LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox silenced the Akron RubberDucks on Wednesday at Prince George's Stadium, winning their second-straight game, 5-0. Bowie shut out the visitors using only two pitchers, and let up only one hit. Bowie saw another great offense outing in the eighth when they plated three runs, and Hudson Haskin collected another pair of hits to extend his hitting streak to six games. Garret Stallings and Ryan Watson both shined on the mound for Bowie, as Stallings let up Akron's only hit in the first inning before finishing five frames, and Watson continued his perfect stretch, firing another four blank frames to start his Double-A career with eight consecutive perfect innings.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

Akron has relied heavily on their pitching staff to bounce back from their own 2-3 start to open this series with a 5-4 record. Ending their homestand with a doubleheader against Reading, Akron allowed only one run in the 14 innings to sweep the twin bill. Entering this series, Akron's 3.17 ERA as a staff is the third-best in the Eastern League, and their 109 strikeouts lead the league. Offensively, Akron sits in the bottom half of the league in multiple categories, including only three home runs and 86 total bases, fewer than ten per game.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Left-handed pitcher Logan Allen enters the season as the Guardians' eighth-ranked prospect, having no relation to the big-league pitcher with the same name. He will enter his third start of the year with a 2.89 ERA, pitching five innings on one-run ball last time out against Reading. In his first season, Allen pitched to a 9-0 record while striking out 143 batters in 19 starts at both High-A Lake County and Double-A Akron. In Lake County, he started nine-game while pitching to a 1.58 ERA. In Akron, he started ten games as opponents only hit .186 against him.

HASKIN LEADS THE CHARGE

After missing three games from a hit by a pitch early in Bowie's 4-3 win at Binghamton on 4/13, Hudson Haskin continued his tear through pitchers in Wednesday's game, going 2-for-4 with an RBI and run scored. Once again a qualified batter in the Eastern League, Haskin leads the EL in AVG (.560), OBP (.593), SLG (.1160), OPS (1.753), and BABIP (.769). Haskin is ranked as the Orioles #16 prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline, #22 according to Baseball America. He was named the Orioles Organization All-Star in the outfield by MiLB.com for his 2021 season, but did not get to see the full season due to a thumb fracture in late August.

THE UPPER HALL

After batting sixth on Opening Day and taking the second game of the season off, Bowie outfielder Adam Hall has settled in to the leadoff role nicely for the Baysox. Hall has the most base hits to start an inning in the Eastern League this season with seven, including a pair last night for Bowie. Hall is ranked as the Orioles #28 prospect entering the 2022 season according to MLB Pipeline, #27 according to Baseball America. Also listed as the fastest baserunner in the organization by Baseball America.

HIT OR MISS

Bowie tied a season high by striking out 17 times at the plate on Wednesday night, despite plating five runs on seven hits. Only two Baysox players struck out three times in the game, and Adam Hall was the only player not to strike out. Bowie's 121 strikeouts at the plate this season are the third-most in the league, on pace for 1669 strikeouts on the year, well past their league-leading 1226 strikeouts last season (in 18 fewer games.)

FULLY ROTATING

Baysox pitching has hit its stride to help guide Bowie back atop the Southwest Division standings. Since April 11, the Baysox 5-2 record is the best in the league, thanks in part to their starting pitchers firing an overall 3.27 ERA, the third-best mark in the league. In their last full turn through the rotation, Bowie's starters collected a 2.66 ERA while striking out 22 batters.

BACKED TO THE WALL

Bowie has not been afraid to make some noise when down to their final out. Over the two games of this series, Bowie has scored 20 of their 27 runs with two outs. The Baysox 33 runs driven in with two outs is more than any team outside of Triple-A (which has played four more games) and more than any Major League team. The contact has not been as clear-cut, as the Baysox .390 OBP with two outs is only good for 8th in the minors (but it does lead the Eastern League). Bowie only managed a .308 OBP with two outs in 2021, among the bottom half in the League.

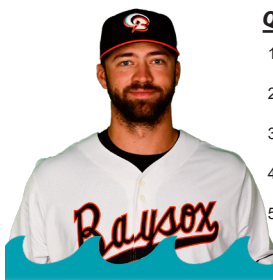

- Gained 27 pounds between the start of spring training and Opening Day. "Just eating and lifting. Starting to focus now on making some muscle out of it"
- Picked up tips on his changeup from Orioles starter John Means when Means made a rehab start with Bowie in 2021: "I was kind of like the little kid, just nervous to talk to him. Eventually I got the nuts to ask him about his changeup. He was the nicest, most genuine guy. He told me how he throws it, how he grips it. He was awesome about it."
- Closed 2021 with 13 consecutive scoreless innings for Bowie after allowing at least one earned run in each of his previous seven outings, including all of his outings with Bowie.
- In 2021, Aberdeen averaged eight runs in games Drew appeared in, while Bowie only averaged 5.8 runs in the same games
- Major contributor for manager Kyle Moore with the Delmarva Shorebirds in 2019. Team finished with a 90-48 record, the best in Minor League Baseball. Rom was one of eight Shorebirds named to the South Atlantic League All-Star Game.

What They're Saying:

Matt Blood, Orioles Dir. of Player Development: "He throws a lot of strikes. He's deceptive, he's an uncomfortable at-bat for hitters and he's still pretty young, so we're excited about that."

MLB Pipeline: "Lean and projectable, Rom hides the ball well by creating deception with his 6-foot-2 frame. He releases from a three-quarters arm slot and uses his long stride and crossfire finish to create good extension, which allows his pitches to play up and miss barrels consistently. He is comfortable throwing either off-speed pitch in fastball counts as well as mixing up arm angles; he couples this unpredictability with a quick pace and moderate effort delivery that projects durability."

Baseball America: "Rom hasn't yet developed a standout pitch, but a varied mix and precocious pitchability have helped him carve up hitters at every level. He experimented with dropping his arm slot against lefties to create different action on his two-seam fastball. Rom knows how the pitches play off one another, and pitches backwards while taking advantage of his deception and angles."

Notes by Outing*

- Apr 8 v RIC Bowie's Opening Day starter, was peppered with base hits over his three innings, six singles. Allowed three single over the first two innings, but did not allow a runner to reach third base. Once he reached the second trip through the order, Richmond started with two singles and two walks to eventually score three runs.
- Apr 21 @ BNG Five shutout frames versus the Ponies, with his only hiccup coming in the second inning, where he allowed a pair of base hits and a walk to load the bases with only one out. Those three baserunners were the only three he allowed all day.

Manager: Kyle Moore

He rejoined the Orioles as the Fundamentals Coach for the IronBirds for the 2020 season before it was canceled. He served as the Hitting Coach for the Complex League Orioles in 2021.

Pitching Coach: Josh Conway

Conway was selected in the fourth round of the 2012 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft by the Chicago Cubs out of Coastal Carolina. He played three seasons with the Cubs organization, making it to Double-A in 2016. The Smithburg, Md native returned to the Chanticleers to complete his undergraduate degree and served as a student assistant and assistant pitching coach before joining the Orioles.
