### GAME ONE: [The Wisconsin Timber Rattlers advanced defeated the Lake County Captains 5-4 on Sunday night to take a 1-0 lead in the best-of-three Midwest League Championship Series.](#)

Cooper Pratt broke a 4-4 tie with a two-out, RBI double off third base in the bottom of the eighth. Tyler Bryant pitched a scoreless ninth for his second save of the postseason. All five games that have been played in the Midwest League Playoffs this year have been decided by one run.

**EARLY IN THE GAME:** Lake County scored twice in the top of the first inning on a two-out single by Ralph Velazquez with an error on the play. Wisconsin rallied for three runs in the bottom of the first on an RBI single by Luke Adams, an RBI grounder by Yophery Rodriguez, and an RBI single by Matt Wood. Wulfrido Antunez tied the game 3-3 with a two-out, RBI single in the second. Hedbert Perez gave Wisconsin a 4-3 lead with double to score Tayden Hall from first with a little help on an error. Lake County scored the tying run in the fourth without a hit on a walk, a balk, a grounder, and a sacrifice fly from Angel Genao.

#### STARTING FIRES AND PUTTING THEM OUT:

Wisconsin used six pitchers on Sunday night. They combined to walk ten Lake County batters. They also combined to strike out fourteen and held the Captains to 2-for-14 with runners in scoring position.

**THANK YOU FANS!** Wisconsin played two home games in the 2024 playoffs with attendances of 4,428 for the game against Quad Cities and 4,183 for the game against Lake County for a total of 8,611.

**PLAYING FOR THE PENNANT:** This is Wisconsin's first appearance in the Midwest League Championship Series since the league moved up to the High-A classification. The Rattlers made the Championship Series in 1996, 1999, 2005, and 2012. Wisconsin won the pennant in 2012. The Appleton Foxes, the team that became the Rattlers in 1995, won eight Midwest League pennants (1964, 1966, 1967, 1969, 1978, 1982, 1983, and 1984) from 1962-1994.

**ABOUT THE LAKE COUNTY CAPTAINS:** Lake County joined the Midwest League in 2010 from the South Atlantic League. They started out as the Columbus RedStixx in Georgia before moving to Eastlake, Ohio after the 2002 season. The Captains are the Midwest League affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The franchise has been affiliated with Cleveland since it was known as the Columbus Indians in 1991. Lake County won the Midwest League title in 2010 and lost to Kane County in the 2014 Midwest League Championship Series. They were the East Division Champions in 2022 and lost to the South Bend Cubs in the Midwest League Championship Series. Lake County went 77-53 during the 2024 regular season and qualified for the playoffs by winning the first half East Division title. They swept Dayton in the East Finals.

**ABOUT THE GUARDIANS:** Cleveland was the parent club of the old Appleton Papermakers in 1941, 1942, and 1946. Mike Garcia was the most notable Papermaker to play for the Indians. Cleveland's affiliation history in the Midwest League includes the Dubuque Packers from 1962-64 and Waterloo from 1977-1988.

**PROSPECTING IN THE SERIES:** [MLB Pipeline](#) places five active Rattlers on their list of Brewers Top 30 Prospects: Cooper Pratt (#2), Yophery Rodriguez (#6), Luke Adams (#8), Luis Lara (#16), and Jader Areinamo (#21). Blake Burke (#15) is currently on the IL. [MLB Pipeline](#) has seven Captains on their list of Cleveland prospects: Travis Bazzana (#1), Ralph Velazquez (#4), Angel Genao (#5), Jacob Cozart (#12), Alex Mooney (#23), Jake Fox (#26), and Matt Wilkinson (#30).

# PITCHING MATCHUP

## WISCONSIN STARTING PITCHER:

**RHP ALEXANDER CORNIELLE:** Milwaukee signed Cornielle as an International Free Agent out of the Dominican Republic on June 15, 2019.

**FAST DEBUT:** Cornielle made his professional debut with one inning of relief against the Cubs #2 affiliate in the Dominican Summer League on August 2, 2019. He allowed one run on no hits with two walks in one inning. Cornielle made three appearances in the DSL in 2019 with no record.

