## TEEING OFF

TODAY'S GAME: The GreenJackets were held scoreless after the first yesterday in a 3-2 loss to open the series. Kadon Morton takes the ball for his first start on the mound as a GreenJacket after converting from the outfield to pitching this past offseason.

SO LONG, PARTNERS: The GreenJackets bid goodbye to two of their most prolific offensive performers, with both 1B Drew Compton and OF Jace Grady being promoted to High-A Rome. The pairing were 1 and 2 on the team in nearly every offensive category, leaving a canyon-sized hole in an already struggling offense.

OUT OF POSITION: The GreenJackets used three different position players on the mound in Saturday's doubleheader, with Joe Olsavsky, P-0 Boucher, and Kade Kern all making their pitching debuts in the blowout.

TAKE A BOW, MAN: Garrett Baumann twirled his team-high 5th quality start for his 4th win of the year Saturday night, posting 6 scoreless innings. Baumann is now the leader among current Carolina League players in ERA at 1.76 at just 19 years old.

ERROR, PAGE NOT FOUND: The 'Jackets now lead all of Minor League Baseball in errors with 82 in 51 games. Diego Benitez was the MiLB overall leader with 18 when he was reassigned to the FCL.

LOW POWER MODE: The GreenJackets are 12th out of 12 teams in home runs in the Carolina League, with just 17 in 51 games. 8 of the 17 came from Grady and Compton, both of whom have now been promoted out of Augusta and up to Rome.

NEXT TIME OUT: The GreenJackets will try to give run support to Davis Polo, who has been solid all season but has found wins scarce in a series of low-scoring ballgames. For the Pelicans, Jaxon Wiggins will make his Single-A debut. The 68th overall pick in 2023 out of Arkansas was 0-3 in 4 starts in the ACL with a 10.29 ERA to start the year, walking 12. Erian Rodriguez will piggyback behind him.

First time skipper Wynston Sawyer helms the 2024 staff in his first ever managerial position. Nina played 9 seasons in the minors across 5 organizations, while also seeing time in the Chinese Professional League, the Mexican League, and the Atlantic League. The righty began his coaching career with the Helena Brewers from 2009-2013, followed by the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers in 2014 and GCL Pirates from 2015-2017 \& 2019.

HITTING COACH


Einar Diaz follows the rest of the staff up from the FCL level, making his first mark at the Iow-A Ievel. It's the 4th different Braves affiliate for whom Diaz has worked, as he was the hitting coach for the AAA Gwinnett Stripers in 2019, and the AA Mississippi Braves in 2021 prior to his two years on the FCL staff. An 11 year big leaguer known most for his time with the Cleveland Indians, the Panamanian catcher also appeared for the Texas Rangers, Montreal Expos, St. Louis Cardinals, and Los Angeles Dodgers over his career. He got his start coaching in the Orioles system for nearly a decade, working for the Delmarva Shorebirds and managing the Rookie-level Bluefield Orioles before working for the major league club as an assistant hitting coach for 6 seasons.

The youngest member of the coaching staff, Connor Justus will begin his coaching career with the GreenJackets in 2024. The Cartersville, GA native was drafted in the 5th round of the 2016 draft out of Georgia Tech by the Los Angeles Angels and played 4 years in the Halos' system, reaching as high as AA Mobile. Justus spent the 2020 season with the St. Paul Saints, who were in the independent American Association at the time, before returning for one more season of affiliate ball with the Marlins in 2021, splitting between AA Pensacola and AAA Jacksonville. Justus' final stop in his playing career was with the Charleston Dirty Birds of the Atlantic League, where he played 47 games in the infield before hanging the spikes up.
