**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels lost to the Somerset Patriots, 7-5. Richmond opened a 5-0 lead through five innings before the Patriots scored seven straight over the seventh and eighth. **Seth Lonsway** made his Double-A debut and threw six scoreless innings. **Jimmy Glownke** gave Richmond a 1-0 lead in the fourth with a sac fly. In the fifth, **Carter Howell** hit a two-run triple and **Jairo Pomares** added a three-run homer, his team-leading eighth of the year, to open a 5-0 lead. In the seventh, Spencer Jones hit an RBI double to break the shutout and Ben Cowles closed the score to 5-2 with an RBI single. In the eighth, Aaron Palensky hit an RBI single to pull the Patriots within two and Max Burt hit a go-ahead, three-run double to move them ahead, 6-5. An additional run scored on a wild pitch. **Tanner Kiest** worked two scoreless innings out of the Richmond bullpen and struck out five.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Somerset Patriots, Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, in the fifth of a six-game series. The two teams met in a three-game set in New Jersey to open the season in April, with the Patriots taking two-of-three games. This series is the Patriots' only visit to The Diamond this season. The Flying Squirrels are 14-11 this year against teams from the Northeast Division, with a 1-6 record against Somerset and a 13-5 record against the rest of the Northeast.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have dropped four straight games after going 7-2 in their previous nine games and 8-4 on their last 12-game road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. The current losing streak is their fourth of at least three games this season. In the current series, the Flying Squirrels are batting .233 (31-for-133) and have been outscored 29-14 by the Patriots. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .218 and averaging 3.6 runs per game (123 runs/34 games) at home compared to a .238 batting average and 4.9 runs per game on the road (189 runs/39 games). The Flying Squirrels have lost eight consecutive home games dating back to June 6. They started the season 12-5 in home games through May 18 and have gone 4-13 since then.

**THE PATRIOTS** have won four consecutive games to open the second half after dropping their final five games of the first half at home last week against the SeaWolves. Somerset finished the first half with a 32-37 record, which was fourth in the Northeast Division. The Somerset offense leads the Eastern League in homers (79). There are five Somerset players ranked MLB.com's top-30 Yankees prospects list, including OF Spencer Jones (No. 2), LHP Brock Selvidge (No. 10), RHP Zach Messinger (No. 21), RHP Trystan Vrieling (No. 22), 3B Tyler Hardman (No. 25) and RHP Danny Watson (No. 27). Baseball America's top-30 Yankees prospects list includes three Somerset players, including Jones (No. 2), Selvidge (No. 11) and Vrieling (No. 23).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Nick Sinacola** makes his fifth Double-A start. After allowing five runs in his Double-A debut on June 6, he has gone 2-0 with a 1.13 ERA (2 ER/16.0 IP) in his last three starts since June 12, all on the team's last road trip to New Hampshire and Portland. He began the season with High-A Eugene and went 4-1 with a 2.68 ERA in 10 outings, including two starts. At the time of his promotion to Double-A, Sinacola ranked second among Northwest League pitchers (min. 40 IP) in WHIP (0.79), third in BB/9 (1.56), third in BAA (.190), ninth in ERA (2.68), and 10th in K/9 (8.48). He spent the entire 2023 season with the Emeralds and went 2-5 with a 4.58 ERA over 23 outings (20 starts). Sinacola was selected by the Giants in the seventh round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine, where he was the America East Pitcher of the Year that season as a senior. **For more on Sinacola, see page two.**

**FOR SOMERSET:** Right-hander Trystan Vrieling makes his 14th start of the year and his second against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched last Saturday against the SeaWolves and allowed eight runs (seven earned) over five innings. On April 7 at Somerset, he made his professional debut against the Flying Squirrels and threw five scoreless innings, striking out six. He was selected by the Yankees in the third round (100th overall) of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Gonzaga, where he was a teammate of 2023 Richmond pitcher **William Kempner**. He spent the entire 2023 season on the injured list after suffering a stress fracture in his right elbow. Vrieling pitched for Mesa in the Arizona Fall League last year, going 0-1 with a 6.76 ERA in five games. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 21 Yankees prospect and No. 24 by MLB.com.

**CARTER'S CRUISING:** Dating back to June 13, **Carter Howell** is batting .395 (17-for-47) with two doubles, two triples and 11 RBIs. In that stretch, he has picked up three hits three times. He has two triples in his last four games, including an RBI triple on Thursday night. His four triples are tied for the most in the Eastern League this season. For the season, he is leading the Flying Squirrels in batting average (.284), which is ninth-best in the league. He also leads the team in on-base percentage (.358), OPS (.764), hits (65), triples, total bases (93) runs (32) and steals (7).

**KOSS-SOME:** After leading the minors with a .647 batting average (11-for-17), **Christian Koss** was named Eastern League Player of the Week on Monday. In his return to Portland to face his former team, Koss posted a league-leading 1.591 OPS and also led the circuit in hits (11) and doubles (5). He was tied for the league lead in extra-base hits (5), ranked second in OBP (.650) and SLG (.941) and tied for second in runs scored (6). Koss played for the Sea Dogs the last two seasons and was named the team's MVP in 2022. In those two seasons, he played 163 games for the Sea Dogs, batting .252. Koss started the season with Richmond and played three games before an injury placed him on the injured list from mid-April through early-June. In his 22 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, he is batting .408 (29-for-71), which is second-highest in the Eastern League (min. 50 PA) this season, trailing only Portland's Kristian Campbell (.423).

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 17 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .375 (27-for-72) with three homers, five doubles, five walks and 14 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland. In his last 27 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .337 (35-for-104) with six homers, six doubles, 11 walks and 23 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in seven-of-nine games dating back to June 15 and is batting .432 (16-for-37) in that stretch.

**WILL POWER:** **Will Wilson** is batting .317 (13-for-41) with a homer, a double and nine RBIs over his last 10 games dating back to June 16. He has picked up multiple hits in five-of-his-last-10 games, including three hits on June 16, June 19 and in the second game of last Friday's doubleheader at Portland. He hit a solo homer in the second game of last Friday's doubleheader, the 27th of his Flying Squirrels career. He is tied for fourth in franchise history with his 27 home runs, even with **Shane Matheny**, **Sean Roby** and **Devin Harris** while trailing only **Ricky Oropesa** (37), **Jacob Heyward** (33) and **Jarrett Parker** (30).

**TO THE MUNGUIA:** Since being assigned to Richmond on June 19, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .353 (12-for-34) and has added two stolen bases. He has at least one hit in each of his eight games played, including three two-hit games. He played 50 games with Triple-A Sacramento to open the year and batted .250 (36-for-144) in the Pacific Coast League. Munguia played 75 games for the Flying Squirrels last year and hit .282 (83-for-294), which led the team (min. 200 PA).

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked sixth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,879).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Vaun Brown** (No. 10), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 20), C **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 23) and RHP **José Cruz** (No. 28). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list includes four Richmond players, including Brown (No. 15), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19), Sugastey (No. 23) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023) and **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.
