"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

SAINTS SMASH TWO GRAND SLAMS, PULVERIZE INDY ON TUESDAY: The St. Paul Saints whacked two grand slams in a game for just the third time in franchise history, hit four total home runs, and scored a season-high in runs in a 16-4 drubbing of Indianapolis to open the eight-game series on Tuesday afternoon. Eight of nine Saints collected a hit while five St. Paul starters had multi-hit days. Carson McCusker and Ryan Fitzgerald each hit their first career grand slams in affiliated ball. McCusker's first-inning grand salami capped a five-run inning and pulled him into the International League lead in swats with his sixth of the season. Armando Alvarez crushed a 401-foot blast to right field for his second of the year, a two-run big fly to extend the lead to 7-1 in the third. Mickey Gasper added his first homer of the year in the sixth on a solo shot and Ryan Fitzgerald took position player Alike Williams deep with the bases juiced in the eighth. Jeferson Morales (4-4, BB) and Alvarez (2-2, BB, 2 HBP) each reached in all five of their plate appearances, marking the first time in Saints history that two hitters reached in all of their plate appearances with 5 or more trips in a game. Ryan Fitzgerald finished with 5 RBI to match his career-high. Fitzgerald's 5 RBI are the most in a single-game for a Saints hitter since Yunior Severino's 6 RBI game on July 31 last year @Iowa.

ISN'T THAT GRAND?: The Saints touched off for two grand slams in Tuesday's win vs Indianapolis, marking the third time in franchise history the Saints have had multiple home runs with the bases loaded in the same game (see below). The Saints are now one of four teams in Triple-A with multiple grand slams on the season (also: Columbus & Worcester-3 each & Iowa w/ 2):

GIVE ME ALL THE RUNS: After Tuesday's season-high 16 runs scored, the Saints now rank 11th out of 20 International League teams in runs-per-game, averaging 4.9/game entering play on Wednesday. The Saints rank fifth in team batting average (.260) and fourth in OPS (.774) in the International League so far this year. In their eight wins this season, the Saints have scored 57 runs (an average of 7.1/game) while in their 10 losses, they've scored just 21 (2.1/game). One of the Saints inconsistencies in run-scoring has been hitting with runners in scoring position. After going 9-for-18 in Tuesday's win, they now rank fourth in the International League with a .278 average (50-180) w/ RISP. In their eight wins this year, St. Paul are hitting .348 (39-112) situationally and just .162 (11-68) in losses.

MCCUSKER MASHING: Saints outfielder Carson McCusker is crushing the ball to open the season and currently ranks 2nd in Triple-A in average exit velocity to start the year (see below). The 6-8 slugger has hit all six of his homers in the past 11 games. He ranks t-2nd in MiLB behind only Las Vegas' Nick Kurtz (the A's top prospect was just called up) and he has the most HR in the minor leagues since April 9, the date of his first homer. McCusker has two of the top-5 hardest hit balls by a St. Paul hitter this season and four of the top-10, including a 114.2 mph single on April 2 in Columbus that ranks t-9th in exit velocity in Saints history. While his top-end exit velos are impressive, he also ranked 4th in the International League with a 63.9% hard-hit rate (min 20 PA), meaning over 60% of his batted balls are put in play at 95 mph or harder.

CHALLENGE ACCEPTED: After two missed challenges in Saturday's game in Iowa, the Saints had been incorrect on 16 consecutive ABS challenges dating back until April 6. They flipped that script by going 3-for-3 Tuesday vs Indianapolis, including Yunior Severino avoiding a strikeout with a critical challenge in the first inning that led to a bases loaded walk and allowed McCusker the chance to come up and hit a grand slam two batters later.

WALKIN' DOWN THE LINE: St. Paul's 94 walks drawn as an offense currently ranks t-5th in the International League entering play Tuesday, but on a walks-per-game basis, they lead the league averaging 5.2 bases on balls per game. The Saints' .369 team on-base percentage also leads the International League. The Saints had drawn at least two walks in each game this season until drawing just one on Saturday in Iowa and have taken four or more bases on balls in 13-of-18 contests so far this year. Mike Ford and Emmanuel Rodriguez both currently lead the Saints with 12 walks drawn apiece. Mike Ford owns a .371 career on-base percentage and has walked at a 14 career BB-rate in his MiLB career. Emmanuel Rodriguez now has drawn 212 base on balls since 2023, his first season in A-ball, which is top-25 in the minor leagues over that span.

