LAST GAME

The Baysox ended the first half with an 8-4 defeat at the hands of the Altoona Curve on Sunday night. After jumping out to a 4-0 lead through three innings that included a sole home run from Zach Watson and a two-run single from TT Bowens, Bowie fell victim to a disastrous bottom of the sixth inning. The Baysox made two errors in the frame, allowing five runs to score on just two Altoona hits, as right-hander Jean Pinto recorded just two outs after entering in the beginning of the frame, walking two and committing one of the errors with an errant toss to second base, before allowing the go-ahead two-run double to the Curve's Matt Frazier. The troublesome inning canceled out the great start from Alex Pham, as the right-hander fired five shutout frames in his Double-A debut, allowing just two hits and one walk while striking out three. The loss was the fifth in a row for Bowie on a Sunday, pushing the Baysox record to 2-8 on Sundays this season.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Somerset Patriots finished the first half of 2023 with a 42-26 record - best across the Eastern League, clinching a first half title in the Northeast division. The Double-A affiliate of the New York Yankees, Somerset has been powered by its pitching staff this season, which holds a league-lead-ing 3.74 ERA, while allowing the fewest home runs (50) across the league and accumulating the most strikeouts (681). Offensively, the Patriots have hit the most home runs (100) and stolen the second-most bases (126) - both notable weaknesses of this Baysox team. Somerset's roster is highlighted by six of the Yankees' top 10 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - OF Jasson Dominguez (No. 1 NYY/ No. overall), C. Austin Wells (No. 2 NYY), No. Verall), OF Everson Pereria (No. 4 NYY), INF Trey Sweeney (No. 5 NYY), RHP Richard Fitts (No. 8 NYY), and RHP Yoendrys Gomez (No. 9 NYY).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Yoendrys Gomez is set to get the ball in the series opener for Somerset. The No. 9 prospect in the Yankees' system, per MLB Pipeline, Gomez missed the vast majority of April and May on the injured list, not making his 2023 debut until May 28. He has yet to go longer than three innings in any of his five starts this season, but also has yet to allow more than a single run in any outing. The control has been less than stellar for Gomez at times, with 10 walks compared to 13 strikeouts across his 13.2 innings, but he is holding opponents to just a .159 average. Injuries also hampered Gomez each of the last two seasons, with shoulder issues in 2021, before Tommy John Surgery in August 2021 kept on the injured list until early June 2022 and limited him to just 47 innings. Still, the right-hander was able to progress quickly and make his Double-A debut with the Patriots by September, helping Somerset win game two of the Eastern League Championship series. Signed by the Yankees as an international free agent in 2016 out of Venezuela, Gomez features a mid-high-90s fastball, a sweeping mid-80s slider, a low-80s curveball, and a high-80s changeup.

THE A-MAYO-ZING COBY

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. At the midway point, Mayo leads Minor League Baseball with his 42 extra-base hits, while his 26 doubles pace the Double-A level. The No. 8 Orioles'/ No. 80 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, has hits in 14 of 15 games, and is coming off back-to-back Eastern League Player of the Week awards, hitting .440 across the past two weeks with six home runs, seven doubles, and 13 RBI. Mayo also leads all of Double-A in both slugging (.609) and OPS (1.041), while sitting fourth in on-base percentage (.432).

LET HIM COOK

Billy Cook is enjoying one of the hottest stretches of his professional career. Cook has hits in 17 of 18 games for the first time in his minor league career, including eight straight. He's hitting .366 in that stretch with six doubles and four home runs. Cook has bounced back nicely in 2023, hitting .319 with 20 extra-base hits over the past two months, after hitting just .103 with one extra-base hit in the month of April.

TANDEM TROUBLES

The abundance of starting pitching experience on the Bowie roster has led to a reliance on tandems at times this season. Despite a collective starters' ERA of 3.67 - the best in the Eastern League and second-best at the Double-A level, when Baysox starters enter the game as relievers, they sport a collective 5.41 ERA. Bowie has utilized a tandem in 37 games thus far in 2023, going 19-18 in those contests. The back end of tandems have blown six leads for the Baysox this season, while failing to go two innings on nine ocasions, and allowing four runs or more in 12 different contests.

FINISHING WITH A FLOURISH

Despite a last place finish in the Southwest division, the Bowie Baysox ended the first half particularly strong. Bowie won its last three, and four of its last five, series to close things out. Although, peculiarly enough, the Baysox did struggle to close out a series and take care of business during twin bills. Through its last five series of the first half, Bowie went 0-9 in games played either on Sunday, or as part of a doubleheader, while going 16-4 in all other contests.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orioles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 14-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the heim of recent successful teams throughout the Orioles sys-tem. Moore led Class-A Delmarva to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebirds were named MiLB.com's Team of the Year and Moore won South Atlanic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial record sits at 254-216 (.540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orioles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Battimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madilyn and Cameron. Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Sherman Johnson makes his coaching debut, as he joins the Baysox staff as the hitting coach in 2023. Johnson had a brief stint in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Johnson's Japlaying career most recently landed him in independent ball this past season with the Kane County Cougars. Johnson also played two seasons collegiately at Florida State.

Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann

Priching Coach - Forrest Herrmann Forrest Hermann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitch-ing coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Hermann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts. Prior to joining the Orioles organization, Hermann spent two seasons as a pltching coach within the Cincinnati Reds organization. Hermann also served as a pltching strategist in 2019 for the Seattle Mariners organization at their facility in Peoria. Hermann also worked with current Orioles left-hander John Means at P3 Premier Pltching Performance center in Missouri. He pltched for three seasons at the University of Evansville prior to his coaching career.

Fundamentals Coach - Tim DeJohn

Tim DeJohn returns to the Baysox in 2023 for a second season as Fundamentals coach. However, DeJohn also received a promotion this season and will also serve as the Minor League Infield Coordinator at all levels. DeJohn has been a part of the Orioles' staff since November 2019. Prior to joining the organization, DeJohn had an extensive background in the college ranks. He served as an assistant coach at the University of Memphis between 2017 and 2019 and was an assistant at the University of Hartford the two seasons prior. DeJohn played at Western Connecticut State from 2003-2008.

Development Coach - Ryan Goll

Ryan Goll, much like pitching coach Forrest Hermann, is making a jump from High-A in 2023. Goll serves as the Baysox develo-other filling the same role for Aberdean last season. Goll has also been promoted to Offseason Camp Coordinator entering 2023. Goll first served as a Player Development Intern for the Orioles organization in 2020, before joining the minor league staff full-time n 2021. Goll attended the University of Minnesota, where he began as a bullpen catcher and Head Student Manager from 2015-2018, before moving on to be a Student Undergraduate Assistant Coach in September of 2018.
