RIDERS CLINCH PLAYOFFS ON SUNDAY, WIN SEVENTH IN A ROW:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped the series opener to the Midland RockHounds 2-1 on Tuesday night from Momentum Bank Ballpark. Frisco (43-21) had their seven-game winning streak snapped with the loss, but already has their first-half playoff spot locked up, having clinched on Sunday. The Riders found the scoreboard first in the second inning when **Maximo Acosta** lased an RBI single to right, scoring **Alex De Goti** against Midland (36-28) starter Blake Beers (4-5). That score held until the fifth when Jack Winkler crushed a two-run home run against **Josh Stephan** (2-4), giving Midland a 2-1 lead. Stephan allowed just the two runs over his five innings, striking out four and walking one. **Reid Birlingmair**, two innings, and **Seth Clark**, one inning, then finished off the game for Frisco without surrendering a run. Frisco's bullpen has gone 11.0-straight innings without allowing a run over their last three games. On the offensive side, the Riders were paced by a two-hit day from **Josh Hatcher**.

WE'RE GOING DANCING:

After a Midland loss on Sunday, the RoughRiders clinched the first-half Texas League South Division title for the first time since 2014. They have the best record in all of Double-A at 43-21 and they have a season-best 7.0-game lead on the Midland RockHounds in the Texas League South. The RoughRiders are in the playoffs for the first time since winning the Texas League title in 2022. Frisco has not finished the first half with the best record in Double-A since 2008. Triple-A Omaha (Royals, .706) are the only team with a better winning percentage in all of Minor League Baseball than Frisco's .672. The Riders are on pace for 93 wins, which would break their franchise record of 85 (2007).

MORE THAN O-KAY(ber):

Keyber Rodriguez has been tearing up the baseball over the last couple of weeks. On top of his walk-off single on Saturday night, in his last 24 games, Rodriguez is hitting .326 (29-for-89) with nine multi-hit games during that span, including five doubles, two triples, two home runs, 21 RBIs, seven walks, 11 runs scored and two steals. The infielder raised his batting average from .087 to .277 and OPS from .371 to .769 over the last 24 games.

THE HATCHER HAMMER:

Josh Hatcher has crushed the baseball this season for the RoughRiders. He is third in the league, hitting .301, while also tied for second in the league with 40 RBIs. Over his last 18 games, he is slashing .286 (20-for-70)/.324/.457/.781 with four doubles, a triple, two home runs, 14 RBIs and eight runs. In his last seven games, he has driven in eight runs with four extra-base hits.

FIRING BLANKS:

In their last 11 games, the Riders have allowed just 14 earned runs over 98.0 IP (1.29 ERA). Frisco has the best ERA in all of Minor League Baseball during the month of June, at 2.18 through the first 15 games. Having won 18 of their last 22 games since May 25th, the Riders have the best ERA in Minor League Baseball (2.07) during that stretch while also being tied for first in saves (eight) and wins (18) since May 25th. In those last 22 games, the Riders have allowed more than three runs in a game just four times and once in the last 10 games. On Tuesday, their 2-1 loss marked their first loss when allowing three runs or fewer, dropping them to 36-1 in those games.

HICKS IS THE PICK:

Liam Hicks has been on fire at the plate for the Riders over his last 29 games, batting .343 (34-for-99)/.451/.485/.936 with five doubles, three home runs, 16 RBIs, 16 walks, 11 strikeouts and 20 runs. In his last 17 games, he is hitting .355 (22-for-62)/.459/.565/1.024. Last Friday in Corpus Christi, Hicks collected two home runs for his first multi-home run game of his Minor League career.

CHAVEZ RACKING UP THE HITS:

In his first two seasons with the RoughRiders combined, **Frainyer Chavez** just played 44 games with Frisco, but having played his 53rd game of the season with the Riders on Sunday, he is on fire at the plate. Over his last 14 games, he is hitting .360 (18-for-50)/.418/.500/.918 with two doubles, a triple, a home run, five walks, five steals and 12 runs scored. In his last 27 games, he is slashing .308 (28-for-91)/.376/.440/.816.

RISP-ECT THIS:

The RoughRiders have been great with runners in scoring position this season, but have struggled recently. Over their last 29 games, they are 20-9, but are hitting .248 (59-for-238) with runners in scoring position. On the season, they are still second in the Texas League, batting .276 with RISP.

ABOUT RYAN

-Went to La Salle High School in Pasadena, California. There, his senior year, he owned a 1.16 ERA while striking out 48 in 42.1 innings, but played primarily infield.

-Went to UCLA camp as an infielder and asked one of the coaches if he could pitch the last inning of one of the games. He ended up throwing well enough that UCLA invited him out for a visit as a pitcher. He came back two weeks later and committed on the spot.

-At UCLA, he was named Pac-12 Pitcher of the Year and a consensus First Team All-American in 2019 as a junior. Over 16 games (13 starts), Garcia went 10-1 with a 1.44 ERA. In 94.0 innings, he whiffed 117 batters while walking just 26 and holding opponents to a .160 batting average. In his career with the Bruins, he went 20-2 with a 2.11 ERA. His 2.11 career ERA is seventh in UCLA history.

-His best start during his junior year came against Utah on April 26th, 2019. Over a 9.0-inning complete-game, shutout he struck out 14 batters while allowing just three base runners (two hits and one walk). The 14 strikeouts were the most by a UCLA starter since Trevor Bauer in 2011.

-Led the Wareham Gatemen of the Cape Cod League to a championship in 2018, going 2-0 with a 1.28 ERA over 10 outings.

-Now lives in Surprise, Arizona, about two blocks away from the Rangers Spring Training Complex.

2024 SEASON

-Begins 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

-Threw 5.2 scoreless at CC on 4/30. Over four starts at Whataburger Field, Garcia has allowed just three runs over 20.2 IP (1.31 ERA).

2023 SEASON

-In his Double-A debut on April 11th at San Antonio, Garcia allowed just two solo home runs while tying a career-best five innings.

-Allowed career-high eight runs over 2.2 innings against Wichita on 5/10 during a day game.

-Went a career-high seven innings at Corpus Christi, finishing with just 83 pitches.

2022 SEASON

-Was activated in late May while continuing his rehabilitation from injuries.

-His thought for the 2022 season was "I have built a house this season, coming back from injury, and next season, I will be able to fortify the house."

-Averaged 11.8 K/9 over his 14 games (13 starts).

2021 SEASON

-Missed the entire 2021 season with a right lat strain. That required two months of rest and then trying to build back up, but he strained his lat three different times and was unable to get back on the mound.

2019 SEASON

-Three starts into his professional career, he went on the Injured List with a right elbow strain and underwent "Tommy John" surgery on March 16th, 2020.

-During his TJ rehab, he built a computer from scratch and is very interested in technology.
