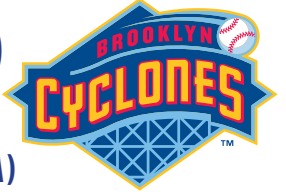

**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn fell to Hudson Valley in a rain-soaked, 10-inning contest on Thursday, 4-3...Down to their final strike and their final out in the bottom of the ninth, LF **Nick Morabito** singled, stole second, and scored on 2B **D'Andre Smith's** RBI single...The Renegades took the lead on a double play in the top of the 10th before RHP **Harrison Cohen** stranded the tying run at the third in the bottom half...The game featured two rain delays, including a 12-minute delay in the top of the fourth and a 35-minute stoppage in the top of the eighth...LHP **Felipe De La Cruz** hurled a quality start despite the weather, allowing two runs over 6.0 innings, and striking out seven...Morabito, Smith, and DH **Junior Tilién** all accumulated multi-hit games for Brooklyn...RHP **Justin Lawson** suffered the tough-luck defeat after allowing only one unearned run over 3.0 innings.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY:** On August 10, 2008, RF **Kirk Nieuwenhuis** went 2-for-4 with a triple and a walk-off RBI single in the bottom of the 10th in a 6-5 win vs. Batavia...In 2012, RHP **Hansel Robles** and three Vermont pitchers combined not to allow a base hit until the eighth inning...Robles' perfect game bid was snapped on a two-out single in the eighth, while Brooklyn tallied their first knock on a 3B **Dimas Ponce** leadoff knock in the ninth...Ponce would take second on a wild pitch and then scored on SS **Philip Evans'** walk-off RBI single in a 1-0 win vs. Vermont...In 2014, tied at two in the top of the ninth, SS **Amed Rosario** provided a go-ahead two-run double as part of a three-tally frame in a 5-2 triumph at Batavia...In 2015, RHPs **Gaby Almonte** (8.0 IP) and **Ty Williams** (1.0) combined on a three-hit shutout in a 7-0 victory at Staten Island...In 2016, RF **Gene Cone** brought in the game's winning run with a walk-off squeeze bunt in the bottom of the ninth to defeat Vermont, 5-4...In 2021, C **Francisco Alvarez** went 3-for-4 with a home run and four runs batted in during a 16-5 drubbing at Wilmington.

**LET'S PLAY TWO:** After Friday's rain out, the Cyclones will play their fourth doubleheader in 12 days on Sunday at 1 p.m. against Hudson Valley...From Opening Day until July 28, Brooklyn played just two twinbills...Brooklyn split their third-straight twinbill on Wednesday, walking off with a 3-2 win in Game 1 before dropping Game 2, 7-0...Brooklyn is 5-5 in doubleheader games this year and 1-1-3 in doubleheaders overall...In 2023, the Cyclones were 0-4-2 in doubleheaders overall and 2-10 in games.

**WENN IN BROOKLYN:** RHP **Jack Wenninger** suffered the defeat in his first start at the High-A level, but has quickly figured things out at the classification since...Over his last four appearances (three starts) since July 14 at Wilmington, the 22-year-old has no record, but a 1.72 ERA (3 ER in 15.2 IP) and one hold...Wenninger has surrendered 13 hits and nine walks while striking out 19 in that span...The Barrington, Ill. native's 1.72 ERA ranks sixth in the South Atlantic League in that time among pitchers with 15.0 or more innings of work.

**MORABITO BITE:** OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old finished with his 31st multi-hit game of the year in the second game of Sunday's doubleheader at Aberdeen and is hitting .349/.423/.413 with a .836 OPS in 17 games since the All-Star break...The McLean, Va. native is tied for seventh in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (49)...With two swipes (39) on Thursday, he broke OF **Omar De Los Santos'** single-season franchise record of 37, which was set last year...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (84), is second in stolen bases (38), fifth in batting average (.292), sixth in runs scored (49), and seventh in on-base percentage (.368)...The former second-round selection is fourth in the SAL in stolen bases (38), sixth in batting average (.292), and eighth in on-base percentage (.368) for the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.314), stolen bases (49), on-base percentage (.407), and hits (115)...He is also tied for second in runs scored (63), third in total bases (144), tied for third in triples (4), fourth in OPS (.800), and fifth in walks (50).

**THE TONG SONG:** RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit and is second among all High-A pitchers in strikeouts (93), in addition to a league-best ERA (3.36) and batting average against (.213)...The 93 strikeouts are also good for eighth in the circuit overall...He is also third in the SAL in WHIP (1.28) and tied for seventh in innings pitched (69.1)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 80.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is first in FIP (2.16), third in strikeout rate (35.2%), fifth in strikeouts (129), and seventh in strikeout-to-walk rate (24.9%).

**OMAR-I-GONE:** OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old powered a walk-off solo home run in the bottom of the ninth vs. Rome on July 28 and has homered in six of his last

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones return to Coney Island for their final six-game series of 2024 against the Yankees' High-A affiliate...The Renegades have six of New York-AL's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: INF **George Lombard Jr.** (6), LHP **Kyle Carr** (11), INF **Roc Riggio** (17), RHP **Cade Smith** (20), OF **Anthony Hall** (27), and OF **Jace Avina** (29)...Brooklyn and Hudson Valley split a home-and-home series (July 1-6) after the Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Hudson Valley on Coney Island (May 23-28)...Hudson Valley won 4-of-6 in Wappingers Falls (June 11-16)...On the year, the series is tied 9-9...Dating back to 2001, Brooklyn trails the all-time series, 150-155 (.492)

17 games since July 13 at Wilmington...Five of those six home runs have tied the game or provided Brooklyn the lead...Since the All-Star break, Omar is second in the league in slugging (.600), tied for second in triples (2) and home runs (5), sixth in total bases (33), tied for sixth in extra-base hits (8), and tied for eighth in runs scored (12)...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fifth in the South Atlantic League for the year with 34 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (71) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos is tied for first in the South Atlantic League (71) and tied for fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (143).

