**Today's Game:** The Nashville Sounds face the Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp in game two of the six-game series. The Jumbo Shrimp took game one 3-2 last night. Left-hander Robert Gasser gets the start for the Sounds, facing Jacksonville's Sean Nolin.

**Robert Gasser:** 23-year-old Robert Gasser makes his third start of the season today. The Houston, Texas resident last pitched April 12 vs. Norfolk. He went 5.1 innings, striking out seven while allowing two hits and two runs (both earned) in a no decision. He is touted as the No. 9 prospect in the Brewers system by MLB Pipeline. Gasser was traded to the Brewers organization from San Diego as part of the Josh Hader trade on August 1, 2022. He was originally drafted by San Diego in the second round of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Houston.

**Sean Nolin:** 33-year-old Sean Nolin makes his first start in the Marlins organization today. He spent the 2022 season with the Kia Tigers of the Korea Baseball Organization, going 8-8 with a 2.47 ERA (124.0 IP/34 ER) and tallying 108 strikeouts. Minnesota signed Nolin as a minor league free agent before he was traded to Miami on April 9. Nolin has pitched in the Majors with Toronto (2013-14), Oakland (2015) and Washington (2021). He made 14 appearances and 12 starts with the Sounds back in 2015, going 2-2 with a 2.66 ERA (47.1 IP/14 ER). His last domestic appearance came on October 1, 2021 with the Nationals vs. Boston (1.0 IP, 0 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 0 K).

**2023 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the International League West Division standings in 2023: First: 1, Second: 6, Third: 2, Fourth: 2, Fifth: 3, Sixth: 2, Seventh: 0, Eighth: 0, Ninth: 0, Tenth: 0.

**On the Mend:** Brewers rehabbing starter Adrian Houser made his second appearance with the Sounds on his MLB rehab stint last night. The right-hander struck out five over 3.0 innings while allowing a couple of home runs in the second. Overall, Houser has a 3.60 ERA through 5.0 innings with Nashville since joining the team on rehab last Thursday.

**Back to His Old Ways:** Sounds outfielder Sal Frelick notched his second 3-hit performance in last night's loss, his second of the season. It was also his first two double game as a Sound with his last multi-double game coming on July 23, 2022 with Double-A Biloxi against Pensacola.

**Strong Arm Barn:** The Sounds bullpen continues to hold true as one of the best in Triple-A. Nashville relievers boast a 3.31 ERA (89.2 IP/33 ER) through 16 games, the second-best in the league, trailing Memphis' 2.40 mark. The 'pen also ranks second in strikeouts (103) and WHIP (1.23).

**Toro on a Tear:** Abraham Toro pushed his on-base streak to 11 games last night with a double. It is one of 19 active on-base streaks of 11 or more games in the IL. He is also tied with Jon Singleton's 11-game on-base streak as the longest team on-base streaks.

**Made For Walking:** Jon Singleton extended his on-base streak to 11 games with a pair of walks last night. After walking only once through his first 10 games, Singleton has earned five free passes over the past four games. He set a Sounds single season record and led the league with 117 walks in 2022.

**Our Hiura:** Keston Hiura crushed his sixth home run of the season and fourth of the homestand with a solo homer in the ninth inning of Sunday's contest. Hiura ranks among league leaders (T-2nd) in the big fly department.

**Erceg's Excellence:** Reliever Lucas Erceg's no-hit streak ended at 7.2 innings on Friday, but the lefty still has not allowed a run in 9.2 innings of work this season, the longest in Minor League Baseball. Erceg is 2-0 and has fanned 11 of 32 hitters faced (34.3%).

**The Future Brew Crew:** Nashville opens the 2023 season with five players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 9 prospect, left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 13 prospect, right-handed pitcher Janson Junk is the No. 15 prospect and right-handed pitcher Cam Robinson is the No. 24 prospect.

**How Sweet It Is:** Sounds manager Rick Sweet begins his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 608-526 record during an eight-season span.

**LAST OUTING:** Gasser's previous start was on April 12 vs. Norfolk at First Horizon Park. The young lefty tossed 5.1 innings, allowing two runs (both earned) on two hits, walking three and striking out seven. He also hit two batters and threw two wild pitches. Gasser departed as the pitcher of record, but Nashville came back to win and give Gasser a no-decision.

**AGAINST OPPONENT:** Gasser's sole career appearance against Jacksonville came on September 16, 2022 at First Horizon Park. He allowed just two runs (1 ER) on three hits over 5.0 innings, walking and striking out four. But Nashville was shut out 4-0, saddling Gasser with the loss.

### 2023 SEASON HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is on Nashville's Opening Day roster for the first time in his career.
- Did not allow a run in 4.0+ innings in first start of season against Memphis.
- Was first Nashville starter to pitch into the sixth in a start this season with 5.1 frames on April 12.