START ME UP: The Saints starting rotation has gotten off to a solid start to the year, spinning a 3.36 ERA among starters that ranks 7th in the International League. If you throw out Andrew Morris' outing last Wednesday in Iowa (7 ER, 3.2 IP), the Saints starting staff have a 2.62 ERA (20 ER, 68.2 IP), which would lead the Triple-A circuit. The rotation went off with a bang to start the season when David Festa, Zebby Matthews, and then Andrew Morris all went at least 5.0 shutout in three consecutive starts, the first time in Saints history that three consecutive St. Paul starters have done so. (It's only the second time ever that Saints starters have not allowed a run in three consecutive games with the last coming from June 29-July 1, 2023 when Randy Dobnak and Blyane Enlow threw 5.0 shutout in back-to-back games before Dallas Kuechel went 4.1 scoreless the following night, all against Gwinnett).

THE STARS OF TOMORROW, TODAY: The Saints' current roster features eight of Minnesota's Top-30 prospects according to MLB.com and nine according to Baseball America while also touting four of Minnesota's top-10 prospects on the MLB Pipeline list. The Twins prospects in the rankings include OF Emmanuel Rodriguez (No. 2, MLB.com, No. 2 BA), RHP Zebby Matthews (-/4), RHP Marco Raya (6/8), RHP Andrew Morris (9/10), RHP Cory Lewis (11/20), INF Payton Elees (23/17-currently on 7-day IL), RHP Travis Adams (22/22), C Diego Cartaya (24/21), & C Jair Camargo (-/23). Rodriguez checks in at the No. 19 on the MLB Pipeline's top-100 prospects and No. 37 on Baseball America's list.

TWINS REPORT: The Minnesota Twins (8-15) snapped out of a three-game funk thanks to a diving catch by Byron Buxton to end the game last night at Target Field, a 4-2 win over the White Sox. Luke Keaschall went 1-for-2 and is 5-for-14 (.357) with a pair of doubles & 2 RBI in his first four games in the majors since going up. Down on the farm, Double-A Wichita (9-7) have won three straight since a four-game skid. Outfielder Tyler Fedko, a 12th round pick out of UConn by the Twins in 2021, has reached base in 12 consecutive games to start the year and is hitting .351 with a 1.257 OPS that ranks 2nd in the Texas League. High-A Cedar Rapids (10-5) and Low-A Fort Myers (9-7) have each won three straight entering play Wednesday.

LAST APPEARANCE: Following 10.0 scoreless innings to open the season, saw his streak of 10 straight zeros come to an end in the first inning on Wednesday in Iowa. Gave up singles to two of the first three batters before an RBI groundout from Jonathon Long saw his first run allowed this year score. Allowed the leadoff man to reach in each of his first three innings, and allowed a run to score in all four innings pitched in. Was chased after giving up a solo homer to Moises Ballesteros with two outs in the fourth. The seven runs allowed was a career-high. Peaked with a 99.3 mph fastball to strike out Christian Franklin in the second, a career-high in velocity.

ON THE FAST TRACK: In just his second full-season in the minors last year, Morris ascended through three levels of the minor league ladder to finish the year making his first six starts at the Triple-A level. It's not the first time that Morris has accelerated at a faster pace than his peers. He graduated high school at just 16 years old, starting his freshman season of college at just 17. He was born on the cutoff date of September 1 for starting school and his mother chose to start him in kindergarten a year ahead. Not only that, he also skipped second grade as he was being homeschooled in Alaska.

BUILDING UP TRAVEL POINTS: Although he was born in New York City, Morris claims Boulder, Colorado as his hometown. He moved from NYC as a child to Oregon, then to Alaska, and then to Colorado, where he attended Monarch High School in Boulder. He tells people Boulder is where he's from as that's where he lived the longest.

