

# ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (11-13) AT RENO ACES (11-13)



RHP Andrew Quezada (0-0, 3.00) vs. RHP Billy Corcoran (1-3, 9.77)

**TODAY'S GAME**: The Isotopes have a 2-1 series advantage after Reno's 8-7 come-from-behind win yesterday ... Andrew Quezada is expected to toe the rubber for Albuquerque while Billy Corcoran is slated to start for Reno.

**HITS**: Albuquerque has connected on double-digit hits in threestraight contests for the first time since September 12-14, 2024, vs. Las Vegas.

SWIPES: The Isotopes swiped a season-high four bags yesterday, the most since September 7, 2024, at Tacoma, also four.

@ RENO: The loss yesterday ended Albuquerque's three-game win streak in Reno. The lsotopes have not won more than three in-a-row in Reno since winning five-straight from August 11, 2012-April 8, 2014, a series high.

**ONE-RUN GAMES**: The club fell to 3-5 on the year in one-run games after yesterday's loss. Albuquerque has dropped four of its last five games decided by one tally.

**STREAK?**: Albuquerque failed to win a third-straight game for the third time on the year yesterday (also: April 6 vs. Salt Lake, 9-8, and April 12 at Sugar Land, 6-2).

ERROR 505: The Isotopes committed one error yesterday, their third-straight contest with a miscue. The club has been charged with an error in three-straight contests for the second time in the last eight games.

**NO DINGERS FOR YOU:** Albuquerque allowed a homer yesterday afternoon, the first dinger relented in five games, ending its longest stretch without surrendering a clout since August 15-19, 2018, also five games.

DUKE CITY HR RECORD: Sam Hilliard homered with two outs in the first inning on April 15, his 79th in an Isotopes uniform – which ties Mike Busch (Dukes, 1993-96) for the most in Albuquerque professional baseball history.

**ISOTOPES RBI RECORD:** Hilliard has 223 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard singled Thursday to extend his on-base streak to 15, every game he's played in 2025. It's tied for the second-longest active on-base streak in the PCL and tied for the fifth-longest overall streak ... Dating back to 2024, has a 23-game on-base streak in Triple-A (June 11-19, 2024)

WARMIN' UP: Warming Bernabel went 2-for-5 yesterday with a double and three RBI. It's his eighth multi-hit contest of the year and third-straight. Has multiple hits in three-straight games for the first time since June 2-5, 2024, with Double-A Hartford. Over his last 10 games, is slashing .368/.422/.684 with six doubles, two homers, 13 RBI and five walks.

**YF**: Yanquiel Fernandez singled yesterday and has a hit in his last four games. Over those last four contests, is 8-for-18 with four homers, one double and seven RBI.

HOME RUN LEADERBOARD: Yanquiel Fernandez has seven homers on the year, tied for the most in all of MiLB.

**RITTER:** Ryan Ritter tied a season-high with three walks yesterday (also: April 17 vs. El Paso). It's his fourth game this year with multiple free passes. Also stole his second base on the year.

**MILLER TIME:** Owen Miller recorded three hits and two RBI yesterday. It's his fifth multi-hit game of the year and second contest with at least three knocks (also: April 16 vs. El Paso, four). Has a hit in his last four games (8x18 with two doubles, one homer and four RBI).

**JC**: Julio Carreras tied a career-high with four knocks yesterday (three times; last: August 4, 2023, at Reading). Over his last two contests, is 7-for-9 with a triple, two RBI and a walk.

VEEN: Zac Veen played in his first game with Albuquerque since being sent down yesterday and connected on two hits for his fourth multi-hit contest in nine games with the lsotopes.

**THE VET**: Austin Nola has back-to-back three-hit games for the first time since July 30-31, 2019, with Seattle at Texas ... Has three multi-hit games in 2025.

**STERLIN**: Sterlin Thompson has a hit in eight of his last nine contests ... Has struckout three times in two-straight contests.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Warming Bernabel is 8th in slugging (.574) and T-9th in RBI (19) ... Ryan Ritter is T-1st in walks (19) and 9th in OBP (.420) ... Yanquiel Fernandez is T-1st in homers (7) and 9th in slugging (.566).

RENO TIES: Connor Kaiser was Albuquerque's primary shortstop each of the last two seasons, playing in a total of 180 games. John Curtiss, currently on Reno's IL, compiled a 3.96 ERA in 43 relief outings for the Isotopes in 2024. Scott

guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

**HOMETOWN KID**: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

**CHRIS MICHALAK**: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

**MICHAEL RYAN**: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

**SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT**: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

**BALLS AND STRIKES**: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
