Today: The Lansing Lugnuts play the sixth game in a seven-game, six-day series with the Lake County Captains. Tonight is Military Appreciation Night, with a special POW/MIA Chair of Honor to be dedicated by Rolling Thunder Chapter 5 at 6:20 p.m., followed by the Lugnuts wearing special Armed Forces uniforms that will be auctioned off to benefit the Coast Guard Foundation. LAFCU Fireworks will follow the game. Lake County won the first two games of this series, Lansing took the next two, and the Captains struck back with a victory last night.

Starting Matchup: Lake County will start the 69th overall pick in the 2021 draft, former Florida Gator **Tommy Mace**, against the 578th pick in the 2021 draft, Michigan Wolverine **Blake Beers**, the reigning Midwest League Pitcher of the Week thanks to throwing seven scoreless innings at West Michigan last Saturday in his last start.

Last Night: Captains 4, Lugnuts 2. Lake County right-hander **Ethan Hankins** tossed three scoreless innings, **Will Dion** followed with seven strikeouts in five innings of relief, limiting Lansing to two runs, and the Caps halted a brief two-game losing streak. In the loss, **Mac Lardner** K'ed six in 2 2/3 innings, **Jack Winkler** went 3-for-4 and **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, went 2-for-4 with two doubles.

Do We Hear Five? Lugnuts starting pitcher **Blake Beers** is currently in an eight-way tie for first among Midwest League pitchers with four wins.

Streak Snapped: Catcher **Daniel Susac** went 0-for-4 yesterday, ending his on-base streak at 18 games, tied with **Caeden Trenkle** for the longest Lugnuts on-base streak this year.

Streak Extended: First baseman / outfielder **Danny Bautista, Jr.**, went 2-for-4 again yesterday, his sixth multi-hit game of the month and his ninth of the season, placing him second on the team behind Daniel Susac's 11 multi-hit games. Bautista, Jr., has hit safely in six straight games, one shy of the team lead this season (set by **Lazaro Armenteros**, **Daniel Susac** and **Jack Winkler**) and is batting .304 (17-for-56) in May, second on the team to only **Sahid Valenzuela** (.311, 14-for-45). Bautista, Jr., has also stolen six bases in seven attempts this month.

Soder Pop: 2022 Lugnut **Tyler Soderstrom** has caught fire in Triple-A Las Vegas with five straight multi-hit games, going 11-for-23 (.478) with four doubles and two home runs during that span. Soderstrom is hitting a cool .333 (22-for-66) in May for the Aviators.

Seventh Heaven: Seven times this season a Midwest League starting pitcher has tossed seven innings. (No one has yet pitched longer than seven innings). Of those seven occasions, two were supplied by Lansing right-handers: **Blake Beers** on May 13 at West Michigan and **Jake Garland** on May 18 vs. Lake County. Garland's 10 strikeouts on Thursday were one behind the highest single-game strikeout total recorded by an MWL pitcher this year (Quad Cities' Noah Cameron, who has twice whiffed 11 in a game).

First-Round Pedigrees: The Lugnuts' roster boasts the A's last two first-round selections. 20-year-old **Max Muncy** was the 25th overall selection in the 2021 draft and enters the season ranked the A's No. 1 shortstop prospect by MLB Pipeline. 21-year-old **Daniel Susac** was taken 19th overall in 2022 and is the A's No. 2 catching prospect behind 1B/C Tyler Soderstrom.

They Know Their Trade: Lansing has four players acquired by the Oakland Athletics via trade on its roster: **Christian Fernandez** (Tampa Bay Rays, 7/9/22, for Christian Bethancourt); **Euribiel Angeles** (San Diego Padres, 4/3/22, for Sean Manaea); **Junior Pérez** (San Diego Padres, 6/30/20, for Jorge Mateo); and **Alexander Campos** (Seattle Mariners, 11/15/17, for Ryon Healy).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2004: With all eyes on him and a Thursday night crowd of 9,823 in attendance, rehabbing Mark Prior made his first appearance since the 2003 National League Championship Series, beginning his road back to the Majors. Prior faced the minimum in three innings, striking out five and issuing one walk – to Drew Macias, who was then caught stealing by catcher Jake Fox to end the second inning. The Lugnuts defeated the Fort Wayne Wizards, 2-1, on two runs in the bottom of the ninth. Brian Dopirak tied the game with a two-out RBI double. Three batters later, Fox drew a walk-off walk to bring in Dopirak. Future Major Leaguer Carlos Marmol picked up the win, allowing one run in six innings and striking out eight.

