JACKSONVILLE SALVAGES SERIES WITH DURHAM

Trevor Rogers tossed 5.0 shutout innings and Peyton Burdick homered to lead the Jumbo Shrimp to a 3-1 victory over the Bulls. A Jerar Encarnacion sacrifice fly in the first got Jacksonville on the board and Jacob Amaya addeed another sacrifice fly in the fifth. Burdick led off the sixth with a homer to make it 3-0. After Rogers exited the game, Durham scored in the sixth on Jonathan Aranda's RBI single, but the Bulls could get no closer. Geoff Hartlieb pitched 1.2 scoreless innings and Anthony Maldonado added 1.1 shutout frames.

AUSTIN POWERS

Austin Allen entered play on April 28 just 2-for-his-first-47 (.043) on the season. In the 22 games, since, however, the St. Louis native is 23-for-78 (.295/.375/.590/.965) at the plate with five doubles, six home runs, 12 RBIs, nine walks and 14 runs scored. After striking out in 25.1% of his plate appearances during the 2022 campaign, Allen has whiffed just 20.4% of the time this season. His .198 BABIP is the second-lowest of the 207 IL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023.

THE BRIAN KING

Heading into play on Tuesday, Jacksonville outfielder **Brian Miller** has reached base in 20 of his last 22 games. During this stretch, the Durham, N.C., native is 27-for-76 (.355/.444/.487/.931) with six doubles, two triples, eight RBIs and nine runs scored. After posting an 8.2 percent walk rate in 2022, Miller is walking in 11.5 percent of his plate appearances this season. He has chopped his ground ball rate from 46.3 percent to 35.8 percent.

CHICKS ARE DIGGING IT

In the 11 games from May 14-26, the Jumbo Shrimp launched just nine home runs, tied for the fifth-fewest in Triple-A. However, over the last nine contests, Jacksonville has blasted 14 long balls, including a season-high six on May 27 against Charlotte, their most at notoriously pitcherfriendly 121 Financial Ballpark since hitting seven against the Carolina Mudcats on June 4, 2010. Those 14 home runs are the sixth-most in Triple-A over the last nine games. On the season, the Jumbo Shrimp's 63 homers rank 18th in Triple-A.

THROUGH THE GOOD TIMES AND THE BAD

Jacksonville salvaged their seven-game series on Sunday with Durham, but the six losses the Jumbo Shrimp suffered to the Bulls were their most in any set since Montgomery swept a six-game series from June 28-July 3, 2018 at 121 Financial Ballpark. Nonetheless, Jacksonville has lost 18 of its last 25 games. During this span, the club has dropped 9.0 games in the standings (6.5 to 15.5 games back). The Jumbo Shrimp's 98 runs scored (3.9 per game) are the second-fewest in Triple-A during this span, and the club owns a collective batting line of .230/.320/.381/.701, all figures that rank in the bottom three in Triple-A. Jacksonville's 146 runs allowed places them 15th at the level during this span.

NOT THIS WAY

Jacksonville starting pitching seemed to find their footing in the middle part of April into May. From April 13-May 5, Jacksonville starters yielded 42 runs, 35 earned on 90 hits (8.2 H/9) in 98.2 innings for a strong 3.19 ERA. However, over their last 28 games, they've combined to surrender 103 runs, 100 earned, on 143 hits (11.9 H/9) in 108.1 innings for a 8.31 ERA. During this stretch, Jacksonville lid-lifters have combined to walk 65 (5.4 BB/9) against only 80 strikeouts (6.6 K/9).

JACOB ARTIST

Jacksonville infielder **Jacob Amaya** came into play on May 1 with just one hit in his previous four games. His season batting line sat at .211/.284/.311/.595 with five extra-base hits. In the 25 games, since, the El Monte, Calif., native has taken his offensive game to a new level. Amaya is 32-for-90 during this stretch, slashing .356/.429/.633/1.062 with five doubles, one triple, six home runs, 19 RBIs, 12 walks and 18 runs scored. After posting a .122 ISO with Triple-A Oklahoma City in 2022, Amaya's ISO is .189 this year.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville snapped a six-game skid with Sunday's 3-1 win over Durham. The losing streak was their longest in four years... Jacksonville was outscored 37-16 during their seven-game series in the Bull City... The Jumbo Shrimp have scored three runs or fewer in six of their last seven games... Of Jacksonville's 26 games in the month of June, 16 are scheduled at 121 Financial Ballpark.

ABOUT CHI CHI

-González was called up to the majors for the first time on May 30, 2015, and made his major league debut that day. He faced the veteran lineup of the Boston Red Sox and began the game pitching 5 2/3 innings without surrendering a hit. It was the longest no-hit stretch to begin a career for a Rangers pitcher since 1992.

-The Baltimore Orioles selected González in the 11th round of the 2010 Major League Baseball draft. Rather than sign with the Orioles, González attended Oral Roberts University, where he played college baseball for the Oral Roberts Golden Eagles

-González starred at Oral Roberts University, where he is now in the University's Hall of Fame. He earned many accoldaes such as 2011 Collegiate Baseball and NCBWA Freshman All-American, 2x Pitcher of the Year (Summit League and Southland Conference) and finished second in the NCAA in 2013 with 126 strikeouts.