**LONG ARM OF THE LAW:** RHP **Justin Lawson** tossed a career-high 4.0 innings to earn his second win in Game 2 of last Sunday's doubleheader at Aberdeen...The 23-year-old allowed just two hits and one walk, striking out four...Lawson has not allowed an earned run in his last 13.0 innings dating back to July 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Since June 15 at Hudson Valley, the Winfield, La. native has composed a 2-2 record and a pristine 0.70 ERA (2 ER in 25.2 IP), earning two saves...No South Atlantic League reliever with 20.0 or more innings pitched since June 15 has a lower ERA than Lawson (0.70).

**TAKING KELLUM 123:** OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old has seven multi-hit efforts in his last 22 games...Since July 6, he has been hitting .316/.381/.355 with a .736 OPS, eight runs scored, three doubles, three runs batted in, and three stolen bases over the 22 games...Clark is seventh in the South Atlantic League in batting average (.316) and 10th in on-base percentage (.381) since that date.

**IT'S A WALK-OFF:** For the fourth time in 10 home games, Brooklyn earned a walk-off victory thanks to 3B **Jacob Reimer's** two-run single in the bottom of the seventh in Game 1 of Wednesday's double-dip with Hudson Valley...In the Cyclones' previous home game, on July 28 vs. Rome, 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** blasted a game-tying two-run home run in the ninth before LF **Omar De Los Santos** followed with a walk-off solo shot in a 7-6 triumph...The back-to-back jacks marked just the second time Brooklyn had accomplished the feat in 2024...SS **William Lugo** and CF **Stanley Consuegra** clubbed consecutive home runs in the sixth inning on May 18 at Bowling Green...It was also Brooklyn's second walk-off home run of the season...3B **Nick Lorusso** smacked a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...The Cyclones also earned walk-off wins in the last 10 home affairs on July 19, via C **Chris Suero's** game-winning bases-loaded RBI single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Jersey Shore and, again, on July 24, courtesy of SS **Wilfredo Lara's** walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th vs. Rome...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 18 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.88% of all defeats, including 26.47% of all road losses, while earning 12 walk-off wins...30 of Brooklyn's 236 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.71%)...The Cyclones have also earned 23 wins in their last at-bat.

**SHUT IT:** Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are three behind Rome (14) for the most in the South Atlantic League...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), INF **Jacob Reimer** (22), RHP **Jack Wenninger** (27), and RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season IL...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Reimer (14), Tong (18), Báez (20), Ziegler (21), OF **Nick Morabito** (23), and Wenninger (28).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Did not receive a decision pitching out of the bullpen last Saturday in the restart of Friday's suspended game at Aberdeen...Entered when the game resumed in the bottom of the fourth inning and Brooklyn trailing 1-0...Surrendered two runs on four hits in 3.0 innings...Did not issue a walk and struck out four...Induced a double play...Threw 35 pitches and 28 strikes (80.00%)... Relieved by RHP **Henry Henry** to start the bottom of the seventh and the game tied at three...Aberdeen regained the lead, 4-3, in that frame, but Brooklyn rallied to load the bases with two outs in the top of the eighth...However, after a 21-minute delay, the game was called due to weather and the IronBirds were awarded a 4-3 victory.

**THE COMEBACK REPORT:** Thornton spent a little over a month on Single-A St. Lucie's 7-day injured list...The 22-year-old was placed on the IL on June 4 and was reinstated on July 14...In four appearances (one start) since returning between the two A-ball levels, Thornton is 1-0 with an 7.36 ERA (6 ER in 7.1 IP), one walk, and 10 strikeouts.

**WHAT'S IN A ROLE:** The Lawrence, Kan. native has seen varied results between his appearances as a starter and a reliever in 2024...In six starts at Single-A St. Lucie, Thornton held a 2-0 record with a 3.42 ERA (9 ER in 23.2 IP), seven walks, and 20 strikeouts...Over eight outings in relief between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 5.75 ERA (13 ER in 20.1 IP), one save, nine walks, and 16 strikeouts.

**DOMINANT IN THE DESERT:** Thornton enjoyed plenty of success during his lone season in the desert at Grand Canyon University in Phoenix, Ariz...The fifth-round selection earned All-WAC Second Team honors in 2023 after accumulating a 9-2 record with a 3.87 ERA (38 ER in 88.1 IP), 18 walks, and 91 strikeouts in 15 starts for the Antelopes... Thornton finished the 2023 season at GCU as the team's leader in ERA (3.87), wins (9), innings pitched (88.1), and strikeouts (91)...The left-hander started his collegiate career with two years (2021-22) at Barton Community College (Great Bend, Kan.).

**FAMILY BUSINESS:** Zach is far from the only athlete in the Thornton family...His father, **Paul**, ran track at St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.) from 1989-93 and was a conference champion in the 1000m in 1993...However, the best athlete in the family may be his mother, **Julie**...From 1988-92, she participated in track and field, cross country, and soccer at Lewis & Clark College (Portland, Ore.) and St. Olaf College...Julie was a two-time All-American in the heptathlon (1991-92) and was later inducted in to the St. Olaf College athletics Hall of Fame.
