WORKING THROUGH THE WEEKEND: Through the first five games of this week's series against the Daytona Tortugas, the Bradenton Marauders pitching staff has struck out 60 batters in 50.0 innings of work while sporting a 3.24 ERA. It's the third-best ERA in the FSL this week while the strikeouts are the second-most. Bradenton has also walked just 18 batters as a pitching staff, which is tied for the fewest in the FSL after they walked 43 in 47.1 innings last week in Lakeland (the most in FSL).

BUT HE GET'S ON BASE: Marauders **UTIL Jesus Castillo** has reached base safely in each of the first 14 games of the season. His streak is currently the longest active streak in all of Single-A. Dating back to last season, Castillo has reached base in 23 straight games. Lonnie White Jr. held the largest on-base streak for a Marauder last year, reaching base safely in 29 consecutive games.

 $\label{lem:way:bessel} \textbf{WALK THIS WAY: Jesus Castillo} \ 's \ walk \ streak \ came\ to\ end\ at\ 11\ games\ last\ Wednesday\ night\ in\ Lakeland.\ \textbf{Castillo} \ was\ one of just\ eight\ players\ in\ Minor\ League\ baseball\ last\ season\ to\ work\ 100\ or\ more\ walks.\ The\ Marauders\ infielder\ is\ t-1st\ in\ the\ FSL\ with\ 20\ walks\ while\ also\ sitting\ t-1st\ in\ all\ of\ Minor\ League\ Baseball\ with\ George\ Lombard\ Jr\ (TAM).\ The\ 20\ -year-old\ is\ also\ t-3rd\ in\ the\ FSL\ with\ eight\ stolen\ bases.$

OH WHAT A NIGHT: On Saturday night, **LHP Michael Kennedy** became the first Marauders pitcher to qualify for a win after tossing five innings. The five innings and eight strikeouts tied a career-high for the Pittsburgh Pirates' No. 15 prospect.

GOT EM!: Michael Kennedy picked off Dominic Pitelli at first base on Saturday night for the Marauders sixth pickoff of the season. As of Sunday morning, the Marauders currently sit tied for second in all of MilB, only trailing the Fredericksburg National (Single-A, WAS) and Lehigh Valley IronPigs (Triple-A, PHI) who both own seven. Bradenton had 23 last season, which ranked the second-most in the FSL and 11th-most in MilB.

DEALING: LHP Yoldin De La Paz has been the rock out of the bullpen so far for the Marauders in 2024. The southpaw has punched out 11 in 7.2 innings after starting the sesaon on a 6.2 innings scoreless streak. Dating back to last season, De La Paz had tossed seven straight scoreless outings which covered 12.1 frames. He last allowed a run on Aug. 17, 2023 against Lakeland

WELCOME BACK TO BRADENTON SKIP: Manager Jim Horner is set to begin his first season as the new skipper for the Marauders in 2024. Horner was the FCL Pirates manager last season and returns to Bradenton after serving as the Bench Coach on the 2021 Low-A Southeast Championship team. The Twins Falls, Idaho native joined the Pirates organization before the 2020 season after managing in the Seattle Mariners organization from 2005-2010, 2013-2015. A former Washington State catcher, Horner played nine seasons in the Minor Leagues and reached Triple-A Tacoma before retiring.
