YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels lost to the SeaWolves, 3-1. They were held to one run and three hits for the second straight game. Erie took a 1-0 lead in the first innings with an RBI single by Gage Workman. In the second, **Andy Thomas** hit a solo homer, his fifth of the season, to tie the score. The SeaWolves moved ahead, 3-1, with a two-run single by Brady Allen in the bottom of the second. Richmond starter **John Michael Bertrand** did not allow a run after the second, throwing five innings and striking out six. **Mat Olsen** worked 1.2 scoreless innings and **Nick Garcia** struck out three over 1.1 innings. Former Flying Squirrels pitcher Eric Silva threw two scoreless relief innings in his first outing against his old team.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels face the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, in the third of a six-game series. This is the final series between the two teams this year. The Flying Squirrels were swept in a six-game series at UPMC Park back in May. The SeaWolves won four-of-six at The Diamond from May 28-June 2.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have dropped back-to-back games after going 4-1 in their previous five games since Wednesday after IN FILING SECTION IN THE PROPRIES IN THE PROPR

THE SEAWOLVES clinched the Southwest Division's first-half title with a 38-29 record to book their third consecutive postseason appearance. They are in second place in the division standings in the second half. Erie's roster includes three of Baseball America's top-30 Tigers prospects, including RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 1), INF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 11) and RHP Troy Melton (No. 12). Jobe is rated by Baseball America as having the best control, best changeup, best slider and best fastball in the Tigers system. He is also rated by Baseball America as the No. 5 overall prospect in baseball. MLB.com's top-30 Tigers prospects list includes four Erie players, including Jobe (No. 2), Lee (No. 8), Melton (No. 12) and RHP Eric Silva (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander Jack Choate makes his fifth Double-A start and his first against the SeaWolves. Last time out, he faced the Curve last Friday and allowed two runs over four innings, striking out six. Choate was promoted from High-A Eugene on August 1. With the Emeralds, he went 1-3 with a 2.90 ERA in 19 outings (18 starts). For the season, Choate ranks ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (106). Choate was selected in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of NCAA DII Assumption University in Massachusetts. *For more on Choate, see page two.*

FOR ERIE: Right-hander Garrett Burhenn makes his 17th Double-A start and his third against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Friday at Bowie and worked six innings, allowing three runs with four strikeouts. In the month of August, he has gone 2-0 with a 3.15 ERA. He pitched against the Flying Squirrels on May 28 at The Diamond and allowed four runs over four innings in a loss. He also pitched in Richmond on June 2 and surrendered two runs over 3.2 innings. Burhenn began the season with High-A West Michigan and went 0-3 with a 2.89 ERA in seven starts. He was promoted to Double-A Erie on May 14. Burhenn was selected by the Tigers in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Ohio State.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The Flying Squirrels have turned 83 groundball double plays this year, which is the most in the Eastern League. Richmond pitcher **John Michael Bertrand** has induced 19 double plays this year, which is the most in the minor leagues. The Flying Squirrels turned four double plays on July 27 against Binghamton, which is tied for the most in a game this season in the league. They matched that feat with four double plays in the first four innings at Harrisburg on August 16 with Bertrand pitching. Those four double plays were tied for the most induced by a pitcher in the Eastern League dating back to 2005, which is the first year those statistics are readily available. It has been accomplished by three other Richmond pitchers, including **Daryl Maday** in 2010, **Clayton Blackburn** twice in 2014 and **Garrett Williams** in 2019. Bertrand's 19 GIDPs this year are tied for the fourth-most in a season in franchise history, trailing 27 by **Craig Westcott** in 2012 (second-most in the Eastern league since at least 2005), 21 by **Clayton Tanner** in 2010 and 20 by **Mike MacDonald** in 2010.

BERICOTO BASHING: In his last 59 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .295 (69-for-234) with five homers, 12 doubles, 13 walks and 33 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he had not homered in 34 games before belting a two-run shot on August 9 off the scoreboard in left-center at The Diamond. Bericoto homered again last Friday.

TO THE MUNGUIA: In his 20 August games, **Ismael Munguia** is batting .333 (25-for-75), tied for third-highest in the Eastern League, with five doubles and five RBIs, adding four stolen bases. He has at least one hit in 16-of-20 games played this month. Last year, he hit .282 over 75 games with the Flying Squirrels. In his Richmond career, Munguia is batting .289 (127-for-439) in 111 games, which is the fifth-highest career mark in franchise history (min. 450 PA).

FAMILIAR FACES: Erie's roster includes two former Flying Squirrels relief pitchers. Matt Seelinger pitched for the Flying Squirrels in 2021 and went 3-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 36 appearances. He was also part of the only nine-inning no-hitter in Richmond franchise history on May 13, 2021 at FNB Field in Harrisburg, recording an out in the eighth inning. He spent parts of the 2022 and 2023 seasons in the Eastern League with Reading. He signed with the Tigers in June and joined the SeaWolves. **Eric Silva** began this season with the Flying Squirrels, going 4-2 with a 4.35 ERA in 28 games with two saves. He was swapped to the Tigers at the trade deadline on July 31 in exchange for Mark Canha and joined the SeaWolves.

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked 10th among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,543), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

BOULEVARD TO THE BAY: This season, 12 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is the most in a season in franchise history. In 2014, 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including Joe Panik, Adam Duvall, Andrew Susac, Matt Duffy, Jackson Williams, Edwin Escobar, Hunter Strickland, Chris Dominguez, Gary Brown, Brett Bochy and Chris Heston. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are Erik Miller (2023 Flying Squirrels), Landen Roupp (2022-23), Kai-Wei Teng (2022-23), Nick Avila (2022), Randy Rodriguez (2022-23), Mason Black (2023), Gerson Garatito (2021), Spencer Bivens (2023), Raymond Burgos (2023), Hayden Birdsong (2023-24), Parker Dunshee (2023) and Grant McCray (2024). Dating back to 2022, 21-of-the-last-23 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) and Dunshee (Braves) being the only exceptions. Last year saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster.

LOTTA INS, LOTTA OUTS, LOTTA WHAT-HAVE-YOUS: The have been 60 players who have seen action for the Flying Squirrels this year, which ties the franchise record for a single season. In 2018 and 2019, the Flying Squirrels also had 60 different players see time on the field. This season, there have been 31 different pitchers used by the Flying Squirrels, which includes appearances by **Andy Thomas** on June 1 against the SeaWolves and **Luis Toribio** on August 10 against the Yard Goats. There have been 31 different hitters who have seen at least one plate appearance with Richmond this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: Two of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF Vaun Brown (No. 11) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features two Richmond players, including Velasquez (No. 17) and LHP **Jack Choate** (No. 21).
