**LAST NIGHT:** The Amarillo Sod Poodles (1-7) fell to the Northwest Arkansas Naturals (6-2), 5-4, Saturday night at Arvest Ballpark. Many hitters from both sides were set down on strikes early in the ballgame. The Naturals scored first in the third, using a leadoff walk, an infield single, and a pair of stolen bases to set the table for Omar Hernandez who collected a two-run single. The Soddies answered in the fourth after **Manuel Pena** hit his third home run of the year, a two-run shot to right-center to tie the game at two. Responding quickly were the Naturals in the bottom of the fourth using a Jack Pineda RBI single to put the home squad back in front by a run. **Danny Serretti's** two-run blast to left in the sixth gave Amarillo their first lead of the night, 4-3. The Naturals once again equalized in the home half, scratching a run on a passed ball. Strong bullpen efforts from both sides kept the game tied until the bottom of the ninth when Dustin Dickerson clutched up with a bases-loaded single to give the Naturals the 5-4 walk-off win.

**YES SERRETTI:** Reaching base three times and slugging his second dinger of the year last night was **Danny Serretti**...it is the first time a Sod Poodle has hit a home run and drawn at least two walks since August 27, 2025 (Conticello) in a game against the Naturals at HODGETOWN, a feat accomplished only six times last season.

**AFTERNOON DELIGHT:** The Sod Poodles are 4-4 all-time against the Naturals in day games...seven of those eight total day games have been played at Arvest Ballpark (4-3).

**SIT 'EM DOWN:** Amarillo starters have struck out 18 Naturals over the past three games in just 9.1 innings of work combined...the 17.36 K/9 rate by starters leads Texas League rotations over that span.