**HIT PLAY:** Cornielle started 2021 with the Brewers Blue affiliate in the Arizona Complex League and was 4-2 in nine games – four starts – with a 4.64 ERA and 50 strikeouts over 33 innings. With Carolina in the end of the season, he was 0-1 in two starts with ten strikeouts in eight innings.

**WEEKLY AWARDS:** Cornielle was named the ACL's Pitcher of the Week on September 6, 2021. He also won the Midwest League Pitcher of the Week Award on September 11, 2023.

**BACK IN 2022:** Cornielle was 9-7 in 22 games – 19 starts – with a 3.19 ERA and 124 strikeouts over 101-2/3 innings pitched for the Carolina Mudcats this season before joining the Timber Rattlers on August 23. He was second in the Carolina League in strikeouts and third in the Carolina League in ERA before his promotion to Wisconsin. Cornielle was 1-0 in three starts with 21 strikeouts over 17-1/3 innings pitched.

**LAST SEASON:** Cornielle was 1-3 in twenty games – eighteen starts – for Wisconsin. He walked 34, struck out 92, and compiled a 4.55 ERA in 89 innings pitched for the Rattlers.

**LAST START:** Cornielle won Game One of the West Division Finals at Quad Cities on [September 10](#). He allowed two hits and walked four with five strikeouts over 5-2/3 scoreless innings.

**VS. LAKE COUNTY:** Cornielle has never pitched against the Captains prior to this evening. The last time he pitched against an affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians was in 2022 when he was 0-2 in three games – two starts – as a member of the Carolina Mudcats against the Lynchburg Hillcats. Cornielle allowed nine runs – six earned – on ten hits and thirteen walks with thirteen strikeouts over 12-2/3 innings.

## LAKE COUNTY STARTING PITCHER:

**LHP MATT WILKINSON:** The Cleveland Guardians selected Wilkinson in the tenth round of the 2023 draft out of Central Arizona College. MLB Pipeline has Wilkinson as the #30 prospect in the Guardians organization. *Baseball America* has him at #28.

**CANADIAN ORIGIN STORY:** Wilkinson started out at the age of 16 playing for Okotoks in the Western Canadian League in 2019 where he was 1-1 with a 4.26 ERA. He would pitch for Okotoks again in the summer from 2021 through 2023.

**ARIZONA TERRITORY:** Wilkinson pitched two seasons for Central Arizona College and was 15-4 with two saves in 35 appearances – seventeen starts. He had an ERA of 1.38 and 221 strikeouts in 137 innings pitched during his career. Wilkinson was a member of the Vaqueros team that won the 2022 NJCAA Division I College World Series.

**TIMBER RATTTLERS TIES:** Former Timber Rattlers outfielder Tristan Peters was a teammate of Wilkinson in Okotoks during the 2019 season. Former Timber Rattlers pitcher Tyler Woessner and Wilkinson were teammates in 2022 at Central Arizona. Current Timber Rattlers pitching coach Josh Spence played at Central Arizona in 2007 and 2008.

**PRO CAREER:** Wilkinson made a one-inning relief appearance for the ACL Guardians in 2023 after signing his pro contract. He began this season with the Lynchburg Hillcats in the Carolina League, and he was 3-1 with a 1.12 ERA in eight starts with 71 strikeouts over 40-1/3 innings before his promotion to Lake County on May 21. Wilkinson made sixteen starts in the regular season with the Captains and was 5-5 with a 2.30 ERA and 103 strikeouts over 78-1/3 innings.

**LAST START:** Wilkinson had a no decision at Dayton on [September 10](#) in Game One of the East Division Finals. He allowed two runs – one earned – on five hits with three walks and two strikeouts over 5-2/3 innings.

**VS. WISCONSIN:** Wilkinson has never pitched against the Timber Rattlers prior to this evening. Tonight is also the first time he will pitch against an affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers.