Draft Day: Signed for \$40,000 as the 578th pick in the 2021 draft... signing scout: Rich Sparks, the 2006 Dick Bogard Scout of the Year, who scouts Indiana/Kentucky/Michigan/Ohio and also signed Braves catcher Sean Murphy, Lugnuts starter Jack Perkins and former Lugnuts Marty Bechina, Jeff Criswell, Max Schuemann and Jack Weisenburger... third Michigan Wolverine drafted in 2021, following southpaw Steven Hajjar (2nd round, Minnesota) and shortstop Benjamin Sems (15th round, Colorado).

What's in a Name? Besides Seth Beer, pitcher Clarence Beers saw action in one game in relief in 1948 for St. Louis... middle name of Ausweger is Blake's mother's maiden name... has two older sisters, both of whom played volleyball.

Hometown: Manhattan Beach is in southwestern Los Angeles County, bordering the Pacific Ocean, with a beach stretching over two miles... motto: "Sun, Sand, Sea"... city name was decided by coin flip, with landowners George Peck and John Merrill arguing between the names Shore Acres and Manhattan; they flipped to decide the name, and Manhattan won... the postmaster added "Beach" to the end to differentiate it.

Glory Days: Attended Loyola High School (the "Cubs"), a private all-boys Roman Catholic prep school in Los Angeles that first opened in 1865... Loyola also produced Royals broadcaster Ryan Lefebvre, volleyball great Sinjin Smith, linebacker Anthony Barr, and New York Giants outfielder Fred Snodgrass, who played with Christy Mathewson on John McGraw's powerful Giants teams... turned to full-time pitching after a growth spurt shot him up from 5'7 to 6'2, taking him from playing catcher and shortstop to the pitcher's mound... Beers distinguished himself at Loyola, named a 2017 Perfect Game First Team All-State, First Team All-Region and Third Team All-American.

Hail to the Victors: Pitched four years at Michigan... in College of Literature, Science and the Arts... as a freshman, made two appearances: 1/3 IP vs. Army, 3 BB, 1 K, 4 R, and 0 IP vs. Western Michigan, 2 BB, 1 HBP, 3 R... finished with 135.00 ERA... sophomore year was better: 6.04 ERA, 14 G, 2 GS, 1 sv., 22 1/3, 24 H, 1 HR, 10 BB, 15 K, 5 HBP, 7 WP... as a junior, was at his best, though season was pandemic-shortened: 3.13 ERA, 4 GS, 23 IP, 15 H, 0 HR, 5 BB, 21 K, 6 WP... as a senior: 8.42 ERA, 13 G, 5 GS, 25 2/3 IP, 30 H, 2 HR, 20 BB, 21 K, 7 WP... notable Wolverines: Ted Simmons, Charlie Gehringer, Barry Larkin, George Sisler, Bill Freehan, JJ Putz, Mike Matheny, Chris Sabo, Ryan LaMarre and Jake Cronenworth.

Pro Ball – Better Late Than Never: Debuted on the very last day of the 2021 season, getting the start in the Arizona Complex League on September 18th... allowed one run (James Triantos HR) on two hits in one inning, striking out one; A's lost, 5-4, in a walk-off.

2022 - Stockton: Started the third game of the year for the Ports, April 10 at Fresno (4 2/3, 7 H, 5 R, 2 BB, 4 K, 2 HR)... followed up with a gem: 6 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 1 BB, 5 K vs. Modesto, April 17... that was the start of five consecutive six-inning outings: April 17 vs. Modesto, April 24 at Inland Empire (6 IP, 3 H, 1 UER, 1 BB, 7 K), May 1 vs. Fresno (6 IP, 6 H, 2 R, 0 BB, 10 K), May 8 vs. San Jose (6 IP, 5 H, 2 R, 2 BB, 9 K), May 15 at Rancho Cucamonga (6 IP, 5 H, 4 R, 3 HR, 1 BB, 8 K)... in final start in Stockton, allowed five runs on nine hits in five innings vs. Modesto, May 22, done in by a four-run 5th, though he walked none and whiffed eight... in May: 23 IP, 3 BB, 35 K... vs. LHH: .292/.358/500, 3 HR, 5 BB, 11 K... vs. RHH: .231/.257/.365, 4 HR, 2 BB, 40 K... baserunners: 8-for-10 successful.

2022 - Lansing: Tossed four straight quality starts to begin his Midwest League tenure.

Trayson Kubo followed Beers with three scoreless innings, sending the game into extra innings... bonus runner Lazaro Armenteros scored the game's only run on a Raul Brito wild pitch in the 10th.
- **No. 2, 6 IP, 2 ER, 7 K; June 4 vs. Cedar Rapids:** Gave up solo tallies in the 1st, 2nd and 4th innings, but still battled through... departed with Nuts trailing 3-2... Lansing lost, 8-5.

- May 15 - P **Blake Beers** is named the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week, honoring his seven shutout innings at West Michigan on May 13.
- May 18 - P **Jake Garland** delivers a stunning debut, coming up from Stockton to strike out 10 Lake County Captains in seven innings while allowing one run on two hits.
