New Hampshire recorded only three hits in the game with Leo Jimenez crushing a home run for the second straight night in the third inning, his sixth homer of the season. The solo home run by Jimenez went an estimated 406 feet and 105 miles per hour off the bat. However, the Fisher Cats did not collect a hit from the third inning onward while striking out 15 times. Starting right-hander Adam Kloffenstein went six innings, allowing four runs on eight hits and two walks while striking out a season-high 10, receiving the loss. It's the third time in his career (second in Double-A) where Kloffenstein has recorded 10 or more strikeouts in a start. The 22-year-old has now gone five or more innings in 13 consecutive starts. He now ranks second in the Eastern League in strikeouts (93) and third in innings pitched (79). Hartford center fielder Bladimir Restituyo delivered the go-ahead runs for the Yard Goats in the fourth with a two-run homer off kloffenstein. Left-handed starter Joe Rock struck out nine Fisher

In the series, Jimenez is 6-for-14 with two homers, a double, a triple, and six RBIs. On Wednesday, Jimenez recorded his first 5- RBI game as a professional, going 3-for-5 with a triple shy of the cycle. The Blue Jays No. 19 prospect has stepped up offensively over the last 25 games for the Fisher Cats, leading the team in extra base hits (13) and RBIs (22) while playing solid defense up the middle between shortstop and second base.

Over his last 10 games, Martinez has walked 10 times while striking out just six times. The Blue Jays top position player prospect continues to be among the Eastern League leaders in homers (T-3 <sup>rd</sup> ) and RBI (4 <sup>th</sup> ).

**LAST TIME OUT**: Started the first game of last Friday's home doubleheader with the Sea Dogs. Allowed three unearned runs in four innings in a 6-2 loss to fall to 3-6 on the season. Gave up three hits (all singles), walked four and struck out five.

v. HARTFORD– Third career start and second in 2023 vs. Yard Goats. Losing pitcher in Manchester on April 27 when he allowed three runs on seven hits in four innings. Pitched four shutout innings at Dunkin making his New Hampshire debut last August 21.

**2023:** Opened season with his third consecutive outing at Double-A without allowing a run. Earned the win 4/8 at Altoona. Picked up second win on June 3 in a 2-1 win over Reading at Delta Dental Stadium. Beat Akron 2-0 on June 16 when he worked the first five, striking out a Double-A high eight batters.

Was primarily a start with the C's (10 outings, 9 starts). Had a 3.82 ERA and 0-2 record with Vancouver, throwing a career-high 11 strikeouts vs. Everett on July 31.
