 8th innings in April.

News and Notes

Reading's win on Sunday gave the R-Phils their first series win of the season. The R-Phils first series win of the season in 2023 came one week later, the first week of May at Hartford. In total, Reading won seven series in 2023. A win on Tuesday will give Reading a .500 record for the month of April, after going 6-14 in the month last season. The last time Reading had a .500 or better record in April was 2019. Of note, there were no April games in 2020 or '21. Marcus Lee Sang has found much success when slotted in the bottom of the lineup. He is hitting .333 in the eight spot, which is his best by any spot in the lineup this season.

Schwecke's Week

Trevor Schwecke had a strong week against Somerset capped off with a Sunday performance that saw him go two-for-four, with a double and two RBI. In total, Schwecke slashed .357/.375/.500, with an .875 OPS. He added a run, two doubles and three RBI. Sunday was hit first multi-hit/multi-RBI game of the season.

Swiper Yes Swiping

Reading had its best week on the basepaths this season, with 12 stolen bases, including a season-best five last Wednesday. The R-Phils 12 stolen bases last week ranked second-best in the Eastern League. They currently sit with the third-most in the league with 29 steals. This comes after Reading finished 10th in the Eastern League with 119 stolen bases in 2023.

Saturday Struggles

So far this season, Reading owns an 0-5 record in Saturday games. In all other days of the week, the Fightin Phls are 10-6. Additionally, Reading is 6-2 on Tuesday-Thursday, and just 4-9 in Friday-Sunday games.

This Day in Baseballtown History

April 30, 1967: At Elmira, Dallas Green tosses a six-hit shutout, walking one and striking out five en route to his second victory as Reading wins, 7-0. Green also drives in a run and scores in a decisive five-run 4th.

Playing Portland

Portland enters today with an 11-8 record and sits in second place in the Northeast Division. Last week, the Sea Dogs went 2-4 at Hartford, incluing dropping the final three games of the series. After this week, Portland remains at home and welcomes Binghamton. Portland went 73-63 in 2023 and narrowly missed out on winning the division in the first half of last season. Portland's roster has nine of Boston's top-30 prospects on its roster, featuring: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (3), Wikelman Gonzalez (5), Nick Yorke (6), Blaze Jordan (19), Eddinson Paulino (22), Hunter Dobbins (25) and Angel Bastardo (26). Blaze Jordan was named Eastern League Player of the Week after hitting .444 (12-28), with four 2B, two HR and 8 RBI.
