SERIES HISTORY (529 GAMES)

Omaha and Nashville played each other regularly from 1985-1997 (American Association) and 1998-2019 (Pacific Coast League).

In the modern PCL (2005-2019), the teams had 16 games scheduled against each other each season, typically 8 in Omaha and 8 in Nashville.

With a move to the International League for both teams, they did not play each other in 2021and again were not scheduled for games in 2022, despite playing in the same division.

The last series Omaha and Nashville played was August 26-29 at Werner Park, with Omaha taking the first two games and Nashville winning the last two

seventh inning, the Omaha Storm Chasers fell to the Nashville Sounds, 8-3 in Tuesday's series opener at First Horizon Park.

Heasley struggled to open the game, allowing three runs in the first inning, but settled down and found himself in a groove, retiring 12 of 13 batters between the first and fourth innings.

While the Storm Chasers hitters were held quiet in the first four innings, the club sprung to life in the fifth, as Logan Porter opened the inning with a single, Dairon Blanco walked and Angelo Castellano doubled in Porter to put Omaha on the board ... Samad Taylor grounded out to plate Blanco, then Maikel Garcia drove home Castellano to tie the game at 3-3 but was thrown out at second straight to stretch his hit into a double.

Those three runs were Omaha's only ones of the game, as Nashville scoured five.

Heasley allowed a pair of runs on three hits in the bottom of the fifth, then was tagged for one more in the sixth and one in the seventh before being lifted, in favor of **Brooks Kriske**.

Kriske allowed a two-run homer that scored a runner inherited from Healsey, then Ryan Weiss pitched a scoreless eighth, but Omaha's offense went relatively quiet after the brief outburst, falling by five runs.

Nashville pitching faced one over the minimum over the last four innings, as Omaha managed one hit and two walks, but hit into two double plays.

Porter finished the day 2-for-5, accounting for two of Omaha's five hits.

NOTES AND NUGGETS

ROLLING IN THE DEEP

The last 7 games have been Omaha's starting pitchers throw at least 5.0 innings in every game, after just two starts of 5.0 IP or more in the first 13 games.

Last week, Omaha starters have combined to allow 13 earned runs in 33.0 innings (3.55 ERA), including quality starts from **Mike Mayers** and **Jonathan Heasley**. Even when they go deep into games, receiving run support has been a challenge for Omaha starters, who are averaging just 2.35 runs of support per game ... when receiving at least 3 runs of support, Omaha starters are 6-2, compared to 2-10 when getting less than 2 runs of support ... the team is 8-1 when recording at least 10 hits, but 0-11 when getting 10 hits or less.

3 of Heasley's 5 starts have been 6.0 innings or longer, including a pair of quality starts: 4/7 vs. Toledo and 4/19 vs. Gwinnett ... he's pitched into the 7th inning his last two starts, something he only did three times last year with Kansas City.

PUSHIN P(ORTER)

Catcher **Logan Porter** is once again flying under the radar, as one of the most productive hitters in the International League season.

While he falls short of qualifying for the average categories, among International League hitters with at least 50 plate appearances, Porter ranks <u>2nd</u> in slugging percentage (.739) and 7th in OPS (1.135).

His five home runs lead the Storm Chasers and 34 total bases are the 2nd-most

SAMAD (TAYLOR'S VERSION)

Samad Taylor led off the first 18 games of the season for Omaha and 19 of the team's 20 games ... he has gone 25-for-80 at the plate, with 8 extra-base hits and 16 runs batted in.

He has collected multiple hits in 8 different games this season, including each of the first 4, with hits in 15 of the 18 games he's played ... he's reached base in 17 of 18, including each of the last 12 games, Omaha's longest on-base streak this year. His 25 hits rank <u>ited 7th</u> in the International League, and his 8 steals are <u>tied 6th</u> as well, <u>tied 7th</u> in Triple-A as well.

SOMETHING'S BREWING

Brewer Hicklen was activated from the 7-Day Injured List yesterday, after opening the season on Omaha's IL (right elbow strain).

Hicklen was named the Royals Triple-A Player of the Year last year for Omaha and set career-highs in doubles (30), home runs (28), runs batted in (85) and runs scored (85)... he finished just two homers shy of a 30/30/30 season (HR/SB/2B).

Hicklen made his season debut yesterday, coming off the bench to play center field, he went 0-for-1 with a strikeout.

FREDDY FERMIN'S BUSINESS

Added to Kansas City's 40-man roster in November, catcher **Freddy Fermin** was recalled by the Royals on Friday (April 21) and started Sunday for Kansas City.

In the Royals' 4-3 loss to the Angels Sunday, Fermin recorded his first MLB hit in the 3rd inning off lefty *Reid Detmers* a 103.3 MPH single to left field.

Fermin's average exit velocity of 92.7 MPH still leads Omaha hitters this season, with a team-best 10 balls put in play 100 MPH or harder.

MANAGER: Mike Jirschele • #23

- Mike Jirschele returns for his 15th season as Omaha's manager, his 18th season managing in Minor League Baseball and 32nd season overall with the Royals organization, named to the position of Storm Chasers manager on January 13, 2023, after previously managing Triple-A Omaha from 1995-97 and 2003-13.
- Jirschele served on the Kansas City Royals coaching staff as the Third Base Coach from 2014-19 and won the World Series in 2015. Jirschele most recently served as the bench coach under manager Chris Widger during the 2022 season with the Double-A Northwest Arkansas Naturals. He spent the 2021 season as Widger's bench coach for the High-A Central champion Quad Cities River Bandits and served as Special Assistant to the General Manager in 2020.
- In his second stint as Omaha's manager, over 11 years from 2003 to 2013, he led the team to four division titles, three consecutive trips to the Pacific Coast League Championship Series (2011-2013), two PCL titles (2011, 2013) and the team's first of two Triple-A National Championships in 2013.
- He earned the 2011 Mike Coolbaugh Award for outstanding baseball work ethic, knowledge of the game and skill in mentoring young players on the field and he is a four-time recipient of the Dick Howser Award (1992, 1994, 2005, 2011), recognizing outstanding work in player development within the Royals organization.
- Prior to his time with Omaha and Kansas City, he served as the Royals Minor League Infield Coordinator for four years, from 1998-2002, and he held managerial positions with Wilmington (1994), Rockford (1993) and the Gulf Coast Royals (1992).
- From He appeared 999 games in the Minor Leagues across 13 years, between 1977 and 1990, including 22 games with the Omaha Royals between 1988 and 1989.


