YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels shut out the Sea Dogs, 6-0. Ryan Murphy started and pitched four scoreless innings. Wil Jensen and Spencer Bivens each covered two scoreless innings and Jose Cruz ended the game with a 1-2-3 ninth, striking out two. Richmond opened the scoring in the third with an RBI single by Shane Matheny and Ismael Munguia scored later in the inning. In the fifth, Munguia and Matheny each hit RBI singles and Carter Aldrete added a two-run single to extend the lead to 6-0.

TDDAY'S GAME: The Richmond Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Portland Sea Dogs, Double-A affiliate of the Boston Red Sox. This series is the first match-up between the two teams this season. The Flying Squirrels will travel to Portland for a six-game series from August 22-27. Last year, the two teams split a six-game series at The Diamond, with Richmond's series finale win clinching the Southwest Division First-Half title. The Sea Dogs won five-of-six against the Flying Squirrels at Hadlock Field last year.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have gone 19-10 in their last 19 games since June 18 but have dropped eight-of-their-last-13. On the last road trip, they went 1-2 in a series at Harrisburg and split a six-game set in Akron. In their last 29 games, the Flying Squirrels are batting .243 (225-for-925), the best in the Eastern League, with 30 homers, 43 doubles and have score 143 runs. In that same span, the Richmond pitching staff has combined for a 3.38 ERA, fourth-best in the league, with 312 strikeouts. Over the last 34 games since June 14, Richmond starting pitchers have combined for a 3.00 ERA (42 ER/126.0 IP) and have allowed nine home runs. For the year, the Flying Squirrels' 3.76 ERA, second-best in the league. Richmond starters have thrown 327.1 innings, which is the fewest in Double-A. Richmond relievers have thrown 453.2 innings this year, the most in Double-A. The Flying Squirrels bullpen has a 3.37 ERA, which is the lowest in Double-A, just ahead of Akron (3.41), and the fourth-lowest of the 120 full-season teams in the minors

THE SEA DDGS have the best overall record in the Eastern League this season and are leading the second-half standings in the Northeast Division. The Sea Dogs are 12-6 in their last 18 games since July 2, including taking four-of-six in last week's series against the Fisher Cats, closing it with a no-hitter on Sunday. Portland's roster includes six of Baseball America's top-30 Red Sox prospects, including SS Marcelo Mayer (No. 1), 2B Nick Yorke (No. 4), RHP Wikelman Gonzalez (No. 7), C Nathan Hickey (No. 10), 2B Chase Meidroth (No. 11) and 1B Blaze Jordan (No. 20). MLB.com's top-30 Red Sox prospects list includes Mayer (No. 1), Yorke (No. 3), Jordan (No. 10), Gonzalez (No. 11), INF Matthew Lugo (No. 13), Hickey (No. 15), Meidroth (No. 19), RHP Jacob Webb (No. 24) and OF Phillip Sikes (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Carson Seymour takes the mound for his 15th Double-A start. He last pitched on Thursday in Akron and allowed two runs over 4.2 innings, picking up a win because the game was shortened to five innings due to rain. In his last two starts, Seymour has been awarded his first two Double-A wins. On the season, Seymour is ranked sixth in the Eastern League in ERA (3.91), second in BAA (.227) and fifth in WHIP (1.24). A native of Poway, Calif., Seymour was selected by the New York Mets in the sixth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University. After making four appearances in 2021, he began the 2022 season with Low-A 5t. Lucie, where he went 4-0 with a 1.19 ERA in seven outings (four starts). He was promoted to High-A Brooklyn on May 23 for 11 outings before being traded to the Giants on August 2 as part of the deal that sent Darin Ruf to the Mets. Seymour closed the year with High-A Eugene, going 2-3 with a 3.99 ERA in six starts. Seymour is rated by Baseball America as the No. 14 Giants prospect and No. 16 by MLB.com. FOR PORTLAND: Right-hander Sterling Sharp makes his 13th start of the season. Last time out, he picked a loss after allowing a season-high-tying seven runs over three innings on Thursday against New Hampshire. In his last three starts since July 5, Sharp has gone 0-3 with a 12.83 ERA (19 ER/13.1 IP), elevating his season ERA from 3.63 to 5.74. Sharp was selected in the 22nd round of the 2016 MLB Draft by the Washington Nationals. He first reached Double-A in 2018 with Harrisburg and pitched parts of three seasons with the Senators. Sharp was selected in the 2019 Rule 5 Draft by the Miami Marlins and made his MLB debut in 2020. He was returned to the Nationals in August 2020. Sharp signed with the Red Sox as a free agent last August and made his Boston organization debut at Hadlock Field against Richmond on August 13, allowing two runs in five innings. In four career starts against the Flying Squirrels dating back to 2018, Sharp is 1-2 with a 5.85 ERA (13 ER/20.0 IP).

