GAME INFORMATION

KODAI Senga REHAB: New York Mets RHP **Kodai Senga** is slated to make a rehab start for Double-A Binghamton tonight at Mirabito Stadium against Hartford. Senga (right hamstring strain) was placed on the 15-day IL on June 13 and this will be his first rehab start. The 32-year-old is in his third MLB season and third season with the Mets, and he is 7-3 with a 1.47 ERA through 13 starts. Senga was a 2023 National League All-Star as a rookie and was the fifth Mets rookie ever to be selected to an All-Star Game. Senga signed a 5-year deal with the Mets in Dec. 2022, after spending the previous 11 seasons in Japan's NPB.

TONG TERRIFIC: RHP **Jonah Tong**, the Mets' No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 59 prospect, made his 15th start of the season on Friday and recorded 10 strikeouts over 5.2 innings, while issuing two runs on four hits. Tong recorded 10+ strikeouts of the fifth time this season and ended his outing with five-straight strikeouts. Tong, 22, leads Minor League Baseball with 125 strikeouts (in just 78.2 IP) and a .141 BAA. Tong also ranks among full-season MiLB with a 14.30 K/9 (2nd), 40.8 K% (2nd), 1.83 ERA (3rd), 0.93 WHIP (5th). Tong is T-2nd for the fewest hits (38) and T-5th for the fewest earned runs (14) allowed among qualified full-season minor leaguers this year. Tong was selected to represent the New York Mets in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game in Atlanta and was named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for June, and became the first player in Binghamton franchise history to win an EL monthly award in consecutive months.

2025 MLB ALL-STAR FUTURES GAME: RHP **Jonah Tong** and OF **Carson Benge** were both selected to represent the New York Mets in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game. The game will take place on Saturday, July 12th at Truist Park in Atlanta at 4 p.m. Tong, the Mets' No. 2 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 59 prospect, has spent the entire season with Binghamton and leads Minor League Baseball with 125 strikeouts in 78.2 innings, while holding 6-4 record and a 1.83 ERA in 15 starts. Benge, the Mets' No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 74 prospect, was promoted to Double-A on June 23 and reached base in each of his first eight games. The 22-year-old hit .302 with an .897 OPS in 60 games for High-A Brooklyn.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies fell to the Hartford Yard Goats, 4-1, on Friday at Mirabito Stadium. RHP **Jonah Tong** (L, 5.2 IP, 4 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 10 K) retired 13 of the last 15 batters he faced and struck out 10+ for the fifth time this season. CF **Jett Williams** (2-for-4, K) recorded his 16th multi-hit game. LF **D'Andre Smith** (1-for-4, RBI, K) drove in Binghamton's lone run with an RBI infield hit.

CLIFFORD CRUSH: 1B/OF **Ryan Clifford**, the Mets' No. 6 prospect, clobbered a three-run home run to the top of the second deck in right field at Dunkin' Park on Thursday and now ranks T-3rd among active Double-A hitters with 14 home runs, behind Brock Wilken (18 - Biloxi, MIL) and Tyler Fedko (17 - Wichita, MIN), and also ranks T-5th in Double-A with 47 BB and 8th with 45 RBI. Since June 6, Clifford is hitting .286 (24 H) with a .991 OPS, 6 HR, 15 RBI, 13 R, 5 2B, and 18 BB in 24 games. The 21-year-old ranks among the Eastern League this season: 14 HR (T-1st among active), 47 BB (2nd), 45 RBI (4th), 28 XBH (9th), .824 OPS (10th), .359 OBP (10th), .465 SLG (10th).

MORABITO MAGIC: OF **Nick Morabito**, the Mets' No. 16 prospect, crushed a three-run home run in the first game of Wednesday's doubleheader at Dunkin' Park. It marked Morabito's first HR since May 17, also at Dunkin' Park. Morabito had 4 HR and 23 2B in the first 71 games this season, after hitting 4 HR and 17 2B in 119 games all of last season. He produced a .322 AVG (29-for-90), .413 OBP, .433 SLG, .847 OPS, 19 RBI, 17 R, 10 2B, 11 BB, 11 SB in 23 games in June, and ranked among Double-A: 10 2B (1st), 12 SB (T-1st), 29 H (T-5th), 19 RBI (T-7th). The 22-year-old ranks among AA this season: 31 SB (T-1st), 23 2B (T-2nd), 29 XBH (T-9th), .293 AVG (10th), 78 H (10th).

