**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the first game of the 2021 season and the first of six in this series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks Hartford's only visit to The Diamond in 2021. The Flying Squirrels will visit Connecticut's capital city from June 22-27 for a six-game series.

**610 DAYS:** Tonight's return to the field for the Flying Squirrels snaps a stretch of 610 days without professional baseball in Richmond, bringing an end to the longest span without professional baseball in the city since May 30, 1928-April 27, 1931 (1,062 days). The Richmond Colts' 1928 season ended early when the Virginia League disbanded. Richmond fielded a team in the Eastern League in 1931, but that circuit also disbanded in 1932. Baseball returned in 1933 with the Richmond Colts of the Class-B Piedmont League, and that team played through 1953. They were replaced in 1954 when Baltimore was awarded an MLB franchise and the former Triple-A Baltimore Orioles became the Richmond Virginians, Triple-A affiliate of the New York Yankees. The Virginians played 11 seasons before moving to Toledo in 1965, leaving Richmond without professional baseball for over a year. After 588 days, the Milwaukee Braves' relocation to Atlanta in 1966 moved their Triple-A franchise to Richmond, where it stayed until 2008. When the Braves left Richmond, the city went 584 days without professional baseball before the Flying Squirrels played their first game in 2010.

**A BUNCH OF SELLOUTS:** Including tonight, the Flying Squirrels have sold out all 11 of their home openers in the franchise's history. While adhering to guidelines set forth by the Commonwealth of Virginia and Major League Baseball, maximum capacity is currently capped at 30 percent, which is 2,943. Although a bit below the standard sellout of 9,845, tonight's game marks the 51st sellout in franchise history. The Flying Squirrels are 33-20 in their previous sellouts (including double-headers).

**GET THEIR GOAT:** The Flying Squirrels open a season against the Yard Goats for the fourth time in the last five seasons. In 2016, the Squirrels were supposed to begin the season in Hartford, but the game was relocated to The Diamond due to construction delays of Dunkin' Donuts Park. In that game, the first in Hartford's franchise history, the Squirrels lost, 5-4. The two teams last met on Opening Day in 2017, an 11-1 Richmond win, which is the most lopsided Opening Day score in Flying Squirrels history. In 2019, Richmond beat Hartford, 1-0, in front of a record-tying 9,845 fans. The Flying Squirrels are 2-1 against Hartford in season openers and also went 1-3 on Opening Day against New Britain from 2011-2014.

**HOME COOKIN':** In the franchise's first ten home openers, the Flying Squirrels have combined to go 8-2, including wins in each of the last five. The Flying Squirrels also won the first three home-opening games from 2010-2012. The only two losses came in back-to-back seasons in 2013 and 2014.

**WELCOME BACK, AUGGIE:** José Alguacil returns to manage the Flying Squirrels after leading the team to a 72-68 record in 2015, the most recent season the team has posted a winning record. Alguacil is in his 15th overall season with the Giants organization and worked at the Alternate Training Site in 2020. He previously served as the first base coach and oversaw bunting instruction while assisting with infield defense and baserunning in San Francisco from 2017-2019 on Bruce Bochy's major league staff.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** finished the 2019 season with a 55-84 record, the worst in the franchise's history, and finished in last place in the Eastern League's Western Division for the second consecutive year. Seven players from the 2019 team are back in Richmond to start the 2021 season, including **Jacob Heyward**, **Sean Hjelle**, **Ryan Howard**, **Peter Maris**, **Heliot Ramos**, **Frank Rubio** and **Raffi Vizcaino**. Reliever **Patrick Ruetolo** did not appear with the Flying Squirrels in 2019, but he did pitch in Richmond in 2018. Outfielder **Vince Fernandez** played in the Eastern League with Hartford in 2019.

**THE YARD GOATS** return four players from their 2019 team and welcome 24 newcomers. Six players from the 2019 Yard Goats have gone on to reach the majors. The 2021 Hartford roster includes four players ranked by MLB.com in the Rockies' Top-30 prospects, including RHP **Ryan Rolison** (2), 3B **Elehuris Montero** (9), OF **Jameson Hannah** (13) and RHP **Tommy Doyle** (22). The Yard Goats went 73-66 in 2019 and finished in third place in the Eastern League's Eastern Division.

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Tristan Beck** makes the first Opening Day start of his professional career and his Double-A debut. Drafted by the Atlanta Braves in the fourth round in 2018, Beck was traded to the Giants along with RHP Dan Winkler for reliever Mark Melancon on July 31, 2019 at the trade deadline. That year, his first full professional season, he began the campaign with the High-A Florida Fire Frogs and went 0-1 with a 7.71 ERA through his first four starts before being placed on the injured list with an oblique injury in late-April. After a rehab assignment in the GCL, Beck returned to make four more starts before being traded. He made six total starts with High-A San Jose to close out 2019, and went 3-0 with a 0.47 ERA (1 ER/19.0 IP) in his last three outings of the season. **For more on Beck, see page two.**

**STARTING WITH BECK:** Although he has not taken the mound in an opener as a pro, Beck made two Opening Day starts during his decorated college career with the Stanford Cardinal. In 2016, he became just the third freshman in the last 30 years to start a season-opener for Stanford, joining Hall of Famer Mike Mussina and former first-round draft pick Cal Quantrill. In that outing against Cal State Fullerton, Beck threw 6.1 scoreless innings in a win. He missed his entire sophomore season in 2017 due to injury, but he was back on the hill for Stanford's Opening Day battle with Fullerton as a junior in 2018, picking up another win. Beck also started the Arizona Fall League season-opener for the Scottsdale Scorpions in 2019.

**FOR HARTFORD:** The Yard Goats will turn to southpaw **Ryan Rolison** to open the 2021 season. Selected by Colorado in the first round (22nd overall) in the 2018 MLB Draft, Rolison has a career 3.94 ERA and 166 strikeouts over 160 innings pitched through two minor league seasons. The 23-year-old attended Rockies spring training twice as a non-roster invitee in 2020 and 2021 and also saw work at the Rockies' Alternate Training Site over the last year. Rolison is rated by *Baseball America* and MLB.com as the Rockies' No. 2 prospect.

**ALL OVER THE MAP:** The Flying Squirrels roster contains 18 players from 11 different states across the United States: California (5), Georgia (3), Florida (2) and one player from North Carolina, Minnesota, Illinois, Massachusetts, New York, Missouri, Washington and Ohio. Nine players grew up in four countries and territories outside of the 50 states, including the Dominican Republic (4), Puerto Rico (2), Venezuela (2) and Colombia (1).

**THE MORE THE MERRIER:** Under the new Player Development License structure, Double-A active rosters include 28 players, up from 25 in the previous system. The Flying Squirrels initial roster includes 15 pitchers and 13 position players.

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have three players included in *Baseball America's* Top-30 Giants prospects: **Heliot Ramos** (3), **Tristan Beck** (12) and **Sean Hjelle** (13). Ramos is also rated by *Baseball America* as the No. 83 overall prospect. Ramos (3), Hjelle (11) and Beck (20) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects.

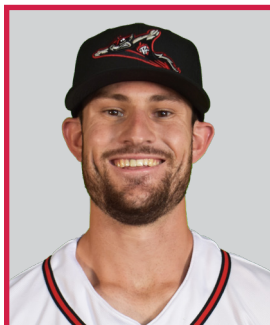