PACKING THE HOUSE: The Flying Squirrels are leading the Double-A level in total attendance (282,366) and average attendance (6,417) this year. They are also 13th in the minors in average attendance. Last year, Richmond led all 30 Double-A teams in total attendance (406,560) and average attendance (6,160) for the first time in franchise history.

GLOW SHOW: Over his last 11 games since July 6, **Jimmy Glowenke** is batting .333 (12-for-36) with two homers, three doubles, 10 RBIs and five walks. In last week's series in Akron, he hit .450 (9-for-20) with two homers, three doubles and 10 RBIs. Last Tuesday, he closed the game a triple shy of the cycle and went 3-for-6 with a three-run homer, a two-run double and an RBI single, picking up a career-high six RBIs. On Friday, he drove in two runs, going 1-for-3 with a double. On Saturday night, Glowenke clubbed a two-run homer in the top of the 11th in a 6-5 win. He worked a walk in this week's series-opener on Tuesday.

ALL ABDARD THE SHANE TRAIN: Shane Matheny saw his league-leading 22-game on-base streak end last Wednesday when he was retired in a pinch-hitting appearance. It was tied for the longest active streak in Double-A and was the eighth-longest on-base streak in the Eastern League this season. During the streak, Matheny hit .247 (19-for-77) with six doubles, three homers and 12 RBIs, adding 12 walks with a .352 on-base percentage. For his Flying Squirrels career, Matheny has worked 108 walks, moving ahead of Jarrett Parker (2013-14) for third-most in franchise history, He trails Ricky Oropesa (2013-16) with 112 and Jacob Heyward (2019, '21-22) with 158. His .354 career on-base percentage is third-highest in Flying Squirrels franchise history (min. 700 PA). On Tuesday to open the series, Matheny went 2-for-4 with a pair of RBI singles.

RETURN OF THE MECK: Wade Meckler has picked up multiple hits 10 times in his 34 Double-A games. He went on a 24-game on-base streak from May 17-July 6, which was the longest on-base streak to begin a Double-A career in Flying Squirrels history, passing the previous record set by **Luis Matos** (17 games) earlier this season. It was also tied for the ninth-longest on-base streak in franchise history. Meckler also had an 11-game run scored streak from June 23-July 6, which was a Flying Squirrels franchise record, passing the previous mark of nine straight games by Tyler LaTorre in 2014. In Game 1 of a doubleheader on June 23, Meckler tied the single-game franchise record for hits, going 5-for-5 and capping the night with a two-run, walk-off single for a 9-8 win over the Senators. For the season, Meckler leads all MiLB hitters (min. 220 PA) in batting average (.383), sixth in OBP (.453) and is eighth in wRC+ (168). He ranks second in the Eastern League (min. 150 PA) in batting average (.341), third in OBP (.429) and is third in BABIP (.402) while posting the fifth-lowest strikeout percentage (14.5) and the second-lowest swing-and-miss percentage (5.2).

MARTY PARTY: Brandon Martorano has reached base 11 times in his last six games with an at-bat since July 14. He reached base five times on July 14 at Harrisburg, picking up three hits with a walk and was hit by a pitch. In his last 11 games since July 3, Martorano is batting .267 (8-or-30) with six walks, two RBIs and four runs scored. Martorano missed 39 games on the injured list from April 21-June 8. On Thursday, he came through with a game-tying sac fly in the fifth in the win.

TAKE A WALK: Hayden Cantrelle has walked 55 times this season, which is tied for the most in the Giants organization and tied for the fifth-most in the Eastern League. His 18.2% walk rate is tied for the second-highest in the league this season. He is also tied for the fifth-best on-base percentage (.389) in the league this year. His 55 walks this season are the eighth-most in a single year in Flying Squirrels franchise history, two shy of Javier Herrera (57 - 2013). The single-season record of 80 was set by Jacob Heyward in 2019. Cantrelle is on pace for 83 walks this season.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have eight players ranked in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects, including LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 6), OF Vaun Brown (No. 8), RHP Mason Black (No. 9), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 14), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 15), OF Wade Meckler (No. 16), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 27) and RHP José Cruz (No. 30). Brown is rated by Baseball America as the best hitter for average and the best athlete, Meckler as having the best strike-zone discipline, Roupp as having the best curveball and Cruz as having the best change-up. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospect list includes eight Richmond players, including Whisenhunt (No. 4), Brown (No. 6), Black (No. 9), Roupp (No. 12), Seymour (No. 16), Murphy (No. 25), Cruz (No. 28) and Meckler (No. 29).

THIS DATE IN SQUIRRELS HISTORY

In 2012, the Flying Squirrels beat the Erie SeaWolves, 7-6, in 15 innings at Jerry Uht Park. Richmond opened a 5-0 lead in first two innings, including a three-run homer by Tommy Joseph and a solo run homer by Luke Anders. After holding a 6-1 lead, the Sea-Wolves scored five unanswered runs from the fifth through eighth innings to tie the score. In the top of the 15th, Juan Perez hit a go-ahead single to give Richmond a 7-6 lead. Chris Wilson pitched three scoreless innings
