## RIDERS TAKE TIGHT OPENER IN ARKANSAS:

The Frisco RoughRiders pulled out a 2-1 win over the Arkansas Travelers to open the series at Dickey-Stephens Park on Tuesday. **Trevor Hauver** provided the two RBIs for Frisco (18-21). He singled in the fourth inning to score **Thomas Saggese** and **Kellen Strahm** to take a 2-1 lead. The RoughRiders had spotted a 1-0 lead to Arkansas (25-15) in the first inning and shut out the Travelers from that point on. **Jack Leiter** went four innings with four strikeouts, while allowing one run and working around seven walks and ceding just one hit. **Nick Starr** (2-2) replaced him and threw two hitless innings. **Theo McDowell** and **Alex Speas** threw scoreless innings as well to set up **Antoine Kelly's** save in the ninth. The Travelers put two runners aboard with no outs in the final inning before Kelly struck out the next three hitters to take the save. The RoughRiders recorded 11 of the final 12 outs on strikeouts and tallied 15 strikeouts on the evening. The Travelers' starting pitcher, **Bryan Woo** (2-2), gave up two runs in five innings to take the loss. Tuesday was the first win for Frisco this season scoring one or two runs. Besides Hauver's single, the only other hits for Frisco were Saggese's double to lead off the fourth inning, an **Evan Carter** single and an infield single by **Luisangel Acuña**.

## STRENGTH IN ARMS:

After the RoughRiders had the worst ERA in the Texas League over a two-week span, over the last seven games, Frisco had the best ERA in the Texas League at 1.76 while going 5-2. The Riders have ceded a league-low three home runs and 28 hits (.135 BAA) with a 0.89 WHIP. Frisco's bullpen allowed just allowed five earned runs with a 1.36 ERA.

## ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Liam Hicks** hitting Frisco's sixth grand slam of the season on Saturday. They are the only team with six grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball and the only team with more than four. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese**).

## COMEBACK KIDS:

The RoughRiders came back from down six runs on Saturday night to win 8-7 on their first walk-off hit of the season. It was the largest comeback win since they returned from down six at Corpus Christi on 6/18/21 and their first comeback win of more than two runs on the season. It was also their first time they won a game when trailing after the fourth inning this season.

## TOP 100 RERANKING:

MLB.com has reranked their Top 100 prospects and the RoughRiders have four Top 100 players that have seen some movement. Outfielder **Evan Carter** is now the No. 11 prospect in baseball (previously No. 36) while pitcher **Owen White** is No. 51, infielder **Luisangel Acuña** places at No. 58 and pitcher **Jack Leiter** is at No. 80. The Rangers fourth-round pick in 2022, pitcher **Brock Porter**, is the No. 81 prospect as well. He is currently pitching for Low-A Down East.

## THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Through his first 16 games of the season, Saggese was hitting just .203/.254/.281/.535, but he has been on a tear ever since. Over his last 21 games, he is hitting .368 (32-for-87)/.421/.552/.973 with five doubles, a triple, three homers, 15 RBIs and 16 runs. In the month of May, he is batting .360/.400/.520/.920 and has four games with three or more hits to his name. Saggese is the No. 15 prospect in the Rangers organization by MLB.com.

## IT'S ABOUT STRAHM TIME:

RoughRiders outfielder **Kellen Strahm** has been on fire on this road trip after getting off to a tough start this season. Through his first 13 games, he was hitting just .125/.250/.146/.396, but since April 25th to begin the series in Amarillo, he is batting .299/.413/.455/.868 with four doubles, a triple, two home runs and six RBIs while walking 15 times. Over the last 21 games, he has raised his average 107 points and his OPS 291 points. It was very similar to last season as Strahm was hitting just .136/.337/.226/.563 on May 14th last season through his first 22 games before slashing .305/.406/.445/.851 over his last 82 games of the season.

## ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire to start his 2023 season. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .309 (50-for-162)/.379/.444/.823 through the first 38 games while ranking second in the Texas League in hits (50), tied for fourth in average (.309), tied for sixth in doubles (11) and tied for first in stolen bases (18). Over his last 34 games, he is batting .326/.402/.479/.881. When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (121).

## WALK THIS WAY:

On the season, Frisco's 199 walks are first among Texas League teams while their .356 team OBP is third in Double-A. **Dustin Harris** is second in the league with 28 walks while **Evan Carter** is third in OBP (.426) in the league and third in the league with 27 walks.

### ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

### 2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

### 2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

### 2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

### 2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
