FIVE-RUN SIXTH SENDS CARDS TO SECOND STRAIGHT DEFEAT: The

Arkansas Travelers wrapped out 15 hits and scored 5 runs with two outs in the top of the inning to blow open a one-run game as the Cardinals fell 11-6 on Friday night at Hammons Field. The loss was Springfield's 3rd in 4 games this week. **Mike Antico** went 2-for-4 with a solo home run, while **Bryan Torres** and **Nathan Church** each had two hits for the Cardinals. **Chandler Redmond** also drove in a pair. In his first rehab start this weekend, Lars **Nootbaar** went 0-for-3 before being replaced in the field in the top of the 6th.



DPPOSING STARTER: Left-hander **Reid VanScoter** makes his 15th start of the season for the Travelers...Last pitched on Sunday, June 23 and took the loss against Wichita allowing 2 R (1 ER) on 3 H over 5.0 IP in a 3-2 Arkansas loss...In 3 starts against the Cardinals this season is 0-1 with an 8.25 ERA... Touched up by the Cards on June 6 in North Little Rock when he took the loss allowing 5 ER on 4 H while walking 4 and striking out 4 in a 10-6 Springfield win...All three of his starts against the Cardinals have resulted in Springfield wins...Spent the eintire 2023 season with High-A Everett and went 10-6 with a 3.27 ERA in 25 starts in his first full season...Struck out 156 with just 35 BB in 143.1 IP...Finished the season tied for 7th in all of MiLB in IP...Selected by the Mariners in the 5th round of the 2022 draft out of Coastal Carolina...2022 Sun Belt Pitcher of the Year and named a 2nd team All-American by *Collegiate Baseball* after going 9-4 with a 3.65 ERA...Went 2-1 with a 4.60 ERA in 12 appearances as a junior in 2021...Spent his first two collegiate seasons at Binghamton in upstate New York...Underwent Tommy John surgery as a sophomore...Threw 3 no-hitters in high school and went 31-1 with a 0.40 ERA over 4 years...25 years old

CARDS BEGIN 2ND HALF WITH FINAL REGULAR SEASON MATCHUP WITH TRAVS: After clinching a postseason berth on the final day of the first half, the Cardinals kick off the 2nd half with a six-game series against the Arkansas Travelers (Double-A, Seattle Mariners) at Hammons Field. The Cards and Travs will not meet again in the regular season. The two clubs met in the division series last season.

CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD



The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

CARDS' RADIO HOME



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

FIRST HALF CHAMPS: For the first time since 2016, the Springfield Cardinals clinched a postseason berth with a first half title. The race came down to the wire, with the Cards needing a win on the last day of the first half to clinch. Springfield trailed the Arkansas Travelers by 2.5 games with 5 to play and by 1.5 games with 2 to play, but the Travs lost their final two games of the first half to the Wichita Wind Surge and the Cards defeated Corpus Christi on back-to-back nights to clinch the title. The Cardinals will be playing in the postseason in backto-back seasons for just the 2nd time in franchise history (2009, 2010).

NOODOODOOT: For the 2nd time during the 2024 season, Cardinals OF Lars Nootbaar is expected to make a rehab appearance in Springfield. He has been on the IL with St. Louis since May 31 with an oblique strain. Nootbaar appeared in one game for Springfield on April 9 rehabbing from fractured ribs, going 1-for-4 with an RBI and 2 runs scored before being activated by St. Louis on April 11. In 5 games with Memphis at the start of the season, he went 3-for-17 with a 2B. In 39 games in the big leagues this season, Nootbaar is batting .234 with 5 HR and 19 RBI to go along with 7 2B and a .741 OPS.

HOME STRUGGLES: After winning their first 8 games at home this season, the Cards have dropped 21 of their last 27 games at Hammons Field. Overall the Cardinals are a league-worst 14-21 at home with a 6.04 ERA, the highest home mark in the Texas League. The Cards have allowed 4 or more runs in 11 of their last 12 games at Hammons Field.

Road games, however, have been a much different story. The Cardinals have the best road mark in the Texas League at 24-14, and sport a 3.62 ERA which is the 2nd best in the circuit behind Frisco and tops in the North Division.

GRINDIN': Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 514 whiffs in 73 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (483 K in 72 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.04 K's per game.

THE [EXTRA BASE] JUICE IS LOOSE: With just 11 extra base hits over their previous 15 and 25 over the first 18 games of the month, the Cardinals have knocked 13 extra base hits (7 2B, 8 HR) over their last 6 games. The power surge has been a welcome sight; the Cardinals hit just 3 HR during a 23 game stretch from May 26-June 21.

For the season Springfield has 146 extra base hits this season, still fewest in the Texas League. San Antonio has the 2nd-fewest with 156. Despite having the most hits and highest OBP (.351) in the league, the Cardinals are 8th in SLG at .361 and 5th in OPS (.711). The Cardinals are on pace to hit 78 HR, which would be the fewest in the Texas League since the Travelers hit 71 in 2016.

BIG INNINGS COSTLY: Big innings have happened more frequently than the Cardinals' pitching staff would like so far this season. The Cards have surrendered 51 innings of 3+ runs in 2024. All together, "big innings" have accounted 202 of the 380 runs (53.1%) Springfield has allowed this season. Cardinal opponents have batted around (9+ in an inning) 19 times this season, 8 of which have happened in June. The Cardinals are 29-6 when they don't allow a "big inning" and 9-29 when their oppoonent scores 3+ runs in an inning.

RUNNING WILD: The Cardinals are 21-for their last-25 in stolen base attempts over their last 10 games. Jeremy Rivas and RJ Yeager lead the Cards with 4 SB during that time, while 4 other Birds have 3 bags each. The Cardinals are 3rd in the Texas League with 93 SB as a team, while Rivas and Bryan Torres are tied for the team lead with 19 SB.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas. Cardinals slugger Chandler Redmond tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with Xavier Scruggs (2010-13). Redmond already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 217.

Since tying the record, however, Redmond has gone 38 straight games without a home run.
