- **LET'S GET IT STARTED:** After Mason Guerra played hero with a walk-off homer last night, the GreenJackets shoot for a sweep of the RiverDogs on a dreary Sunday evening.
- **TEEN TITANS:** The top of Augusta's order has led the way this season, with five players age 19 or younger emerging as the team's key contributors. John Gil, Owen Carey, Nick Montgomery, Eric Hartman, and Isaiah Drake have all shown out despite their relative youth.
- **RANK 'EM:** Five players from MLB Pipeline's ranking of Top 30 Braves Prospects are on Augusta's roster to start the year. The most highly regarded are SS John Gil and OF Luis Guanipa (IL), #s 12 and 13 respectively, while Nick Montgomery, Ethan Bagwell, and Luke Sinnard round out the list.
- **SOMEBODY GET SOME BUBBLE WRAP:** The GreenJackets currently have eight players on their IL, five of whom were injured in the first nine games of the year. Both John Gil and Nick Montgomery were lifted early from the game Tuesday.
- **DOUGIE FRESH:** Despite some bad luck in the hit column early, Douglas Glod has now reached base in 23 of his last 26 games. Glod has drawn 24 walks in 28 games played, and continues to find ways to get aboard.
- **STRANDED:** The GreenJackets have been snakebitten time and again with runners in scoring position this season, but improvement in the last 8 games has raised the team average there to .240, out of the bottom 40 in MiLB. Charleston is .186 with RISP, bottom 2 in all the Minors.
- **CHUCKIN':** The GreenJackets won with pitching last year, and that has been the case once again early this year. Augusta has held opponents to three runs or fewer in 50% of games this year.
- **NEXT TIME OUT:** Both sides pick up an off day tomorrow, before the Jackets head to the coast to battle the Myrtle Beach Pelicans for the 2nd time this year. Charleston returns to the Holy City to host the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers beginning Tuesday.
