Tonight: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the Oakland Athletics, play the third in a six-game series against the Great Lakes Loons, High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The intrastate rivals have split the first two games of this series. Right-hander **Mitch Myers**, who made 21 starts for the Lugnuts last season, receives his first start this year, opposed by 20-year-old southpaw Jackson Ferris, who shares his first name with the three youngest players in Major League Baseball (Jacksons Chourio, Holliday and Merrill).

On the Air: Jesse Goldberg-Strassler and Adam Jaksa collaborate to deliver the call of Lansing Lugnuts baseball, available via Bally Live, MiLB TV and StreamGuys.

Last Night: The Lugs and Loons were postponed and will play a doubleheader comprising two seven-inning games tomorrow, with Game 1 starting at 1:05 p.m.

On Deck: Speaking of which, tomorrow is a special White Claws and Paws Thirsty Twinbill Saturday, with dogs welcome to the ballpark and drink specials: \$3 domestic drafts, \$5 craft drafts and \$5 White Claws. Then Sunday concludes the homestand with the first Capital City Market Kids Day of the season.

Lansing Lugnuts at Lake County Captains

Transaction: Yesterday, Lansing placed infielder Joshwan Wright on the 7-day Injured List; Wright had departed Tuesday's series opener following a bunt single.

EMU to The Show: 2021 Lansing super utilityman Max Schuemann had his contract purchased by Oakland from Triple-A Las Vegas yesterday. When he makes his MLB debut, Schuemann will become the first player this year and the 185th all-time Lugnut to reach the Majors. Max's 2021 Lugnuts teammate, catcher Drew Millas, was also called up to the Majors this week, joing the Washington Nationals; Millas was one of 11 Nuts to make his MLB debut last year.

A'round the A's System

- Triple-A Las Vegas: Though the Aviators have opened the year 2-9, 2021-22 Lugnuts infielder Brett Harris is off to a fine start, hitting .324/.425/.500 and blasting a 416-foot home run yesterday against Salt Lake. 2022-23 Nut Max Muncy meanwhile is hitting .313/.405/.531 with four doubles and a home run while stealing two bases and striking out only four times in his first nine games.
- Double-A Midland: The RockHounds are rocking the Texas League, opening with a 5-1 record thanks to the red hot Colby Thomas (2023 in Lansing). Thomas went 4-for-5 yesterday with his fourth home run in his last five games, and is hitting .400/.464/.880 this year.
- Single-A Stockton: 2023 draftee Cole Conn is hitting .364/.481/.545 with two doubles, one triple, three walks and only one strikeout in his first six games for the Ports, who are 2-4 to open the year. The catcher was drafted in the 12th round last year from Illinois-Chicago.

Patience is a Virtue: The Lugnuts have drawn 27 walks in their first five games, trailing only Wisconsin (29 walks) for the league lead. Will Simpson is second in the Midwest League with eight walks, while Brayan Buelvas and Colby Halter are tied for third with six walks.

Louisville Slugger: Outfielder Cameron Masterman, an undrafted free agent from the University of Lousiville, is tied for first in the Midwest League in doubles (4) and also tied for first in extra-base hits (4).

Prospecting: The Nuts' Opening Day roster includes two MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects in outfielder Henry Bolte (No. 12) and first baseman Will Simpson (No. 30). Bolte, the A's No. 2 outfield prospect, was selected 56th overall in 2022 from Palo Alto High School, where he led all California high schoolers with 13 home runs. He spent the 2023 season with Single-A Stockton, where he slashed .257/.356/.421 in 112 games, collecting 17 doubles, five triples, 14 home runs and 32 stolen bases. Simpson, the A's No. 2 first base prospect, impressed with a .319/.367/.543 line in his professional debut after he was drafted in the 15th round from Washington last year.

Familiar Faces: Lansing returns 17 players from the 2023 ballclub, not including second-year manager Craig Conklin and fourth-year pitching coach Don Schulze. Returners include James González, Euribiel Ángeles, Brayan Buelvas, Jonny Butler and Joshwan Wright, who each appeared in both 2022 and 2023, as well as Jack Owen, who has pitched effectively during each of the last three seasons.

Come Together: The Lugnuts' Opening Day roster includes players representing 10 states, Puerto Rico, and six countries: Canada, Colombia, Cuba, Dominican Republic, Panama and Venezuela.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: A day after allowing eight runs in the seventh inning at Fort Wayne, the Lugnuts exploded for 11 runs in the seventh to blow out the Tin-Caps, 13-4. The first 12 Nuts all reached base, six against reliever Henry Henry and six against reliever Spencer Kulman, including seven walks and two Henry balks. The Nuts drew 13 walks in total. It was the third time in franchise history that the Lugnuts had scored 11 runs in an inning.

2022: Pinch-hitter Jonny Butler's RBI single in the ninth had forced extra innings at West Michigan, and then Butler struck again with a tie-breaking single in the 11th to spark a four-run rally, seemingly pushing the Nuts to a thrilling victory at their archrival. But the Whitecaps tallied five runs in the bottom of the 11th against Daniel Martinez, winning the game on a Wenceel Pérez two-run double, 11-10.

Last Outing: Relieved James González in the 6th inning on Opening Night at Dayton with the Lugnuts leading 1-0... with one out, catcher's interference and a Leo Balcazar double put Dragons at 2nd and 3rd, but Myers whiffed Carlos Jorge and Sal Stewart to exit the threat... he then blazed through two perfect innings to hand the ball to Colton Johnson for a scoreless 9th, ending a 1-0 Nuts win... 43 pitches, 32 strikes.