SWERVE BERGE THAT CORNER: OF **Carson Benge**, the Mets' No. 3 prospect and MLB Pipeline's No. 74 overall prospect, was selected to represent the Mets in the 2025 MLB All-Star Futures Game. Benge snapped an eight-game on-base streak to begin his Double-A career and six-game hitting streak last night. In 69 games across High-A Brooklyn (60) and Binghamton (9), Benge has a .295 AVG, .883 OPS, 5 HR, & 39 RBI.

J-E-T-T, JETT, JETT: SS/CF **Jett Williams**, the Mets' No. 1 prospect & MLB Pipeline's No. 45 overall prospect, hit .307 (27-for-88) with a .979 OPS, 2 HR, 8 RBI, 19 R, 8 2B, 3 3B, 13 XBH, 21 BB, 8 SB with 3 three-hit games and 8 multi-hit games in 24 G in June. Here's how Williams ranked among Double-A in the month of June: BB (2nd), XBH (T-3rd), 3B (T-3rd), OBP (6th), OPS (8th), R (8th), 2B (T-8th). The 21-year-old ranks among Double-A this season: 31 XBH (T-4th), 5 3B (T-4th), .393 OBP (7th), 47 R (T-7th), 20 2B (T-7th), .863 OPS (9th), 24 SB (T-9th).

NY Mets record when Senga starts (9-4)

2025 SEASON: Made 13 starts for the Mets and went 7-3 with a 1.47 ERA and 70 strikeouts in 73.2 innings and opponents hit .195 against him...Placed on the 15-day injured list (right hamstring strain) on June 13...Began rehab assignment with Double-A Binghamton on July 5.

LAST SEASON: Made one regular season start for the Mets on July 26 vs. Atlanta (W, 5.1 IP, 2 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 1 HR, 1 BB, 9 K)...Made three postseason appearances and two starts and combined to go 0-1 with seven earned runs allowed over five innings...Started Game 1 of the National League Division Series in Philadelphia and allowed one run (leadoff home run to Kyle Schwarber) over two innings with three strikeouts (his first start since July 26)...Began the season in the injured list (right shoulder capsule strain) and returned on July 26, before going back on the IL (left calf strain) on July 27 and did not return until Game 1 of the NLDS on October 5.

CAREER NOTES: In his third season in MLB and with the Mets: 43 starts, 20-10 with a 2.53 ERA in career...2023 National League All-Star... Became the fifth Mets rookie to be selected to an All-Star Game, joining Pete Alonso (2019), Dwight Gooden (1984), Jerry Koosman (1968), and Tom Seaver (1967)... In 2023, he became the eighth Japanese-born rookie ever to be selected to an All-Star Game, joining Masahiro Tanaka (2014), Yu Darvish (2012), Kosuke Fukudome (2008), Hideki Okajima (2007), Hideki Matsui (2003), Ichiro Suzuki (2001) and Hideo Nomo (1995)...Finished 8th in the National League with 202 strikeouts in 2023...Senga also recorded 202 strikeouts through his first 29 career major league games, the fourth-most by a Mets pitcher in franchise history. His 12 wins and 202 strikeouts also led all major league rookies that season...Finished 2nd behind Corbin Carroll for 2023 National League Rookie of the Year...Made MLB debut for the Mets on April 2, 2023...In 11 seasons in the NPB, Senga posted a 2.59 ERA and 1.12 WHIP over 1,089 innings, striking out 28% of the batters he faced, and walking 9%...Pitched for Team Japan in the 2017 World Baseball Classic.

BACKGROUND: Originally signed a five-year, \$75 million contract with the New York Mets on December 17, 2022, as an international free agent out of Japan...Played the previous 11 seasons with the Fukuoka Softbank Hawks in Japan's Nippon Professional Baseball (NPB)... Senga is originally from Gamagori, Japan.

-Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16).
 -In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-consecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
 -In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5 in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.
 -In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca).
 -Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.
