LAST GAME

Make it six-straight wins for the Bowie Baysox. For the third time in four games, Bowie broke a tie game with Harrisburg late, this time securing a 5-4 win. Colton Cowser drilled an early home run for his eighth with Bowie, but Wilson Garcia matched the power with a two-run blast in the bottom of the frame. After each side traded individual runs, including a solo home run by Joey Ortiz, held the game tied at three into the eighth inning. An error in deep left field allowed Bowie to score a go-ahead run, and an RBI single by John Rhodes gave Bowie insurance for the win, as Griffin McLarty and Clayton McGinness turned in strong relief outings for the win and save, respectively.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The second half has not been too kind to Harrisburg, entering this series at just 10-17 in the half, partly due to an ERA 5.35. Bowie and Harrisburg have gone back-and-forth this season, after Bowie had a stretch of five wins in six games against the Senators, including a no-hitter, Harrisburg won the final five games of a seven-game series in June. Harrisburg pitching has held Bowie to just a .211 batting average this season, and sport a 3.42 ERA against the Baysox.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-hander Tim Cate is taking his second lap with the Senators after struggling to put up strong numbers in 2021. While spending his entire 2021 in the Harrisburg rotation the career leader in strikeouts at the University of Connecticut only managed a 2-10 record with just 81 strikeouts in over 96 innings, and was given a reset at High-A to start 2022. After 12 appearances overpowering the younger batters at High-A, Cate has made three appearances back with Harrisburg this season, but his numbers are looking similar to 2021 so far. He's already allowed 13 runs in just under 13 innings, and has only struck out 10 batters. His history and profile still offers high hopes for him, while his fastball doesn't hit too hard, he sports a strong curveball, and an average changeup.

EARLY STRIKE

Bowie has always been a team to make a quick jump at opposing pitchers, as the first inning of games sees some of Bowie's best numbers. Bowie has scored a run in the first inning in each of their last four games, and leads the league in batting average in the first inning (.295) but they do, however, only have the fourth-most runs scored in the first inning of games this season (65), and have the most runners left on base in the first inning at 188, an average of 1.9 runners left on base in just the first inning of each game.

JOLTIN' JOEY

Baysox infielder Joey Ortiz had an incredible stretch from July into August. In 27 games, Ortiz went already gone 43-for-105 (.410) at the plate with hits in 25 games, 14 multi-hit games, nine doubles, a triple, his first career multi-home run game on July 15, and led the team with 29 runs scored. Ortiz was ranked as the Orioles #15 prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline, #16 according to Baseball America. He has already played more games this season than in 2021, due to a torn labrum in his left shoulder in late June that season.

EVENING THINGS UP

On their current stretch of nine wins in their last ten games, Bowie enters Saturday's game with a chance to get back to .500 on the season. This year, Bowie is only 1-5 in games where they are one game under .500 and trying to return to an even mark. Bowie has not been .500 since April 29th, when they were 9-9 on the season, and were a season-low 16 games under .500 following a loss to Erie on June 24th, when they were 25-41. Since they were 16 games under .500, Bowie has gone 24-9, three more wins than any other team in the Eastern League.

STAYING UP LATE

Things have not always gone in Bowie's favor late in game this season, including seven walk-off losses in just the first half of the season. The last week has turned things around for Bowie, however, as they've got a +29 run differential in the seventh, eighth, and ninth innings over their last ten games. Entering this stretch, Bowie had a -23 run differential in that same span of innings over the season.
