TULSA DRILLERS (24-35) vs. SPRINGFIELD CARDINALS (34-25)

RHP PATRICK COPEN (0-0, 1.69 ERA) vs. LHP IXAN HENDERSON (3-3, 2.03 ERA)

SETTING THE SCENE: The Cardinals take on the Drillers (LAD) in the 3rd game of a 6-game series and 12-game homestand ... it's Thirsty Thursday and Cashew Chickens Night at Hammons Field.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Springfield enters the day in 1st place in the North Division, 3.0 games ahead of NWA ... the magic number to win the 1st Half title is 8 with 11 games to play ... at 34-25, SGF is a season-high 9 games above .500.

KING OF THE NORTH: SGF is vying to win back-to-back 1st Half titles for the first time in franchise history ... 2024 team clinched on final day of the half with a 37-32 record ... SGF has won four 1st Half titles all-time (2007, 2009, 2016, and 2024).

X MAN: LHP Ixan Henderson makes his 11th start and 2nd vs. TUL ... hasn't allowed an ER in last 2 starts (11.2 IP) ... struck out 9 to tie his careerhigh in last start 6/6 at FRI ... took a loss in his start on 5/24 at TUL after allowing 3 runs over 5.0 IP with a season-high 5 walks ... leads the TL with a 2.03 ERA and ranks 3rd with 65 SO.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: Springfield beat Tulsa, 3-0, to record its 3rd shutout win ... LHP Brycen Mautz, RHP Ricardo Velez, and RHP Luis Gastelum combined to strike out 14 while walking only 1 batter and allowing 3 hits ... C Leonardo Bernal hit a 2-run HR in the 1st.

ON THE RECORD: The Cardinals are 21-9 over last 30 games since record dropped to a seasonworst 12-16 ... are 15-5 over last 20 games and 8-1 in June.

MAUTZ'S MOUND: LHP Brycen Mautz hit seasonhighs in strikeouts (9) and IP (6.0) to pick up his 1st win of the season Wed. night ... did not allow a hit until the 6th and recorded his first QS.

FEEL THE BERN: C Leonardo Bernal ranks 2nd in the Texas League in HR (10), RBI (36), and 3rd in OPS (.912) ... is batting .424 (14x33) with 4 HR, 11 RBI, and a 1.320 OPS in June.

WETHER HEATING UP: IF JJ Wetherholt recorded his 14th multi-hit game of the season Wednesday ... leads the Texas League with a .430 OBP and is 1st among active TLers with a .312 average.

RINC ENTERS THE RING: RHP Hancel Rincon picked up the win in his Double-A debut on Tuesday ... tied a career-high with 8 strikeouts ... allowed 1 run on 5 hits and 2 walks ... was 1-2 with a 4.22 ERA in 10 games with Peoria (A+).

KNOW THE DRILL: Tonight's game is the 9th of 18 vs. TUL and 3rd of 6 at Hammons Field ... SGF is 6-1 in the season series ... outscoring Drillers, 56-26, and have scored in the 1st inning in 6-of-8 games ... holding TUL hitters to a .188 AVG.

GRANDES LIGA: RHP Andre Granillo was added to STL's big league roster and is poised to make his MLB debut ... played with SGF in parts of 3 seasons (2022-24).
