TODAY'S GAME: The M-Braves continue a six-game home series against the Montgomery Biscuits at Trustmark Park. This is the first of five series between the two clubs, who will meet a total of 30 times. They will meet 18 times at Trustmark Park and 12 times at Riverwalk Stadium.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The M-Braves dropped their fifth in a row in an 8-5 loss to the Biscuits.


- Greg Jones gave Montgomery a lead two pitches in with a solo homer to the right field bullpen to lead off the game. The Biscuits scored in four of the first six innings and carried a 6-0 lead into the seventh
- The M-Braves found their offense late. Landon Stephens homered for a second straight game with a lined shot to the left field corner to make it 6-1. Andrew Moritz scored a Beau Philip double with his first hit of the season to make it 7-2 in the eighth. Trailing 8-2 in the ninth, Drew Lugbauer pounded an RBI double off the wall in right to score a run. Then, Beau Philip laced a two-run double down the right field line to make it 8-5. Moritz struck out looking to end the game.
- In his first career start for the M-Braves, LHP Domingo Robles allowed three runs in three innings with four strikeouts. RHP Alec Barger highlighted the bullpen with two shutout innings.
- THE RETURN OF THE SLUGBAUER: 1B Drew Lugbauer, the M-Braves all-time and single-season home run leader, returns for a third season. Lugbauer entered the season with a club record 46 home runs over two seasons. He hit 18 home runs in 2021 and led the Southern League and Braves minor league system with 28 homers in 2022. On September 9, 2022, he surpassed Ernesto Mejia's (2011) and Mike Hessman's (2001) single-season M-Braves franchise record (26)
- The first baseman currently ranks as Atlanta's No. 29 prospect in Baseball America. He added to his own club record with his 49th M-Braves home run on Saturday at Chattanooga. He has three homers in 2023, tied for second in the Southern League.
- MILLI ROCK: The versatile OF/IF Cody Milligan has hit in eight of nine games. He currently ranks in the top 10 in the Southern League in batting (.353, 4th), hits (12, T-2nd), doubles (T-1st), and OPS (1.106, 6th)
- Milligan played in 68 games for the M-Braves last season. He slashed .271/.345/.326 with one home run, 10 doubles, and 21 RBI.
- THE LEGEND OF ARDEN PABST: In two games with the M-Braves in 2023, Pabst hit a homer in back-to-back games, making it four home runs in nine games for the M-Braves in his career. Pabst played eight games for the M-Braves last season, hitting .296 (8-for-27) with two hom-ers and six RBI. He homered twice in the final series of the sesaon against Montgomery.
- "YOU CAN KISS IT GOODBYE": The M-Braves are third in the Southern League with 11 homers and have eight long balls in the last four games. Seven different players have at least one home run with Drew Lugbauer (3), Arden Pabst (2), and Landon Stephens (2) homering multiple times.

SIZZLIN' BULLPEN: The M-Braves bullpen has posted a 3.25 ERA over 47 innings in the first 10 games

- RHP Kyle Wilcox posted 4.1 shutout innings in four appearances with eight strikeouts, touch-ing 100 miles per hour on his fastball. Wilcox is in his second year with the Atlanta organiza-
- RHP Victor Vodnik tossed three shutout innings in three appearances before allowing two runs in his fourth relief appearance. Vodnik received a NRI to Atlanta's spring training. He is currently Atlanta's No. 11 prospect on MLB Pipeline.
- LHP Hayden Deal has allowed one run in 5.1 innings and picked up his first win with two in-nings of relief on Tuesday. Deal made 31 appearances, four starts, in a long relief role for the M-Braves last season.
- RHP **Alec Barger** has seven shutout innings over four relief appearances in his first Double-A season. Barger made 38 appearances for High-A Rome last season.
- RHP Domingo Gonzalez has allowed two runs in 5.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. He picked up the first M-Braves save of the season on Tueday.
- BIG WHEELS KEEP ON TURNING: The M-Braves have already had several roster moves early in the season, with four players being promoted to Triple-A. RHP Kyle Wilcox, RHP Beau Burrows, JF Luke Waddell, C Hendrik Clementina, and LHP Domingo Robles have all been promoted to Gwinnett this sesaon. Robles was transferred back to Double-A Mississippi on Thursday


