Blake on the Bump... Blake Morgan is set to make his second High-A start on Sunday. The lefty started Tuesday's game, going 5.0 innings, allowing two runs on five hits, walking one while striking out five. Before his promotion on Tuesday, Morgan was 4-2 with a 3.47 ERA over 11 starts with the Single-A Charleston RiverDogs. Across three levels this season, the southpaw has struck out 88 batters while walking just 19 over 88.2 innings pitched.

Battle for the Bases... Bowling Green and Frederick represent two of the three top base stealing teams in the SAL. The Keys lead the league, stealing 279 bases. The Hot Rods have swiped 255 bases this year, landing in second place. Bowling Green is also the home to the best base stealer in the SAL, Tony Santa Maria, who leads the league with 45 steals this season.

Myers Makes it Happen... The month of August has been kind to Noah Myers. Over the first 10 games, he is 13-for-35 (.371) with five doubles, one homer, and six RBI. After a slow start to his 2026 Hot Rods tenure, Myers raised his batting average from .182 on July 22 to .276 entering Sunday's game. Myers has made an impact in the series against the Keys, recording an extra-innings RBI double in Wednesday and Thursday's matchups.

Nearing the End... With Sunday being the finale between Frederick and Bowling Green, there are just three remaining regular-season series left this year. The Hot Rods will travel home and take on the Greensboro Grasshoppers next week. The final regular-season road trip for Bowling Green will be in Winston-Salem against the Dash. The Hot Rods will wrap up the year with a home series against the Greenville Drive before heading into the 2026 SAL playoffs.