LET'S GET FUNKY: Lacking the prototypical build of a frontline starter, Morris' unusual delivery has been noted as a reason why hitters have such a hard time picking up his pitches. Fangraphs prospect writer Eric Longenhagen noted in [last year's mid-season report](#) that "Morris' delivery is weird. He has a high front side throughout his delivery and creates a slight crossfire angle with stride direction before throwing out of a high arm slot. It's rare for cross-bodied pitchers to also have a north/south arm slot this extreme and it seems to disorient hitters."

CLIMBING THE LADDER: Before transferring to Texas Tech for his senior year, Morris pitched for three years at Division 2 Colorado Mesa University, helping his team reach the DII National Championship Game in 2019 as a freshman (Mesa finished as Runner-up to Tampa that year). Morris was named the Rocky Mountain Athletic Conference Freshman of the Year for his efforts that season and was a Division 2 2nd-Team All-American in 2021 before transferring to Texas Tech as a redshirt junior.

MAD MORRIS: Morris' mound routine can involve arguing with himself or talking to himself on the mound. "I'm really just analyzing the last pitch, moving on to the next pitch and what it should be," Morris remarked. "Sometimes there are not-so-nice words involved, but real it's 'Trust it. Throw it to the mask' Other times, 'it's good left side, how can we work off of that? What's next, and then next?' There's lots of things going through my head."

LAST APPEARANCE: After putting up zeros in his first two innings following Andrew Morris and Alex Speas on Wednesday in Iowa, allowed hits to six of the next eight batters faced before being lifted in the seventh, including allowing a career-high four home runs. All four of his home runs allowed came in the span of 18 pitches (first two allowed on the four-seam FB, next on slider, next on changeup). Departed the game with the Saints trailing 8-2 in an eventual 20-6 loss. St. Paul's nine runs allowed and five homers given up in the seventh were both the most in franchise history (Anthony Prato allowed 3 runs & another HR in inning).

THE KNUCKLEBALL FRATERNITY: When he debuted on September 19 with the Saints last season, Lewis became just the third pitcher in Triple-A to throw an offering recorded as a knuckleball (not counting position players) by pitch tracking last year, joining El Paso's Matt Waldron and Lehigh Valley's Nick Nelson. Only Waldron threw the knuckleball more than 7% of the time like Lewis (it was Waldron's primary offering at 43%) & neither Waldron nor Nelson's knuckleball averaged more than 80 mph. Lewis' hard-knuckler came in at an average of 83.2 mph, with his hardest of the day clocking in at 85.8 mph. MLB's Statcast system has never in its 17 seasons of existence recorded a knuckleball in the Major Leagues faster than 84.2 mph (thrown by Padres' Matt Waldron in June 2024). In a poll of seven Twins catchers at this year's Spring Training, the group identified Lewis' knuckleball as [the filthiest pitch in camp](#). Saints catcher Patrick Winkel told the Minnesota Star Tribune's Bobby Nightengale that one of the knuckleballs Lewis threw in pregame warm-ups hit him squarely in the mask.

R.A. DICKEY ON LINE 1: One of Lewis' secondary offerings is a knuckleball that he picked up when he was 10 years old. He started throwing it at a Pony League All-Star practice and blew away coaches with it. His high school coaches allowed him to stick with it and realized in college that it was for real. Along the way, he has gotten tips from R.A. Dickey on how to throw the pitch, which will average in the mid-80s.

THE BEST WAY TO CATCH A KNUCKLEBALL? WAIT TIL IT STOPS ROLLING AND PICK IT UP : When the Twins took Lewis in the ninth round of the 2022 MLB Amateur Draft, Lewis bought an oversized catching mitt, which he passes along to anyone who catches for him. Catchers joke that it looks like a softball first base mitt, but it's absolutely necessary.

LEWIS KNOWS NO-NO's: In Lewis' final Double-A outing last season on September 12, he did not allow a hit until there were two outs in the fifth inning. However, he has been part of a no-hitter in his career. On May 14, 2023 with Fort Myers, Lewis spun 5.2 innings of perfect baseall, retiring all 17 hitters he faced, striking out seven. The Mighty Mussels went on to finish the game without allowing a hit or a walk, but lost the perfect game on a wild pitch and a dropped third strike in the eighth inning.