Respect: Mitch posted the No. 3 score in the world in the video game *Super Monkey Ball...* he is also considered the top chess player in the Lugnuts' clubhouse.


Hometown Hero: Hometown of Lanett's motto is "The Gateway to Alabama," since it sits directly on the Eastern border to Georgia, directly bordering West Point, Georgia... pitched for Valley High School as a freshman and sophomore and Opelika High School as a junior and senior, posting a career 1.22 ERA with a fastball/curveball mix, playing third base, and batting third... father Barry starred in baseball at Jacksonville State.

The Buc Starts Here: Initially committed to University of Alabama, but coach instability led to Mitch joining juco Florida Southwestern State instead, making 15 appearances, 14 starts, in both 2017-18 and 2018-19... as a freshman: 5-6, 4.28, 2 CG, 73 2/3, 35 BB, 62 K, 1 HR... as a sophomore: 7-2, 3.29, 3 CG, 79 1/3, 23 BB, 88 K, 3 HR... became one of 10 Bucs to sign on with a D-I program (not including Ryan Gusto, who was drafted in the 11th round by the Astros).

Onward to Pitt: Upon transferring to Pittsburgh, made four starts in 2020 (2-2, 3.52, 23 IP, 4 BB, 30 K, 0 HR) before the season was shut down, with 10 strikeouts in six shutout innings vs. Lehigh... followed in 2021 as Pitt's Friday starter: 13 GS, 5-5, 3.21, 1 CG, 81 1/3, 23 BB, team-leading 83 K, 6 HR... tossed 9-IP CG at Virginia, 3/20/21, allowing three hits, one run, and whiffing five... the last Pitt Panther to appear in a game for the Nuts before Myers was also the only other Panther to play for the Nuts: T.J. Zeuch (pronounced "Zoyk"), the 21st pick in the 2016 draft, who made two starts in the Midwest League for Lansing in 2016 and spent 2022 with the Cincinnati Reds.

2022 Professional Debut: After signing for \$125,000 as the Athletics' 12th-round selection in 2021, did not appear in a Minor League game until 2022, spent entirely with Stockton... led Ports in starts (22, six more than the closest teammate), innings (124 1/3, 28 1/3 more innings than the closest teammate), and double plays (10)... worked seven innings five times, 6 2/3 innings once, 6 1/3 innings twice, and six innings four times: 12 starts of 22 starts lasting at least six innings... struggled in 12 games, 11 starts, at home (7.11 ERA, .304 avg, 16 HR, in 57 innings) compared to 11 starts on the road (4.14 ERA, .269, 10 HR in 67 1/3 innings)... lefties and righties hit nearly identically: .286/.355/.536 for lefties, .285/.339/.525 for righties, though righties hit 17 of the 26 home runs allowed... struggled mightily in first innings, allowing .353/.402/.627 slash line and six home runs... opposing base stealers swiped 10 bases in 16 attempts.

2023 with the Lugnuts: Opened season as the Nuts' Wednesday starter... tossed first quality start of the year on April 27, allowing two runs (both in the 5th) in six innings vs. Quad Cities April 27... followed up with a second quality start on May 4 vs. Dayton, though he once again received a no-decision... struck on the back of the head by a line drive against Peoria on June 13 and spent two weeks on the Injured List, missing his scheduled start at Wisconsin before returning to action at Great Lakes on July 3... tossed another quality start (6 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 BB, 6 K) against Quad Cities on July 27.

Last Outing: Dominated as the Lugnuts' Opening Night starter, April 5 at Dayton, needing only 51 pitches (40 strikes) to toss five scoreless innings... retired first 12 batters, allowed leadoff single to Cam Collier in the 5th, then mowed through final three batters... finished with six strikeouts... Mitch Myers and Colton Johnson completed the four-hit shutout in a 1-0 victory, the only run supplied by a Cameron Masterman RBI double in the sixth inning.

Third Time's a Charm: Career stats in Lansing: 3 yrs., 4.24, 10 G, 5 GS, 34 IP, 17 BB, 38 K - 2023: promoted from Stockton on August 15, to replace the promoted Brady Basso, and impressed in four appearances to conclude the year.

- 2022: five appearances from April 14-May 10, transferred to Stockton for the rest of the year.

The Bigger Picture: After signing as a free agent at age 18 in 2019, James jumped from the Dominican Summer League that initial professional season to the Arizona Complex League and the Low-A West in 2021, then joined the Lugnuts out of Extended Spring Training before finding a regular role in the Ports' rotation... in 2023, he ranked second in the California League in strikeouts (108) and seventh in innings pitched (87 1/3), recording four quality starts as the ace of the Stockton starting rotation, before he was called up to the Midwet League.

Changing Things Up: Former Lugnuts pitcher Stevie Emanuels, who broke out last season, earning a trip to the Arizona Fall League and a spot in Double-A to begin this season, credits James for teaching him his change-up grip last year while with Stockton.

Los Canaleros: Joins Joshwan Wright (Injured List) as native Panamanians on the Lugnuts' roster... both were on Team Panama's World Baseball Class team in 2023... made one appearance, allowing three hits and two runs without recording an out... the best players from Panama in baseball history: Mariano Rivera, Rod Carew, Carlos Lee, Bruce Chen, Juan Berenguer.
