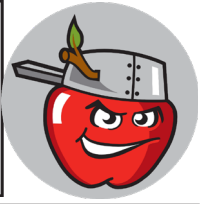

**A SERIES SLEW:** The Loons have scored 40 runs through the first five games of this series. 50 is the most runs in a series for Great Lakes, on June 28th to July 3rd, 2022 vs. Dayton at Dow Diamond. The Midwest League adopted six-game series starting in the 2021 season

**FREE REIN:** Alex Freeland has a 1.121 OPS, the best in the Midwest League. Also, despite missing the first three games of 2024, he is third in the MWL in walks with 16.

**GARCIA GALORE:** Yunior Garcia launched a home run in three straight games played from April 20-24. He's the first Loon since Dalton Rushing on August 25-26, 2023 to do so. Both Garcia and Rushing accomplished the feat against Fort Wayne.

**CROWN NEWELL:** Chris Newell has four home runs, tied for third in the Midwest League. Newell hit a homer in back-to-back games on April 24th. All four of his blasts are on the road.

**SEEMED LIKE IT WOULD NEVIN END:** Kyle Nevin's 14 game on-base streak ended in game two of Wednesday's doubleheader. It was tied for the longest in the Midwest League, starting on opening day.

**QUALITY IN APRIL...:** In seven games, the Loons have had a starter complete five innings. The latest being Jared Karros on Thursday night. Great Lakes had just four starters go five innings all of April 2023.

In three games from April 13-14, Christian Romero, Jared Karros and Peter Heubeck all went five frames. The last time the Loons did that was September 4-7, 2022.

**ROAD WARRIORS:** The Loons offense has fired on all cylinders away from Dow Diamond this season. They have scored double digits in four of 11 road games. Great Lakes have averaged 7.4 runs and are hitting at a .279 clip in away games.

**CAPTIAL PUNISHMENT:** The Loons achieved numerous season highs in a 12-1 seven-inning win, the first of two on April 13th against the Lansing Lugnuts at Jackson © Field™. Great Lakes had their most hits (15), 2B (5), 3B (1) and HR (2). Also, the most runs and hits in an inning with a six-run seven-hit top of the seventh. The next day the Loons once again had 12 runs and 15 hits in the series finale.

**Opening Day Roster Rundown:** 10 players (of 30) spent at least a portion of the 2023 season with GL

- Three players were selected by the Dodgers in the 2023 MLB First-Year Player Draft
- Seven players were drafted by the Dodgers in the 2022 MLB First-Year Player Draft
- 13 players originate from outside the United States (5 Dominican Republic, 3 Venezuela, 3 Mexico, 1 Canada, 1 Puerto Rico)
- Three Loons appear on MLB.com's pre-season list of top 30 Dodgers prospects (Ferris - 8, Liranzo - 10, Miller - 27)
- The top five strikeout leaders with Low-A Rancho Cucamonga in 2023, are on the Loons 2024 Opening Day roster. Heubeck (91), Campos (85), Reinoso (83), Karros (75), Romero (74)
- The average age of the roster is 22.5 years old. With the youngest players being 20 (Liranzo, Ferris) and the oldest at 25 (De La Paz, Reinoso)

**LOON -> SHOW:** In 2024, six former Loons have made their MLB Debut. Landon Knack is the 112th Loon to appear in MLB.

**LAST YEAR CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES:** The Great Lakes Loons appeared in the Midwest League Championship for the second time in their 16-year franchise history.

The Loons made the postseason for the ninth time in ever. Great Lakes became the second team in MiLB to secure a postseason berth. The Loons secured their best half in franchise history with a 45-20 mark, a .692 winning percentage in the first half. Besting the 2010 Loons who went 47-23 in the second half - a .671 winning percentage.

**LOON -> SHOW:** In 2023, eight former Loons have made their MLB Debut. Michael Busch became the 100th Loon to reach the majors.

## Loons Coaching Staff

### MANAGER

#### **Jair Fernandez**

The Great Lakes Loons in conjunction with the Los Angeles Dodgers, named Jair Fernandez as their manager for the 2024 season. Jair Fernandez becomes the 11th manager in the 17-year history of the Loons. Last season, Fernandez served as skipper for the Los Angeles Dodgers Arizona Complex League team, his seventh season coaching in the organization and fourth in Arizona. This will be Jair's second stint with the Great Lakes Loons. He served as the hitting coach in 2017 and 2018. The Loons hit a combined .240 in those two seasons, accumulating 192 home runs. For his home country, Fernandez has served in a multitude of coaching roles. In 2017 and 2023, he coached for Team Colombia in the World Baseball Classic. He manned third base in the 23' Classic. In the Colombian League, played annually from October to January, Fernandez managed two different franchises from 2016 to 2018. Leones de Monteria for two seasons and Tigres de Cartagena midway through the end of the 2018 campaign. Fernandez, 37, debuted in minor league baseball in 2007 at the age of 18 in the Seattle Mariners organization. The Colombian-born catcher spent nine seasons in baseball, appearing with two teams at the Triple-A level. Fernandez played within four major league organizations, the Mariners, Minnesota Twins, Houston Astros, and Chicago Cubs. Two summers were spent in the Midwest League. In 2008, he was an MWL All-Star with the Beloit Snappers, now the Beloit Sky Carp. Beloit was a then affiliate of the Twins. He had 36 hits in 36 games, batting .283 and posting a .703 OPS. Before that season, he was traded from the Mariners organization to the Twins organization for 34-year-old R.A. Dickey. Fernandez totaled 470 games in his minor-league career, 31 at the Triple-A level including two with Oklahoma City, in 2012. Since 2015, Oklahoma City has been a Dodgers affiliate.

