Major Responsibilities:

- Day-to-day cleaning of the interior and exterior of the facility
- Sweeping, mopping, dusting, vacuuming, and window cleaning
- Clean restrooms including, but not limited to, removal of trash, restock paper products, cleaning urinals, sinks, and toilets
- Must be willing to operate various types of cleaning equipment, including vacuums, floor scrubbers/sweepers, and any other tools, as related to the position
- Visually assess all areas of the ballpark for hazards (trash, standing water, items out of place, unlocked doors, etc.) and report to Director of Operations
- Be aware of, and enforce, appropriate stadium rules
- Remain at post throughout the event, unless taking an assigned break
- Perform other duties as assigned

Qualifications:

- Ability to listen and follow instructions
- Good problem solving skills and organizational ability
- Ability to work independently and as a member of the team
- Ability to work flexible hours including daytime, evening, weekends, and holidays, as needed
- Must be able to speak, read, and write English
- Must have professional attitude and appearance
- Superior customer service skills
