GAME 40: After blowing a 3-0 lead in the 9th inning in the series opener but bouncing back with a huge 9th inning last night in a 7-2 win, the FredNats will look to win the first half of the series in Salem against the Red Sox. RHP Riley Cornelio gets the start today for the FredNats and is coming off a very strong start at home against Columbia in which he pitched five innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts. Corelio has been up and down this year in his first year of pro ball, but his highs have been very good. He faces off against RHP Jose Ramirez who is not the Cleveland Guardians' All-Star third baseman. Ramirez has been very good for Salem this year, sporting a 1.21 ERA for the Red Sox.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Salem scored two runs in the 1st inning off Jarlin Susana, but the Red Sox were held off the scoreboard the rest of the game by the FredNat pitching staff. Susana pitched four innings, and the FredNat bullpen got out of a jam in the 7th with the bases loaded. Marquis Grissom Jr. induced an inning-ending double play to keep the game tied at 2. Paul Witt had two hits and two RBI, and Brady House hit the go-ahead two-run single in the 9th, the first of five runs in the 9th for the FredNats, who held on for a 7-2 victory to even the series at one game apiece.

LA CASA: After tearing it up in the month of April, Brady House has had a slower month of May. However, in the last couple weeks, he's returning to his early-season form. He currently is on a five-game hitting streak, and in his last 10 games, he's 10-for-36 with five extra base hits, four RBI and four walks. He's also stolen three bases without being caught. He's returned to the MLB Top-100 Prospect List, checking in at number 91.

HOLDING CORT: Returning FredNat Cortland Lawson has taken huge strides at the plate in 2023. The Virginia native was drafted in the 14th round of the 2022 draft out of Tennessee, and the infielder has a wRC+ of 164 (100 is average), and a wOBA of .445 (.320 is average). Lawson leads the FredNats with a .912 OPS in 21 games, and had two hits and a run scored last night. He also has a .500 BABIP, which is batting average on balls in play, which indicates when he hits the ball, he's hitting it very hard.

STEHLY POWER: Despite only playing 2-3 games per week, FredNat infielder Murphy Stehly has the longest hitting streak of the season for a FredNat at 13 games. Stehly, a 10th round draft pick of the Washington Nationals last summer out of Texas, played one game with the FredNats last year after the draft before being injured in that game.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 32, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

THE STAFF: Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freleigh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.), and 2SP Sports. Freleigh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

A LASTING LEGACY: The Fredericksburg Nationals adopt the franchise history of their predecessors in the Carolina League dating back to 1978...the Alexandria Dukes (1978, 1980-83) and Alexandria Mariners (1979) played at Four Mile Run Park in Alexandria, Virginia...the Prince William Pirates (1984-1986), Prince William Yankees (1987-1988), Prince William Cannons (1989-1998), Potomac Cannons (1999-2004) and Potomac Nationals (2005-2019) played at G. Richard Pfitzner Stadium in Woodbridge, Virginia...the franchise has won five Mills Cup Championships, as the Dukes in 1982, as the Yankees in 1989, and as the Nationals in 2008, 2010 and 2014.

TONIGHT'S START: Riley Cornelio made his professional debut for the Fredericksburg Nationals in a start at Fayetteville this season, after being selected in the 7th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. The 22 year-old righty more than answered the bell, firing five innings with just one earned run, while picking up seven punchouts to just a pair of walks. However, he was saddled with the loss in a 3-2 defeat against the Woodpeckes

A stalwart for the TCU Horned Frogs, Cornelio led the team in '22 with 15 starts, and also finished first with 77 strikeouts in 75.0 innings of work.

The right-hander excelled in Big 12 action, posting a 3.12 ERA with 40 strikeouts in just seven starts. His work earned him 2nd Team All Big-12 honors.

HIGH HONORS: Cornelio was a highly touted arm coming out of Pine Creek HS in Monument, Colorado. Baseball America tabbed him as the top overall draft prospect in the state for 2019, as he earned both the Perfect Game and Gatorade Colorado Player of the Year award in his senior campaign

LAST TIME OUT: Riley Cornelio bounced back very nicely in his last appearance against the Columbia Fireflies. With the FredNats looking to snap a slide against the Fireflies, Cornelio turned in five innings of one run ball to keep things close. While he did not get the win on his record, the Nats did pick up a 2-1 victory in the game.
