INDY BITS

ABOUT LAST NIGHT, GAME 1: Rochester opened up a doubleheader sweep with an extra-innings victory in Game 1, 4-3. The Red Wings tallied the first runs of the twin bill in the second inning, when Trey Lipscomb singled home Travis Blankenhorn. A sacrifice fly off the bat of Alex Call then brought Juan Yepez home to end the inning. Down to their last offenive half inning, the Indians tied the contest courtesy of a two-run shot by Liover Peguero. After a scoreless bottom half that sent the game to extras, Indianapolis grabbed a brief 3-2 lead in the eighth on a run-scoring single by Alika Williams. Rochester countered in the home half against Brent Honeywell, with Call sending his ninth home run of the season into the Indians' bullpen beyond the left field wall for a two-run, walk-off blast

QP IN NY: Quinn Priester began a rehab assignment with Indianapolis yesterday and tossed 4.0 two-run innings, taking a no-decision in the doubleheader opener as Indianapolis tied the game in the top of the seventh inning. The 23-year-old was placed on the 15-day injured list on June 6 (retroactive to June 3) with a right lat muscle injury. He opened the season on Indianapolis' Opening Day roster, going 2-1 with a 3.28 ERA (9er/24.2ip) and 29 strikeouts in five Triple-A starts. He also made six big-league starts across two stints, going 0-5 with a 4.83 ERA (17er/31.2ip) and 20 strikeouts with the Pirates.

PEGUERO POPS: Liover Peguero broke an 0-for-15 stretch yesterday with his fifth homer of the season and third in June during yesterday's twinbill opener. With the Indians trailing 2-0, Peguero launched a game-tying two-run shot in the top of the seventh inning to force extras. The long ball was Peguero's first since homering in consecutive games on June 13-14 at Jacksonville. He followed up the performance with two additional hits, a double and RBI in the nightcap for his first multi-hit game since going 2-for-4 on June 19.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT, GAME 2: In the second affair, Rochester scored the game's last five runs in the final two innings — four in the bottom of the seventh — to secure the doubleheader sweep. Indianapolis got on the board early and rode the arm of Jake Woodford to build a 4-0 lead. Alika Williams worked a leadoff walk in the first and Seth Beer smacked a two-out double to make it 1-0. After three consecutive walks by Thaddeus Ward in the third inning, a sac fly courtesy of Beer extended the lead to two. In the sixth, Gilberto Celestino doubled and scored on a Mike Jarvis fielder's choice, and a ground-rule double by Peguero added another run to cap the Indians scoring. Following two walks and a hit by pitch that loaded the bases with one out, Dylan Crews hit a line drive, two-run double up the middle to end the shutout bid. Darren Baker then plated Erick Mejia as the game-tying run while reaching safely on a missed-catch error by Malcom Nuñez at first base. Carter Kieboom completed the trifecta of close calls for the Indians defensively, flaring a fly ball to right field that Joshua Palacios dropped on a sliding attempt, allowing Crews to jog home as the winning run.

CHOPPIN' WOOD(FORD): Jake Woodford continued his dominant stretch with the Indians, tossing 5.1 one-run innings with no walks and a season-high tying eight strikeouts in yesterday's nightcap at Rochester. He has struck out six-plus batters in each of his three starts with Indianapolis, going 0-1 with a 2.08 ERA (4er/17.1ip), no walks, 21 strikeouts, a 0.81 WHIP and .215 batting average against. He has thrown at least 5.0 innings in each of his last nine outings dating back to April 24 with Triple-A Charlotte at Lehieh Valley.

NO BEER: Seth Beer put the Indians first two runs on the board in the second game of yesterday's doubleheader while going 2-for-3, doubling home a run in the first inning followed by a sacrifice fly in the third. It was his second two-hit game since joining the Indians lineup on June 19 vs. lowa, and his 15th multi-hit game of the season after logging a four-hit game, four three-hit games and seven two-hit games with Double-A Altoona.

WALK-OFF WOES: The Indians lost both games at Rochester yesterday in walk-off fashion, 4-3 and 5-4. It was the first time they have been walked-off in consecutive games since 2022 on May 29 at St. Paul (8-7, B9) and May 31 at Omaha (2-1, B9). It was also the first time they have been walked-off by the same team in consecutive games since June 21-22, 2016, at Gwinnett when they lost 8-7 in the 12th inning and 4-3 in the 10th inning, respectively.

TONIGHT: The Indians continue a six-game road trip at Innovative Field, home of the Rochester Red Wings, with the fourth of six games this week. It is their first road trip to Rochester since 2019 after going 8-4 vs. the Red Wings at Victory Field from 2022-23. On Sept. 19, 2023, the Indians defeated Rochester 19-1 for their largest margin of victory again the opponent in the all-time head-to-head series. Taking the mound for the Indians will be RHP Luis Cessa (2-2, 3.99) in his third start with Indianapolis since being signed as a minor league free agent. Countering for Rochester will be RHP Spenser Watkins (4-3, 4.38) in his third career start vs. Indianapolis. In those outings, both with Toledo in 2019, he is 0-2 with a 10.60 ERA (11er/9.1ip) and six strikeouts.

THIS DATE IN 2009: In his first appearance with the Indians since Aug. 31, 2005 vs. Toledo, right-hander Ian Snell again toed the rubber vs. the Mud Hens for a history-making outing. Snell struck out a Victory Field era record 17 batters in 7.0 two-hit innings as the Indians won, 2-1, in 10 innings against their divisional rival. The record-setting performance didn't stop there as 13 of those strikeouts were consecutive, another Victory Field era best.
