TONIGHT'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Oklahoma City Dodgers close out their season-opening six-game series on Tuesday night at Dell Diamond. Round Rock RHP Collin Wiles is set to make his Triple-A debut on the mound while Oklahoma City plans to counter with RHP Josiah Gray. First pitch in the series finale is set for 6:05 p.m.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT

A dramatic Round Rock Express comeback attempt fell short as the Oklahoma City Dodgers handed the E-Train their first loss of the 2021 season with an 8-6 decision on Monday night at Dell Diamond. After OKC plated a run in the first inning, the Dodgers surged ahead with a six-run second, highlighted by a two-run Omar Estévez double and a three-run Zach Reks homer. E-Train C John Hicks put Round Rock on the board with an RBI single in the third, then after four scoreless frames, the Dodgers tacked on another run in the eighth. Round Rock's comeback attempt began in the bottom of the inning. Hicks and DH Jason Martin tallied consecutive RBI doubles to bring the E-Train within 8-3. 1B Curtis Terry then stepped to the plate and smoked his Triple-A West League-leading fourth home run of the season. The inning continued as RF Carl Chester advanced to first on an error before ultimately scoring on a Charles Leblanc single. However, OKC RHP Kevin Quackenbush shut down Round Rock's comeback attempt to seal the 8-6 decision.

ANOTHER DAY, ANOTHER DEBUT

Round Rock's scheduled starting pitcher, RHP Collin Wiles, is set to become the 11th member of the Express to make their Triple-A debut in 2021. The righty last pitched for the Double-A Frisco RoughRiders in 2019, finishing 0-3 with a 5.52 ERA (19 ER/31.0 IP) in nine games, including seven starts. Wiles struck out 22 and walked nine on the year.

TRACKING TERRY

E-Train 1B Curtis Terry collected his Triple-A West League-leading fourth home run of the season in Monday night's defeat. On the year, Terry is hitting 8-20 with two singles, two doubles and four home runs. He set a new career high with 25 longballs across 129 total games with Class A-Advanced Down East and Class-A Hickory back in 2019.

SPEAKING OF HOME RUNS...

The Express continue to lead the Triple-A West League in home runs with 13. Round Rock's .608 slugging percentage is also tops in the 10-team circuit. The Express and Salt Lake Bees are the only two clubs in the league with a home run in each of the first five games of 2021.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Ten members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021, RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, RHP Demarcus Evans, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, INF Charles Leblanc, RHP Ryder Ryan, INF Anderson Tejada, INF Curtis Terry and OF Leody Taveras. Two more Express players are seeking their Triple-A debuts with the club, RHP Collin Wiles and C Blake Grant-Parks. Interestingly enough, Evans, Tejada and Taveras all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no prior experience at the Triple-A level.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 16 different states: Arkansas, California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Maryland, Michigan, Mississippi, Nevada, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Five different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 24 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Anderson Tejada, OF Elier Hernandez and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.



An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.


