TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves start a six-game series against Montgomery at Riverwalk Stadium. This is the second to last series between the two clubs this season, with the last six games coming at Trustmark Park from September 13-18. They will meet a total of 30 times, with 15 games at Trustmark Park and 15 games at Riverwalk Stadium.

FIRST MLB REHAB: The M-Braves get their first MLB rehab of the season in RHP Kirby Yates. The reliever had his rehab assignment transferred from the FCL Braves after a scoreless inning with two strikeouts on Saturday, July 26. The reliever is recovering from Tommy John surgery after being placed on the 60-day IL by Atlanta on March 16, 2022. Yates last pitched in an MLB game for San Diego on August 14, 2020.

SWEEPING INTO HISTORY: The M-Braves swept the Rocket City Trash Pandas from July 12-17 at Trustmark Park, completing the first six-game sweep in club history. The M-Braves outscored Rocket City 34-12 in the sweep. The pitching staff posted an astounding 2.00 ERA (12 ER/54.0 IP) with 18 walks to 62 strikeouts. The M-Braves hit .335 with four home runs.

The M-Braves starters gave up just three runs in 26.1 innings. The series was highlighted by seven inning shutouts from LHP Jared Shuster. The club received six scoreless innings from RHP Darius Vines and LHP Dylan Dodd.

STARTING JULY OFF RIGHT: The M-Braves are off to a 13-2 start in July, the best start to the month in the MLB. The latest sweep of Rocket City gives the team its longest win streak of the season. The club posts a 2.52 ERA and .305 AVG (15 HR), which are both second in all of minor league baseball.

THE COMEBACK KIDS RETURN: The M-Braves came from behind in the final inning or later for the sixth time this season on Friday, July 15 against Rocket City. The M-Braves had just two comeback wins in the final inning or later last season. Three of those comebacks have come at Riverwalk Stadium. The M-Braves have walked off five times at Trustmark Park, including back-to-back walk offs on July 7-8.

RELIEVERS TO THE RESCUE: The relief core for the M-Braves leads the Southern League and ranks 3rd in Double-A with a 3.82 ERA this season.

LAST TIME AGAINST THE BISCUITS: The Biscuits took four out of six games against the M-Braves from June 21-26. Drew Lugbauer set the M-Braves career home run record with a solo homer on Tuesday, June 21. The Biscuits won the final three games of the series.

CAN'T MISS THE NEW GUYS: In his first week in Double-A, INF Vaughn Grissom hit .462 (12-for-26) with a triple, home run, five RBI, three runs, and three stolen bases. The Oviedo, FL native posted a 1.154 OPS, hitting in all six games, and logged two three-hit games and a pair of two-hit games. Grissom is ranked as Atlanta's No. 5 prospect, batting .312/15 HR/55 RBI/.891 OPS in 74 games for Rome.

Justyn-Henry Malloy is batting .250 with a homer and six RBI in six games. Malloy blasted a three-run walk-off home run on Friday, July 15. Malloy hit .304/10 HR/44 RBI/.888 OPS in 71 games for Rome. He is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 28 prospect.

LHP Dylan Dodd went six shutout innings in his Double-A debut with seven strikeouts on Sunday, July 17. Dodd went 9-5 with a 3.44 ERA in 89.0 innings over 15 starts for Rome. He is currently ranked as Atlanta's No. 20 prospect.

LHP Lisandro Santos has 3.0 scoreless innings in two relief appearances. Santos posted a 3.40 ERA in 20 appearances, four starts, over 47.2 innings.

THE SLUGBAUER MAKING MISSISSIPPI HISTORY: 1B Drew Lugbauer set club record with seven RBI on Saturday, July 2 at Biloxi, including his team-leading 16th home run. Lugbauer has hit a club record 36 career M-Braves home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021. He homered twice on May 27 at Pensacola where he matched the previous club-record with six RBI.

Lugbauer hit a walk-off three-run homer on Friday, July 8 vs PNS and a walk-off single on Friday, June 3 vs MTG. He is in league's top 10 in...home runs (20, 2nd), RBI (50, T-5th), XBH (39, 2nd), SLG (.493, 8th) walks (47, T-5th), doubles (19, T-4th), and total bases (149, T-1st).

THE FUTURE NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Starter Jared Shuster was named the league's player of the week this past week. He matched a career-high with 7.0 innings, 12 strikeouts, and yielded only two hits while walking none. Atlanta's No. 7 prospect according to MLB Pipeline has a 2.87 ERA through 16 starts, which ranks third in the Southern League. The New Bedford, MA native ranks among the league leaders in opponent's batting average, (.201, 2nd), WHIP (0.98, 2nd), innings pitched (84.2, 2nd) and strikeouts (98, 2nd).

Shuster received an invite to the MLB Futures Game at Dodger Stadium on Saturday, July 16 before the MLB All-Star break, featuring baseball's top prospects from around the league.

VINES SHINES AGAIN: RHP Darius Vines has a 1.85 ERA over his last five starts (6 ER/29.2 IP), 21 strikeouts, seven walks, matching career highs with 7.0 shutout innings on June 25 at MTG, and July 1 at BLX. He leads the league with 104 strikeouts and 88.0 innings pitched while also ranking among the leaders in starts (17, T-2nd), ERA (4.60, 7th) and WHIP (1.33, 6th).

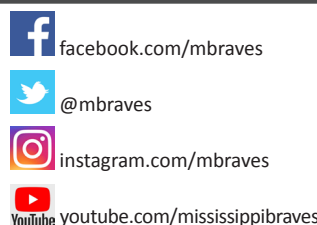

- Jared Shuster makes his 17th start of the season and his fourth start against Montgomery. In his last start, Shuster went 4.1 innings, allowing three runs, one earned, off eight hits with seven strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT

- Shuster logged his team-leading eight quality start, with seven shutout innings against Rocket City on Tuesday, July 12.

2022 NOTES

- Shuster earned Southern League Player of the Week from July 12-17 with seven shutout innings against Rocket City on Tuesday, July 12. He atched a career-high with 12 strikeouts to just two hits and no walks.
- Invited to 2022 MLB Futures Game at Dodger Stadium in Los Angeles, CA on July 16, 2022. He competed against the top prospects in all of baseball.
- Shuster struck out a career-high 12 over 5.0 shutout innings on Saturday, April 16 at Biloxi. He matched a Southern League record by striking out the final eight batters of the outing. The only other four Southern League pitchers to accomplish eight-straight strikeouts: Jim Jefferson (1988, Chattanooga), Dan Miceli (1996, Carolina), Anthony Reyes (2004, Tennessee), Nik Turley (2017, Chattanooga).
- Picked up back-to-back career highs with 7.0 innings in his last two outings (4/22 vs CHA, 4/28 at MTG).

- Split time with High-A Rome and Double-A Mississippi.
- Combined for a 2-0 record in 17 starts with a 4.44 ERA and 90 strikeouts in 73.0 innings
