JUMBO SHRIMP RALLY FOR 3-2 WIN

Jacob Berry lashed a game-tying single in the ninth and Bennett Hostetler scored on a passed ball in the 10th inning on Thursday as Jacksonville came from behind to beat Norfolk 3-2. The Tides opened up the scoring in the second on a balk and sacrifice fly to make it 2-0. A Berry RBI double in the fourth halved the Jumbo Shrimp deficit before his game-tying hit in the ninth. Following Hostetler's run in the 10th, Jack Ralston worked a perfect bottom of the 10th for his first save. Patrick Monteverde worked 6.0 innings - the longest in a game for a Jumbo Shrimp starter this season - yielding two runs on six hits.

YOU'RE A SKY FULL OF ALL-STARS

Miami Marlins outfielder Kyle Stowers is scheduled to begin a rehab assignment on Friday with Jacksonville as he seeks to return from a Grade 1 hamstring strain. Stowers was the Marlins' All-Star in the 2025 Midsummer Classic, and the 28-year-old finished a breakout season by batting .288/.368/.544/.912 with 21 doubles, three triples, 25 home runs, 73 RBIs and 61 runs scored. Prior to getting traded to Miami in 2024, Stowers played in 243 games with Norfolk from 2021-24.

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE

The Jumbo Shrimp opened the 2026 season with a 1-6 record - the worst beginning to a season for any Jacksonville team in recorded club history (through 2005). The Jumbo Shrimp have rallied from that start to win five games in a row, evening their record to .500 and vaulting from 18th place to ninth place in the International League. Jacksonville has outscored its opponents 22-6 during this five-game run. During their 2025 championship season, the Jumbo Shrimp compiled five winning streaks of at least five games long.

SHUT DOWN CYCLE

Over the last five games, Jacksonville has yielded only six runs, five earned, on 17 hits in 48.0 innings (0.94 ERA). The club's pitching dominance coincides with a five-game winning streak to help the Jumbo Shrimp rebound from a 1-6 start - their worst in recorded club history (since at least 2005). During this five-game stretch, Jacksonville hurlers have combined to tally 65 strikeouts (35.5 percent of their 183 batters faced) against 25 walks.

'PEN PALS

Jacksonville's bullpen led Triple-A in ERA (3.64) and BAA (.214) in 2025 while also throwing the fifth-most innings (700.2) of any bullpen at the level. However, over the first five games of 2026, Jumbo Shrimp relievers combined to surrender 22 runs, 21 earned, on 27 hits (9.6 H/9) in 25.1 innings for a 7.46 ERA (21 BB, 7.5 BB/9, 38 K, 13.5 K/9). The club has turned that around over the last seven contests, yielding only three runs, two earned, on 11 hits (2.6 H/9) in 38.0 innings for a 0.47 ERA (14 BB, 3.3 BB/9, 62 K, 14.7 K/9). Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede one unearned run over their last 25.2 innings.

GOOD MORNING, GOOD AFTERNOON, GOODNIGHT

Jacksonville has recorded double-digit strikeouts in all but two games thus far in 2026, with the lone exceptions being a pair of nine-punchout performances. Jumbo Shrimp hurlers have tallied at least 14 strikeouts in seven of the last nine games, totaling 122 against 42 walks during that span. As a result, heading into play on Friday, Jacksonville leads all of Triple-A with 151 strikeouts on the season. The club's pitchers have combined to fan 32.3 percent of opposing hitters (MLB average: ~24.1%). Second-place Louisville's 128 strikeouts are closer to 17th-place than they are to Jacksonville in first.

TRUST THE PROCESS

Jacksonville ranks in the bottom five in Triple-A in several offensive categories, including average (.190), OBP (.310), SLG (.290), OPS (.600) and hits (72). The potential silver lining for the club has been they also own Triple-A's second-lowest BABIP at .249, far below the baseball-wide average of roughly .300. Perhaps encouragingly is that the Jumbo Shrimp rank much higher, even if not elite, at the level in chase rate (17th, 27.7 percent), hard-hit percentage (19th, 35.0 percent), barrel percentage (20th, 5.3 percent), and average exit velocity (20th, 87.8).

POPCORN SHRIMP

Jacksonville is just 13-for-84 (.155) with runners in scoring position over the last eight games... Robby Snelling's outing on April 3, when he surrendered three runs in 4.0 innings, marked the first time in 14 Triple-A starts that he yielded more than two runs.

ABOUT ROBBY

-Snelling was originally selected by the San Diego Padres in the supplemental first round (39th overall) of the 2022 draft.

-MLB Pipeline ranks Snelling as the No. 39 prospect in baseball entering 2026.

-On July 30, 2024, the Padres traded Snelling, infielders Jay Beshears and Graham Pauley and right-handed pitcher Adam Mazur to the Miami Marlins in exchange for right-handed pitcher Bryan Hoeing and left-handed pitcher Tanner Scott.

-As a senior at Robert McQueen High School in Nevada, Snelling set a Nevada record for strikeouts in a seven-inning game with 20 strikeouts and posted a state large-class record with 145 strikeouts in 62.1 innings. He posted a 0.56 ERA.

-Snelling was a star high school quarterback and linebacker, and as a 4-star linebacker recruit, had offers to be a two-sport athlete in college. He likely would have committed to Arizona to play both sports, but when then-U of A baseball coach Jay Johnson accepted the same position at LSU, Snelling committed there to only play baseball. He passed on that commitment to sign with the Padres.

-During the summer of 2021, he participated in the High School All-American Game as well as in the All-Star High School Home Run Derby at Coors Field where he hit 21 home runs.

2025 SEASON

-Snelling was named the Marlins' Minor League Pitcher of the Year, an International League All-Star and a 2025 Rawlings Gold Glove Award® recipient for defensive excellence. He is the just the fifth Jacksonville player ever to earn a Gold Glove.
