## FRISCO FALLS IN FOURTH-STRAIGHT GAME:

Evan Carter reached base all five times on Wednesday but the Frisco RoughRiders stranded 14 base runners and lost 5-2 to the Tulsa Drillers at Riders Field. Carter had a double, a single and three walks. He has now reached base in seven of his nine plate appearances in the series. Frisco (22-19, 53-56) has dropped the first two games of the series to Tulsa (15-26,56-54). After Carter's leadoff double in the third inning, Trevor Hauver traded places with a double of his own to tie the score at 2-2. Hauver's double was his 19th of the year to lead the team. Keyber Rodriguez led off the second inning with a walk and later scored on an error. He led off the fourth inning with a triple and went 2-for-3. In his last five games, the shortstop has nine hits with four extra base hits. Noah Bremer lasted five innings in his start for Frisco. He allowed 10 batters to reach but allowed just two to score. David Garcia helped get out of a jam in the fourth inning. With the bases loaded, the catcher back-picked a runner at first for the second out of the inning. Bremer went on to leave the bases loaded without a run allowed. The Riders turned a double play in the second inning to help Bremer face the minimum. Rodriguez and Jax Biggers turned Frisco's 98th double play, first in the Texas League and third in all of Double-A. Danny Duffy (2-2) suffered the loss when an inherited runner scored after he exited the game. He allowed one earned run over one inning. Aidan Anderson and Robby Ahlstrom both pitched one inning out of Frisco's bullpen without a run allowed. Robbie Peto (1-0) took the win with three innings of scoreless relief for Tulsa.

## NEW MONTH, NEW ME:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the mound this season, but in the month of August, they have been fantastic. In the 14 games in August, (7-7 record) the RoughRiders lead the Texas League with a 3.16 ERA while allowing a league-low 11 home runs and . 213 BAA. The bullpen has allowed just 20 earned runs over 67.1 innings, a 2.67 ERA with 93 strikeouts to 23 walks. Ryan Garcia was brilliant on Tuesday in Coprus, allowing just two base runners on walks over six no-hit innings with six strikeouts. Nick Krauth then followed up with a second quality start, giving the RoughRiders their first back-to-back quality starts since May 31st and June 1 st when Owen White and Jack Leiter completed the feat. On the offensive side in the month, Frisco is last in the Texas League with a . 706 OPS and runs per game with 4.4 per contest.

## FOUR TO FOUR:

The RoughRiders won four in a row in Corpus Christi before losing their last four games in a row entering Thursday's game. Over the four wins in a row, the Riders allowed just three runs on the pitching side ( 0.75 ERA) while scoring 4.8 runs per game and hitting .250 (8-for-32) with runners in scoring position. Over the last four games, Frisco has allowed 25 runs ( 6.09 ERA) while scoring 3.3 runs per game and hitting .167 (8-for-48) with runners in scoring position.

## THE ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on the road this season. In the second half, Frisco is a league-best 12-9 on the road and they have the second-best road record overall in the Texas League at 30-27. Away from Riders Field, Frisco is averaging a league-best 5.8 runs per game and they have a league-high 107 doubles on the road as well. At home, the Riders are just 23-29 on the season, only trailing Wichita for the worst home record in the Texas League.

HAUV YOURSELF A YEAR:
Trevor Hauver has been fantastic recently for the RoughRiders on the offensive side. On June 16th, he was hitting
$.218 / .337 / .368 / .705$, but in the 43 games since, he is batting $.235 / .410 / .491 / .901$ with 12 doubles, six home runs, 26 RBIs and 33 walks In those games, he has raised his average 36 points and his OPS 96 points.

CARTER WALKS SO THE ROUGHRIDERS CAN RUN:
Evan Carter has been fantastic at drawing walks and getting on base this season. Carter's 68 walks are second in the Texas League despite only playing in 77 percent of the RoughRiders games this year. His 16.6 percent walk rate this year is third-highest in the league as well. He has walked 18 times in his last 16 games. His . 414 OBP on the season is seventh in all of Double-A and among all 12 players in Double-A with a . 400 OBP or better, Carter is the youngest at 20 years old.

## HICKS IS THE CORRECT PICK

Liam Hicks has been as hot as anyone at the plate for the RoughRiders. Over the last 25 games, Hicks is batting . 318 (28-for-
88)/.423/.432/.855 with five doubles, a home run, 13 RBIs, 15 walks and 12 runs scored. In his last 12 games, he is batting . 333 ( $14-$ for42) with a .881 OPS

K'S BY KELLY:
RoughRiders reliever Antoine Kelly has been incredible out of the Riders bullpen recently. He has not allowed an earned run over his last 20 outings. During that stretch, he has 25 strikeouts to three walks over 21.2 innings while recording four saves. He has converted on all eight save opportunities this season. He was named Texas Rangers Minor League Reliever of the Month for July.

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:
The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with Evan Carter hitting Frisco's ninth grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with at least nine grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Seven different players have accounted for the grand slams (Liam Hicks, Luisangel Acuña, Jax Biggers, Dustin Harris, Trevor Hauver, Thomas Saggese (3) and Evan Carter). On
July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.