### PITCHING COACH

#### **David Anderson**

David Anderson continues his rise through the ranks of the Dodgers organization as the pitching coach for the Loons for a third season. Anderson, 27, joined the L.A. system as a development coach in 2020, and was assigned as the pitching coach for the organization's Arizona Complex League team in the 2021 season. He led his staff to the fourth-lowest ERA in the ACL at 4.06, the third-most strikeouts (617 in 488.0 innings pitched), and the second-best walks and hits per innings pitched. Anderson, a 2015 graduate of Muhlenberg College, got his start in coaching at his alma mater, serving as pitching coach for the NCAA Division III school in Allentown, Pa., for two years immediately after his graduation. After that, he became a volunteer assistant for Cornell in 2017 before landing at Atlanta's Emory University, serving as the school's pitching coach and recruiting coordinator. While in the college ranks, Anderson also got head coaching experience in summer collegiate ball as manager of the Watertown (N.Y.) Rapids of the Perfect Game Collegiate Baseball League in 2018, leading the team to a 26-21 record in its inaugural season. He then went on to manage the now-defunct Fayetteville (N.C.) SwampDogs of the Coastal Plain League in 2019. Anderson, a native of Syracuse, N.Y., tossed four seasons at Muhlenberg. As a junior in 2014, he posted a 3.14 ERA over 63.0 innings, all as a starter. He walked just seven batters that season while striking out 28. He served as team captain as a senior, and led the team that year in innings pitched and strikeouts. After college, Anderson tested the waters in independent baseball. He appeared 16 times for the Newburgh Newts of the North Country Baseball League, with a stellar 2.38 ERA and seven saves. He then threw to a 2.67 ERA with the Bridgeport Bluefish of the Atlantic League, an MLB Partner League.

### PITCHING COACH

#### **Richard De Los Santos**

Richard De Los Santos returns for a third year as a member of the coaching staff after serving as Assistant Pitching Coach in 2022. This year, Anderson and De Los Santos will share the title of Pitching Coach. The 38-year-old De Los Santos had a nine-year minor league career as a right-handed pitcher, mostly in the Tampa Bay system. He played a portion of the 2005 season for the Southwest Michigan Devil Rays in Battle Creek, who would be purchased in 2006 by the Michigan Baseball Foundation and become the Loons in 2007. De Los Santos pitched in 36 games over three seasons for Triple-A Durham, racking up 99 strikeouts in 169 1/3 innings at MiLB's highest level. Over the course of nine seasons in affiliated baseball, the Dominican Republic native accumulated up over 400 strikeouts on the mound.

### HITTING COACH

#### **O'Koyea Dickson**

O'Koyea Dickson, 33, returns to Dow Diamond in a coaching role after spending the 2012 season as a player with the Loons. He was drafted in the 12th round of the 2011 draft by the Dodgers, and made his Major League debut with the club in 2017. 2024 marks Dickson's third year coaching in the Dodgers organization after he worked with Single-A Rancho Cucamonga in 2022 as the team's Hitting Coach. The 2022 Rancho Cucamonga team had the most hits and RBIs in the California League under Dickson's direction. The California native made his Major League debut in September of 2012 for the Dodgers, and appeared in a total of seven games after an injury cut his time in Los Angeles short. His lone hit in the big leagues came off Madison Bumgarner of the San Francisco Giants on September 23, 2017. He hit 24 home runs and drove in 76 runs in that 2017 season for Triple-A Oklahoma City. For the next two years, Dickson had stints in Nippon Professional Baseball, the Atlantic League, the Mexican League and the Pacific Association before entering coaching. Notably in 2007, as a fifteen year old sophomore at George Washington High School, Dickson became the first high-schooler to hit a home run at Oracle Park, then AT&T Park.

### BENCH COACH

#### **Elian Herrera**

Former Loon Elian Herrera is back for a fourth season as the bench coach for Great Lakes. Herrera, a four-year big leaguer, begins his fifth season as a coach within the Dodgers' organization. The second baseman played over 20 games with the Loons in a span of two separate seasons, including the inaugural 2007 Great Lakes Loons, along with nine other future Major Leaguers. He also returned to the Loons for a portion of the 2009 season. From 2012-2018, Herrera played in 324 games at the AAA level, holding a .310 batting average in nearly 1200 plate appearances. Herrera made his major league debut on May 15, 2012 at Dodger Stadium, in a game where Kirk Gibson managed the Arizona Diamondbacks vs. Don Mattingly's Dodgers. Before joining the Loons staff in 2021, Herrera was the bench coach for the Rancho Cucamonga Quakes in 2019, helping lead the team to the playoffs after an 81-57 finish in the regular season, good for first in the South division of the California League.
