Valdez Cranks Homer, Birds Fall To Cannon Ballers In 10 Innings 5-2

MYRTLE BEACH, S.C. (April 17, 2026). – The Myrtle Beach Pelicans (7-6) fell to the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers (4-9) 5-2 in 10 innings at Pelicans Ballpark on Friday night. With the score tied at 2-2 after the ninth inning, Kannapolis wasted no time taking the lead in the top of the 10th. With Marcelo Alcala starting the inning at second base as the extra-innings baserunner, James Taussig ripped an RBI triple to give Kannapolis a 3-2 lead. After Bryce Eblin was plunked, Jaden Fauske laced an RBI single which made the score 4-2. After a groundout moved both runners up a base, Javier Mogollon hit a sacrifice fly that scored Eblin to give the Cannon Ballers a 5-2 lead. Kannapolis took an early 1-0 lead in the top of the second inning courtesy of a solo home run by Arxy Hernandez (1).

Myrtle Beach tied the game in the bottom of the second when Deric Valdez (1) jacked a solo home run. The Pelicans took the lead in the bottom of the third. Alexis Hernandez walked and then stole second base. After Josiah Hartshorn drew a walk, Cole Mathis grounded into a forceout that scored Hernandez from third to give the Birds a 2-1 lead.

The Cannon Ballers tied the game 2-2 in the top of the ninth on a solo home run from Rylan Galvan (3). Pelicans RHP David Bracho was stellar in relief, striking out a career-high eight batters over four scoreless innings.

The Cannon Ballers started the scoring in the top of the second courtesy of a solo home run by Rylan Galvan (1) to take a 1-0 lead. RHP Pierce George (1-0, 0.00 ERA) received the win for Kannapolis, RHP Jordan Henriquez (1-1, 4.50 ERA) was tagged with the loss. Myrtle Beach continues their six-game homestand against Kannapolis tomorrow, April 18 at 7:05 PM EST. LHP Victor Zarraga (1-0, 7.94) will start on the mound for the Birds. The Cannon Ballers will counter with RHP Caedmon Parker (0-0, 2.35).

MATHIS MADNESS

In Wednesday night's win over Kannapolis, INF/OF Cole Mathis launched 2 two-run home runs for his fifth and sixth home runs of the season, to send Pelicans ballpark into a frenzy. In his last five games, Mathis is slashing .450 (9-for-20) with two doubles, 4 home runs, and 8 RBI. Mathis started the 2025 season in Myrtle Beach where he slashed .215/.336/.402 to go along with nine doubles, one triple, three home runs, and 14 RBI over 29 games. Mathis is currently ranked as the 14th overall prospect in the Cubs Farm System.

FRIDAY NIGHT THEIVERY

Back 4/10 in Columbia, the Pelicans stole a season-high nine bags, four of them coming from INF Ty Southisene (tied his career high in SB). OF Alexey Lumpuy stole three bases, OF Cole Mathis and INF Jose Escobar swiped one a piece. Myrtle Beach currently ranks tied for third in stolen bases across Single-A with 20 on the year. Southisene and Lumpuy currently lead the Pelicans in stolen bases on the season with seven each. They also led the stolen base charge last season as they finished No.1 and No.2 in team high steals. Southisene (41), Lumpuy (30).

BRAYLON - NOT MICHAEL MYERS

Pelicans RHP Braylon Myers tallied a season and career high in strikeouts with four on Wednesday night. The former Alabama Crimson Tide reliever threw 3.0 innings while only giving up two hits and one run.

BRILLIANCE FROM BRACHO

Pelicans RHP David Bracho was lights out in relief of starter Edwardo Melendez on Friday night. Bracho struck out a career-high and personal season high eight batters, the most of any Pelicans pitcher in a game this season. Bracho kept the Cannon Ballers offense in check for the middle part of the game.

ANOTHER 5 K'S FROM DOMINICK

RHP Dominick Reid (Cubs 15th overall prospect) turned in another stellar performance on the bump Wednesday night against Kannapolis. The No.3 overall pitching prospect in the Cubs system hurled 3.1 innings of three-run ball, while he fanned five batters. It marks the third consecutive start that Reid has tallied five strikeouts. Back on 4/4 in Charleston. Reid tossed 4.0 innings of shutout ball while fanning five batters and only surrendering two hits along with a walk. The Plano, TX native had his sweeper and changeup working like a beauty and will continue to hone-in on his fastball.

MAGIC FROM MCGWIRE

RHP Mason McGwire was stellar in Tuesday nights series opening win over Kannapolis. The Irvine, CA native struck out a season-high five batters over three innings of relief. McGwire also earned his second win of the season and now boasts a 1.50 ERA.

NEW AND OLD KIDS ON THE BEACH

Myrtle Beach's highest rated prospect, Josiah Hartshorn, checks in as the No.7 overall prospect in the Cubs farm system. Hartshorn was drafted in the sixth round (No.181) of the 2025 MLB Draft out of Orange Lutheran High School (Calif.). In 2025, the 19 year-old prospect hit .364 over 109 plate appearances while adding five home runs, nine doubles, and 24 RBI.
