FIVE STRAIGHT DUBS: The Storm Chasers extended their winning streak to a six games with their first shutout win of the season, a 3-0 victory over the Indianapolis Indians. Omaha has won the first four games of the six-game set, clinching a series win. **RHP Jackson Kowar** tossed 5.0 shutout innings in his fifth start of the year, striking out four and walking two while lowering his season ERA to 1.01. **INF Emmanuel Rivera** slapped a two-run single in the third inning to put the Chasers in front and **INF Ryan McBroom** crushed a solo homer in the eighth to add an insurance run. **RHP Jace Vines** (2.0 IP), **LHP Gabe Speier** (1.0 IP), and **RHP Jake Newberry** (1.0 IP) combined for four scoreless innings of relief to complete the two-hit shutout.

HOME RUN HEROS: The Chasers have hit at least one home run in 10 consecutive games (May 16-pres.) thanks to **INF Ryan McBroom's** solo home run in the eighth inning on Friday. It's Omaha's longest streak of games with at least one home run since 5/8-5/23/2019, when Omaha had 15 straight games with a home run. Omaha is fourth in Triple-A East and leads the Midwest Division with 32 home runs, including 21 during the current 10-game streak.

MORE LIKE McBOOM: **INF Ryan McBroom** has homered in three straight games and five of his last seven games overall while also collected at least one RBI in seven straight games. In that span, McBroom is batting .357 (10-for-28) with one double, five home runs, and eight RBIs while posting a .929 slugging percentage. The 29-year-old has hit in the cleanup spot each time he's been in the lineup this season, playing all but one of Omaha's games.

OLIVARES ON TOP: **OF Edward Olivares** tallied his 11th multi-hit game through 20 games played on Friday and ranks in the top 10 in Triple-A East in most offensive categories. Olivares is third in AVG (.395), fourth in OBP (.473), seventh in SLG (.654), third in runs scored (19), second in hits (32), and tied for fourth in stolen bases (7). He is also third in the league in wOBA (.485) and third in wRC+ (199). Olivares has hit safely in 17 of 20 games and reaching base safely in 18 of 20 games, including a nine-game hitting streak and 14-game on-base streak to start the season. Olivares had hit in the leadoff spot in each of the 20 games he's played.

PROSPECT-STUDED ROTATION: Four of the five members of Omaha's starting rotation is one of the Kansas City Royals top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America*. **LHP Daniel Lynch**, who made his first Omaha start on Tuesday, is the No. 2 prospect in the Royals organization, while **RHP Jackson Kowar** is No. 4, **RHP Ronald Bolaños** is No. 18, and **RHP Scott Blewett** is No. 25. Lynch (No. 21) and Kowar (No. 84) are also both top-100 prospects overall. The Storm Chasers roster currently boasts seven of the Royals' top 30 prospects with the inclusion of position players **OF Kyle Isbel** (6), **OF Edward Olivares** (19), and **INF Lucius Fox** (22).

RIVALRY RENEWED: Tuesday marked the first game between Omaha and Indianapolis since 1997, when both franchises were members of the American Association. Omaha is 269-280 (.490) all-time against Indianapolis during the regular season and 9-11 (.450) in four postseason meetings. Omaha defeated Indianapolis in the 1978 American Association Championship Series while Indianapolis claimed American Association Championship Series wins in 1982-, 1988, and 1989.

FOR OMAHA: **RHP Eddie Butler** starts for the Chasers in a game that was originally scheduled to be started by **RHP Carlos Hernández**, who was recalled by the Royals on Friday. Butler has made six relief appearances since signing as a Minor League free agent and joining Omaha, tossing 6.1 innings with six strikeouts and one walk. Butler was originally drafted in the first round (46th overall) by the Colorado Rockies in the 2012 MLB Draft and made his Major League debut with Colorado in 2014. He split time between Triple-A Iowa and Chicago-NL in 2017 and 2018 before he was traded to Texas midway through the 2018 season. Butler spent the 2019 season with the N.C. Dinos in the KBO and the 2020 season with the Chicago Dogs in the independent American Association.

FOR INDIANAPOLIS: **RHP Beau Sulser** makes his fifth start of the season for Indianapolis. In his last outing, Sulser allowed five runs (two earned) on six hits with three strikeouts and one walk in 4.0 innings at St. Paul. This is Sulser's first season at the Triple-A level and first season as a full-time starting pitcher. He spent the entire 2019 season with Double-A Altoona, where he was named a Midseason Eastern League All-Star, posting a 2.72 ERA in 33 appearances (six starts) with 63 strikeouts and 31 walks in 96.0 innings. Three of his six starts came in his final three outings of the season.

DOPPLER RADAR: The Kansas City Royals reinstated **INF Hunter Dozier** from the 10-day Injured List on Friday, ending his rehab assignment with Omaha... The Royals also recalled **RHP Carlos Hernández** and optioned **INF Ryan O'Hearn** to Omaha... O'Hearn hit .189 (10-for-53) in 20 games with the Royals in 2021 and last played for Omaha in 2019 when he hit .295 with nine home runs in 35 games.
