TONIGHT'S GAME

Tonight's series opener at Dell Diamond will feature the Round Rock Express playing as the Chupacabras and the El Paso Chihuahuas as the Margaritas as part of Minor League Baseball's Copa de la Diversión campaign, a nationwide initiative to celebrate the culture and values of Hispanic and Latino communities. First pitch is set for 7:05 p.m.

Tonight's game can be heard live on the flagship home of the Round Rock Express, AM 1300 The Zone. Online audio is also available at am1300thezone.iheart.com and via the iHeart Radio app. Express Director of Broadcasting Mike Capps handles play-by-play duties while former Round Rock RHP Ross Ohlendorf provides color commentary.

LAST TIME OUT

The Round Rock Express earned a series sweep with a 4-3 win over the Salt Lake Bees on Tuesday night at Smith's Ballpark. Round Rock's pitching staff totaled 16 strikeouts, including nine by starter RHP Wade LeBlanc, who made his E-Train debut. The Express put a run across in the first inning when 2B Eli White hit a single to bring in CF Leody Taveras. The Bees responded as RF Jo Adell hit a leadoff home run to tie the contest at 1-1 in the bottom of the frame. In the fourth, Round Rock 1B Curtis Terry launched a two-run dinger to center field that also scored White. Salt Lake 1B Matt Thaiss hit a two-run homer in the sixth, crossing home with DH Luis Rengifo to tie it up at 3-3. In the seventh, SS Anderson Tejeda singled before stealing second. On the play, Salt Lake C Francisco Arcia committed a throwing error, allowing Tejeda to race home with the go-ahead run. After allowing a leadoff triple in the eighth, RHP Drew Anderson struck out the side, preserving the 4-3 victory.

GAVIGLIO ON THE MOUND

RHP Sam Gaviglio is scheduled to get his fifth start of the season in Thursday's contest. In his two home appearances, Gaviglio earned one win while throwing for a 3.97 ERA (5 ER/11.1 IP) and striking out 15 batters.

HOW SWEEP IT IS

Round Rock's series sweep over the Salt Lake Bees from May 27 to June 1 marked the first six-game sweep in franchise history. The win also marked the first time this season that a Triple-A West League team has swept a six-game series. Three teams in the Triple-A East League have completed the feat: Omaha. St. Paul and Nashville.

LONG TIME RIVALRY

Round Rock and El Paso are reviving their instate rivalry in the Triple-A West League, the third different league to see the foes face off. Having met a total of 191 times, both teams spent time as members of the Double-A Texas League before their time in the Triple-A Pacific Coast League. The Express hold a 58-32 lead over the Chihuahuas in games played at Dell Diamond and are welcoming the team to town for the first time since 2017.

A FAMILIAR FACE

Round Rock RHP Nick Vincent spent 2015 as a member of El Paso's pitching staff. He finished his season out west with 40 appearances and a 5-3 record. He allowed 17 earned runs in 50.1 relief innings for a 3.04 ERA. Of the 209 total batters Vincent faced, he walked 15 and struck out 68.

EL PASO'S LOCAL TIES

Four members of the Chihuahuas are returning to Central Texas this week. RHP Mason Thompson grew up in the area, attending Round Rock High School before being selected by the San Diego Padres in the third round of the 2016 draft. C Michael Cantu attended college at The University of Texas and is in his second season as a backstop for El Paso. Finally, two former members of the Express are returning to Round Rock, INF Nick Tanielu (2019) and OF Patrick Kivlehan (2016).

INTERNATIONAL SUCCESS

Express INF Yonny Hernandez recorded an RBI single in Venezuela's 5-0 victory over Canada in Wednesday's Baseball Americas Qualifier in Florida. The win helped Venezuela to a 3-0 record and sent the team to the Super Round, where they are set to play the Dominican Republic on Friday.

ONE STEP CLOSER TO THE SHOW

Twelve members of the Round Rock Express have made their Triple-A debuts so far in 2021, RHP Jason Bahr, OF Carl Chester, RHP Demarcus Evans, INF Yonny Hernandez, INF Jake Hoover, C Jack Kruger, INF Charles Leblanc, RHP Ryder Ryan, INF Anderson Tejeda, INF Curtis Terry, OF Leody Taveras and RHP Collin Wiles. C Blake Grant-Parks is also seeking his Triple-A debut with the Express. Interestingly enough, Evans, Tejeda and Taveras all saw action with the Texas Rangers during the shortened 2020 season despite no experience at the Triple-A level. C Jack Kruger also suited up for the Los Angeles Angels in 2021 before making his Triple-A debut with Round Rock in May.

STATING THE FACTS

American-born players on Round Rock's roster hail from 15 different states: California, Florida, Georgia, Illinois, Kansas, Louisiana, Maryland, Nevada, New York, North Carolina, Oregon, South Carolina, Texas, Utah and Virginia. RHP Jake Lemoine is the lone Texan on the roster, hailing from Bridge City. Lemoine was a standout pitcher at the University of Houston before being drafted by the Texas Rangers in 2012.

AROUND THE WORLD

Six different nations are represented on the Express roster. In addition to the 22 players from the United States, INF Charles Leblanc is Canadian, INF Andy Ibáñez was born in Cuba, INF Anderson Tejeda and OF Leody Taveras hail from the Dominican Republic, RHP Jharel Cotton is a native of the U.S. Virgin Islands and C Yohel Pozo and INF Yonny Hernandez are Venezuelan.

EXPRESS MANAGER KENNY HOLMBERG

The 2021 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Kenny Holmberg's 13th year in the Texas Rangers organization. In 2020, he worked with Rangers prospects at the Alternate Training Site in Arlington, as well as the Fall Developmental League in Arizona. Round Rock will be the fourth different club for which Holmberg has managed in the Rangers farm system after serving at the helm of Short-Season Spokane in 2018, the Rookie-level Arizona League Rangers from 2013-2015 and the Rookie-level Dominican Summer League Rangers from 2010-2011. He has compiled a 207-172 (.546) record while leading his clubs to the postseason in four of his six managerial campaigns, including a Northwest League championship series appearance in 2018. He originally joined the Texas organization as a coach for the DSL Rangers in 2009 and



also served as a coach for the club's High-A affiliate in Myrtle Beach in 2012. In addition to his managerial post for the Express, Holmberg also serves as the Rangers' Major League Infield Coordinator.

An infielder in his playing days, Holmberg was selected by Milwaukee in the 22nd round of the 2005 MLB draft and played four seasons in the Brewers organization. He compiled a .272 average with 34 home runs and 187 RBI over 338 career minor league games. Holmberg was also selected by the Toronto Blue Jays in the 49th round of the 2001 MLB draft out of Dunedin High School in Florida but opted to play collegiately at St. Petersburg College from 2002-2003. He then spent two seasons at Embry-Riddle Aeronautical University, earning first-team NAIA All-America honors in 2005.
