LET'S PLAY TWO?: Before the Marauders and Blue Jays take the field for their originally scheduled Friday-night matchup, the two will complete their previously suspended game from June 29 (26 days ago) at TD Ballpark. As the road team, the Marauders will step to the plate in the top of the eleventh with the game tied at 3-3 with Yordany De Los Santos at second base and Edward Florentino at the plate. ABS chalenges remaining, while Bradenton has one. Both teams will still have their ACS challenges available. To this point, Bradenton is 2-6 in extra-innings games. Tonight's originally scheudled game will resume shortly after the conclusion of this one.

GROUND-BALL MACHINE: After yesterday's postponement in Clearwater, right hander **Carlos Castillo's** start has been pushed back to tonight. Last Saturday at Clearwater, Castillo appeared in relief and tossed two scoreless innings. Overall, Castillo has made 17 apperances and 14 starts

for Bradenton this season, and has pitched to a 4.50 ERA over a career-high 64 innings. Castillo generally keeps the ball on the ground as he has pitched to a 46.4 percent groundball rate this season. He mixes in a sinker (91.9 mph), slider (83.5 mph), changeup (86.7) and curveball (80.6 mph). For Castillo, six of his eight hardest pitches this year came in the month of June (topped out at 95.2 on 6/1)

MARAUDERS MASHERS: The Bradenton Marauders return from the All-Star Break as one of the best home-run hitting teams in all of Class-A. Their 73 longballs this season are the most in the Florida State League and second-most throughout the entire level. 111 of their 428 total runs

have been generated via the long ball (25.9%). They're 25-21 when leaving the yard at least once, and 17-28 when not homering at all. They've

FINDING A WAY: While the Marauders have been very relient on the longball this season, they've left the yard just once over their last seven

games - including a season-long stretch of six straight before **Ethan Lege's** solo shot on Tuesday. It marks just the second time they've gone five or more contests without a homer (4/19-4/24). SECOND-HALF TRENDS: Bradenton is off to a 12-13 start in the second half, currently tied with Fort Myers for the FSL West's final playoff spot. With 41 games to go, the Marauders are eyeing their first postseason appearance since 2021 when they won their second FSL title. Entering the week, Bradenton has been stellar on the mound in the second half, posting a 3.28 ERA over 228 innings - the sixth best mark in Class-A and the third best in the Florida State League. In the process, their starters have been dominant, registering a 1.90 ERA to lead all Single-A clubs over the stretch (San Jose - 2.48, 2nd). In the process they've limited opponents to a .197 average and have only allowed two homers as a group. Moreover, as an offense, they're 66-for-228 (.289) with runners in scoring position, good for the third highest clip in Single-A in run-scoring opportunities. They've also swiped 64 bases, the second most in Single-A.

WELCOME TONY: Pirates No. 21 prospect (MLB Pipeline) Tony Blanco Jr. was activated and assigned to Single-A Bradenton on Saturday, July 19 at Jupiter and collected his first Single-A hit and RBI on a first-inning single and fourth-inning sacrfice fly. Blanco began the season on the injured list and just completed a two-game rehab assignment with the FCL Pirates where he went 1-for-6 with a home run. In 30 FCL games last year, Blanco Jr. batted .305 and slugged .505 with four homers. His father Tony Blanco played 62 big-league games for the Washington Nationals in 2005 and spent eight seasons in the Nippon Professional Baseball League in Japan.

MARAUDERS ON THE MEND: In this year's draft the Pittsburgh Pirates selected RHP Seth Hernandez sixth overall in the first round of the 2025 MLB Draft and signed with the organization on Tuesday for 7.25 million dollars, the largest bonus ever for a prep pitcher. Hernandez was recently named 2025 Gatorade National High School Player of the Year and spent the 2025 season as a senior at Corona High School in California (0.39). ERA/53.1 IP, 105 K). He was committed to Vanderbilt University. At 19 years old, he was touted as the best prep arm in the draft, and the No. 3 overall prospect in the draft class via MLB Pipeline. His fastball reached 100 miles per hour, paired with an esteemed changeup, curveball and slider. Other notable selections included C Easton Carmichael (3rd Rd., Oklahoma), SS Gustavo Melendez (4th Rd., HS) and 1B Jared Jones (9th Rd., LSU) among others
